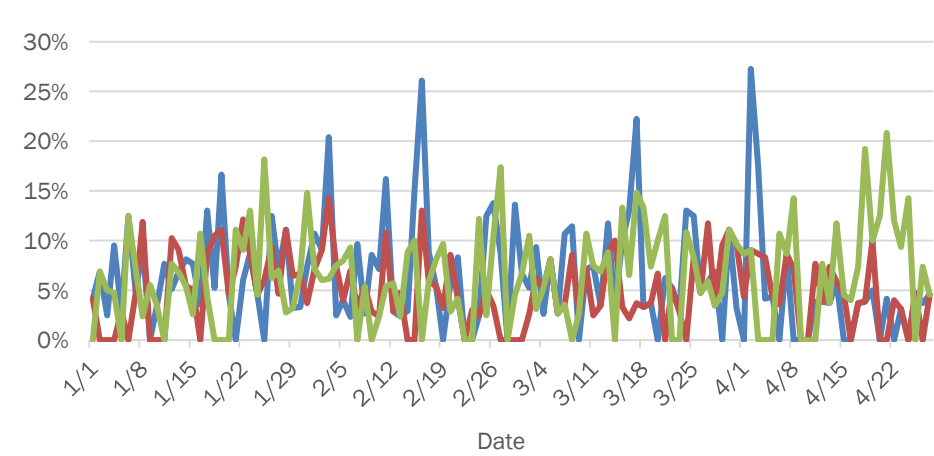

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

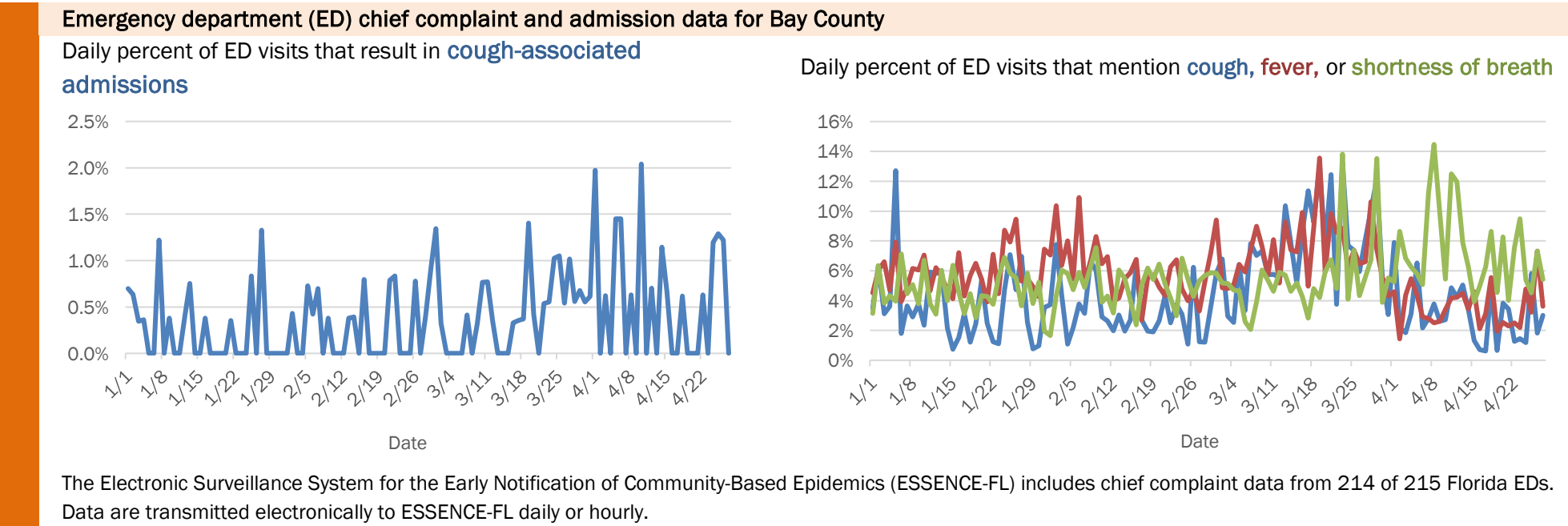
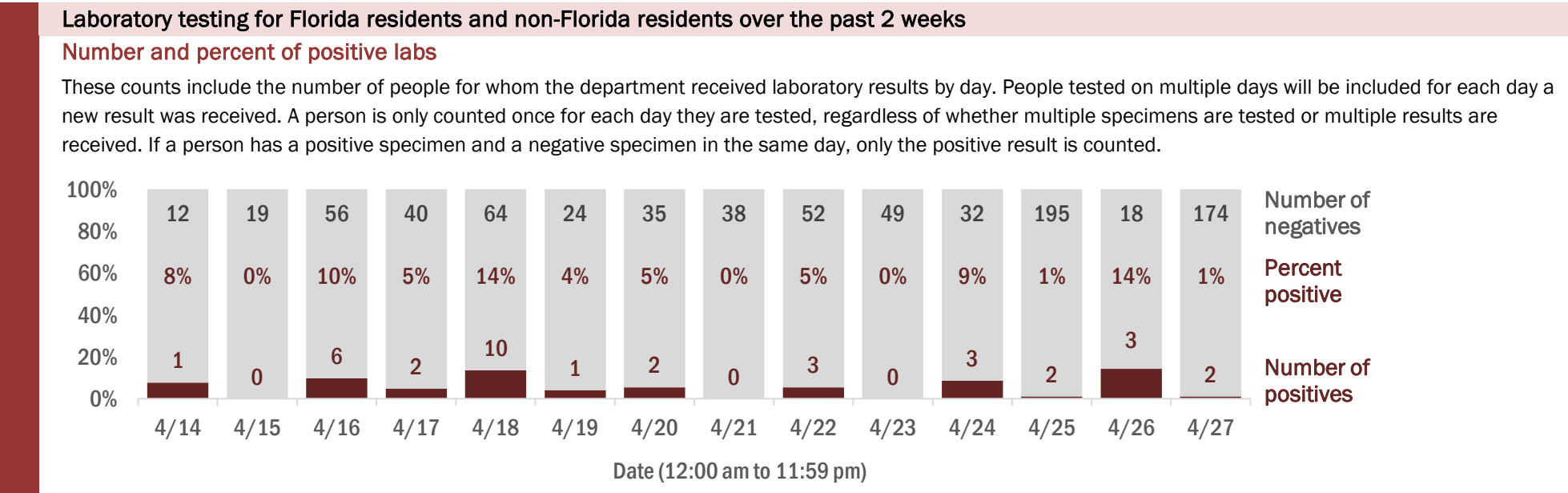
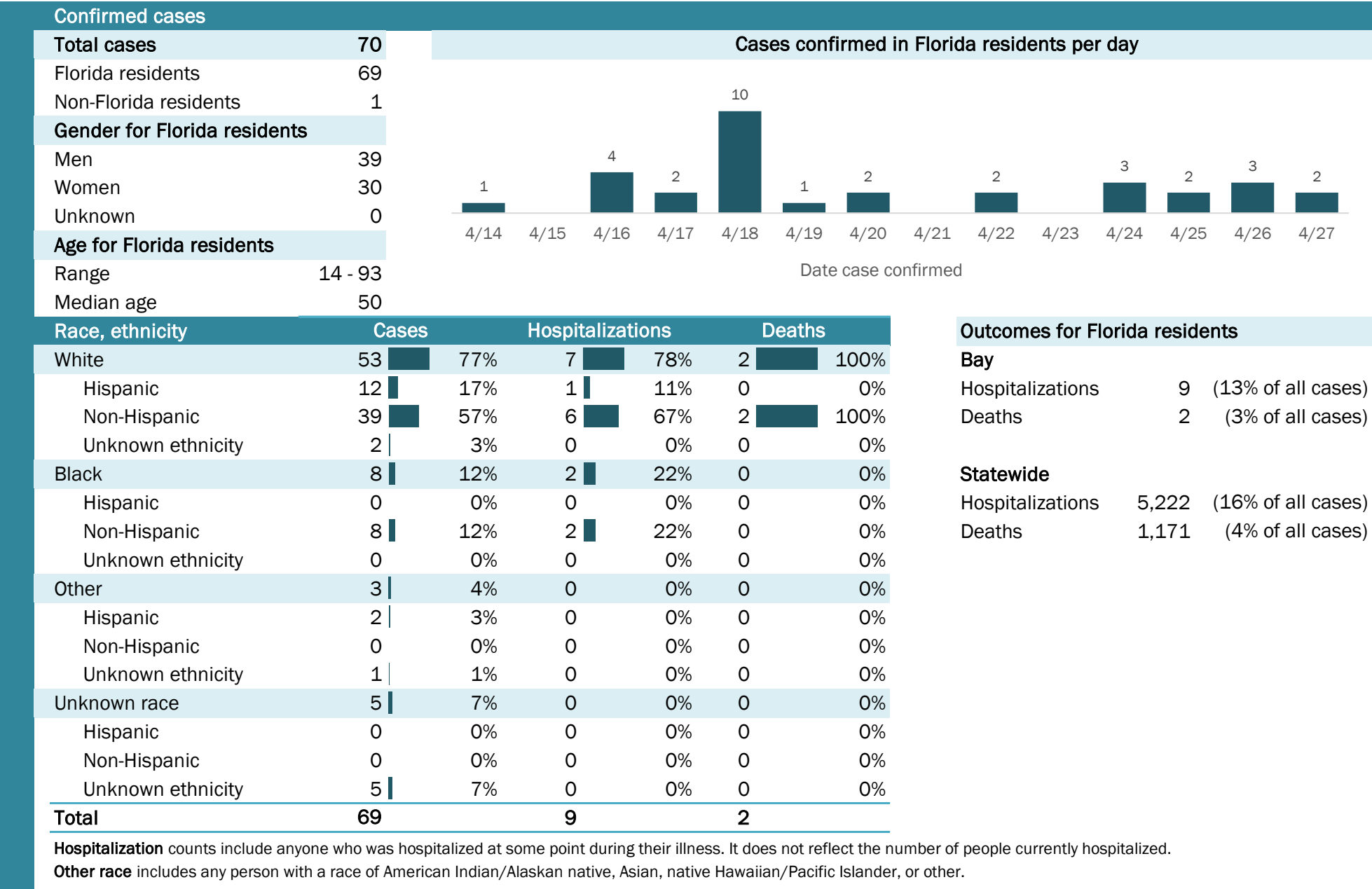

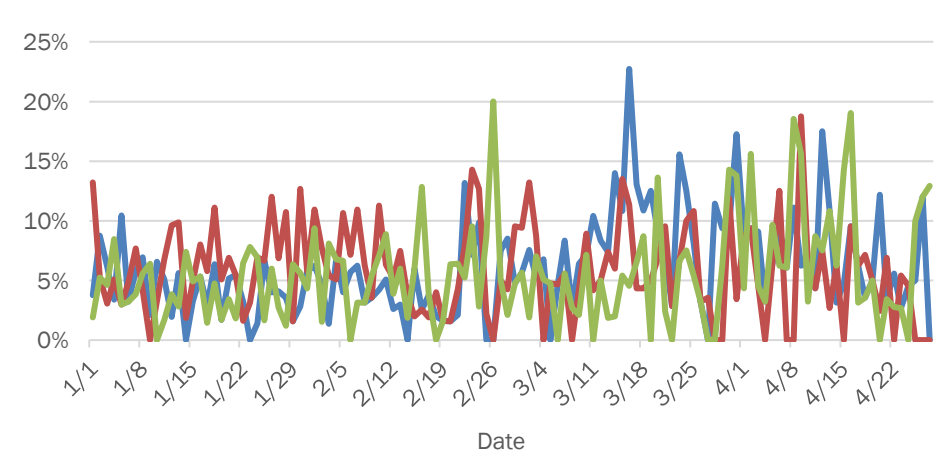


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Bradford County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

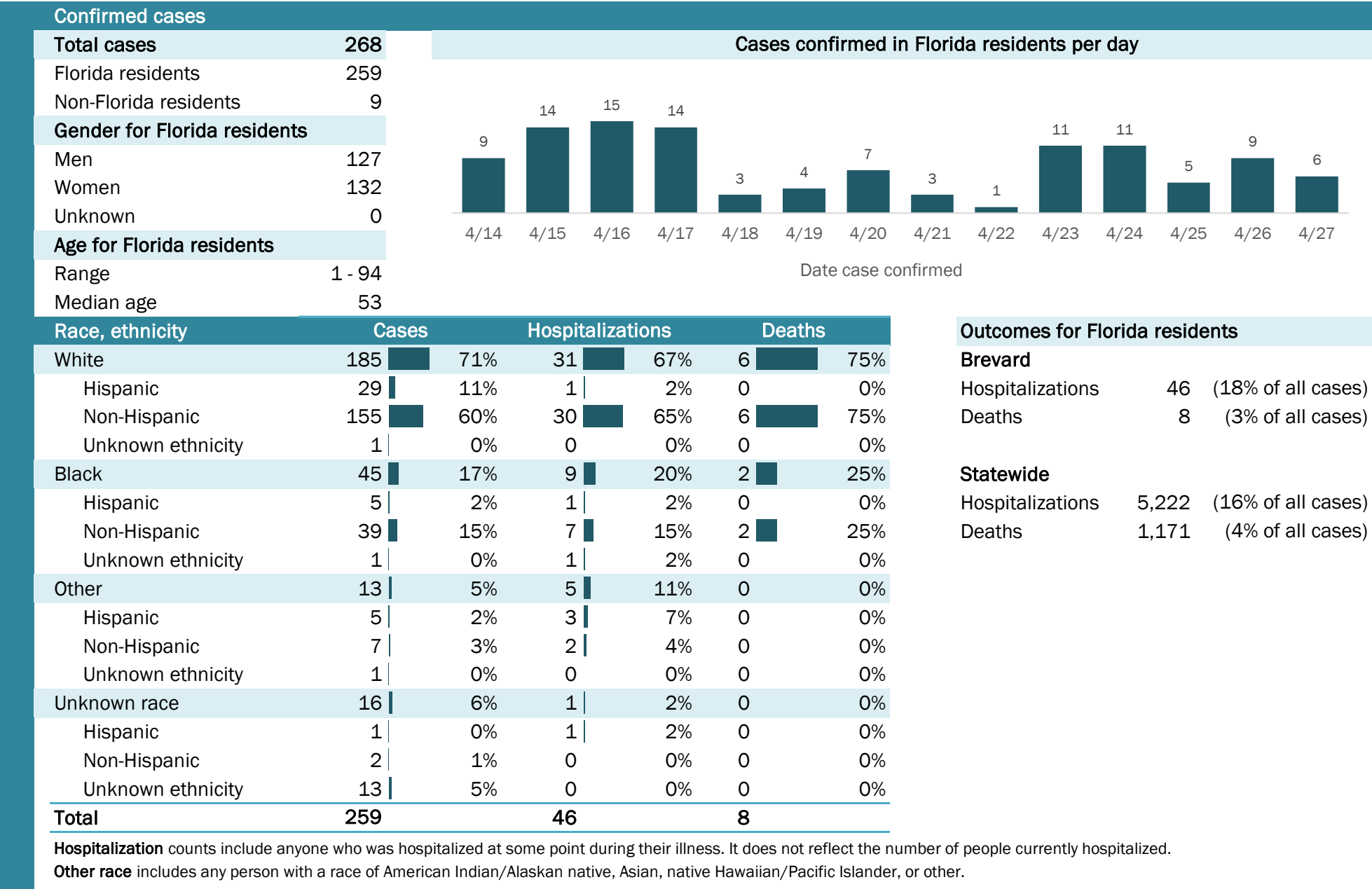

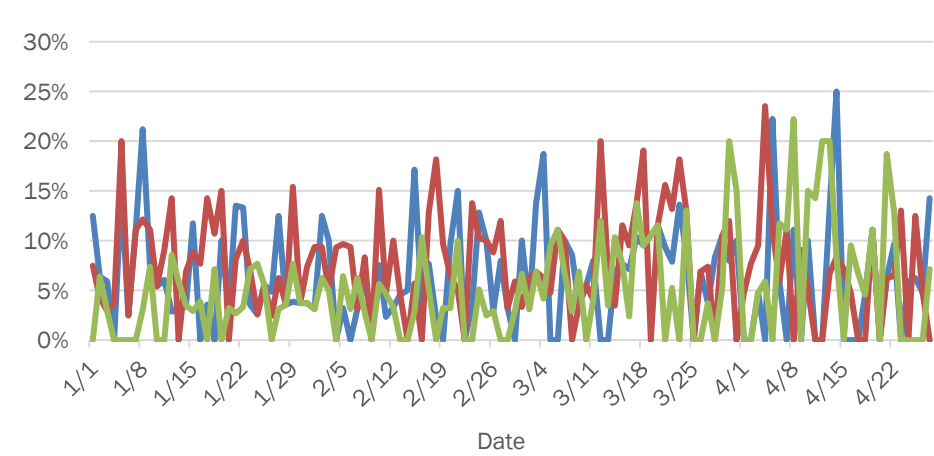


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Calhoun County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

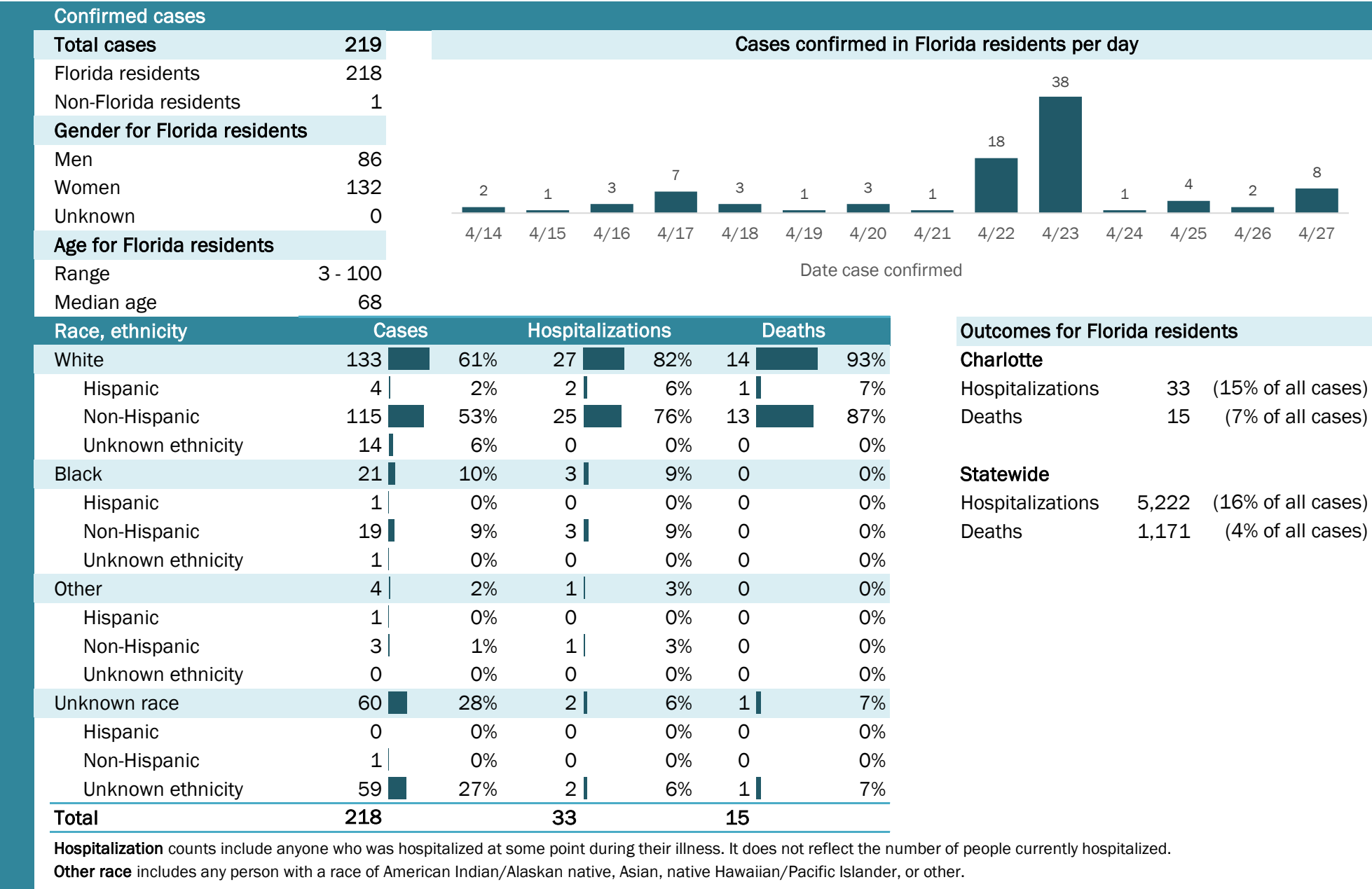

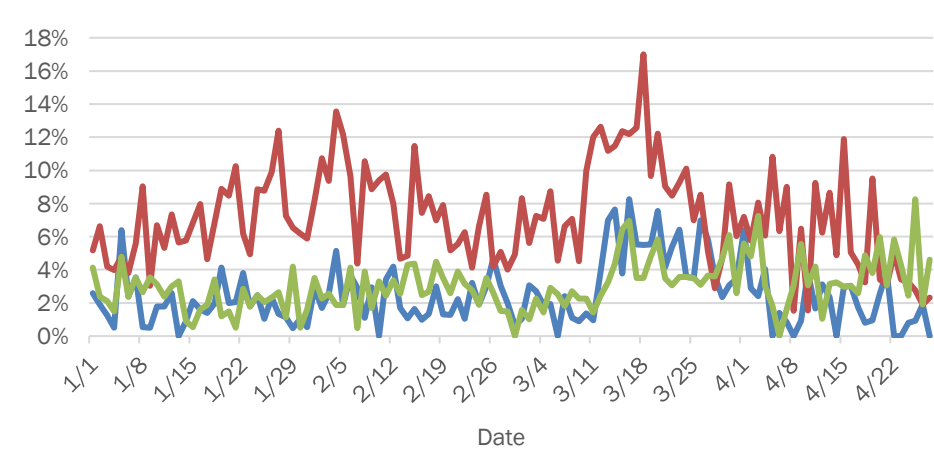


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Citrus County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

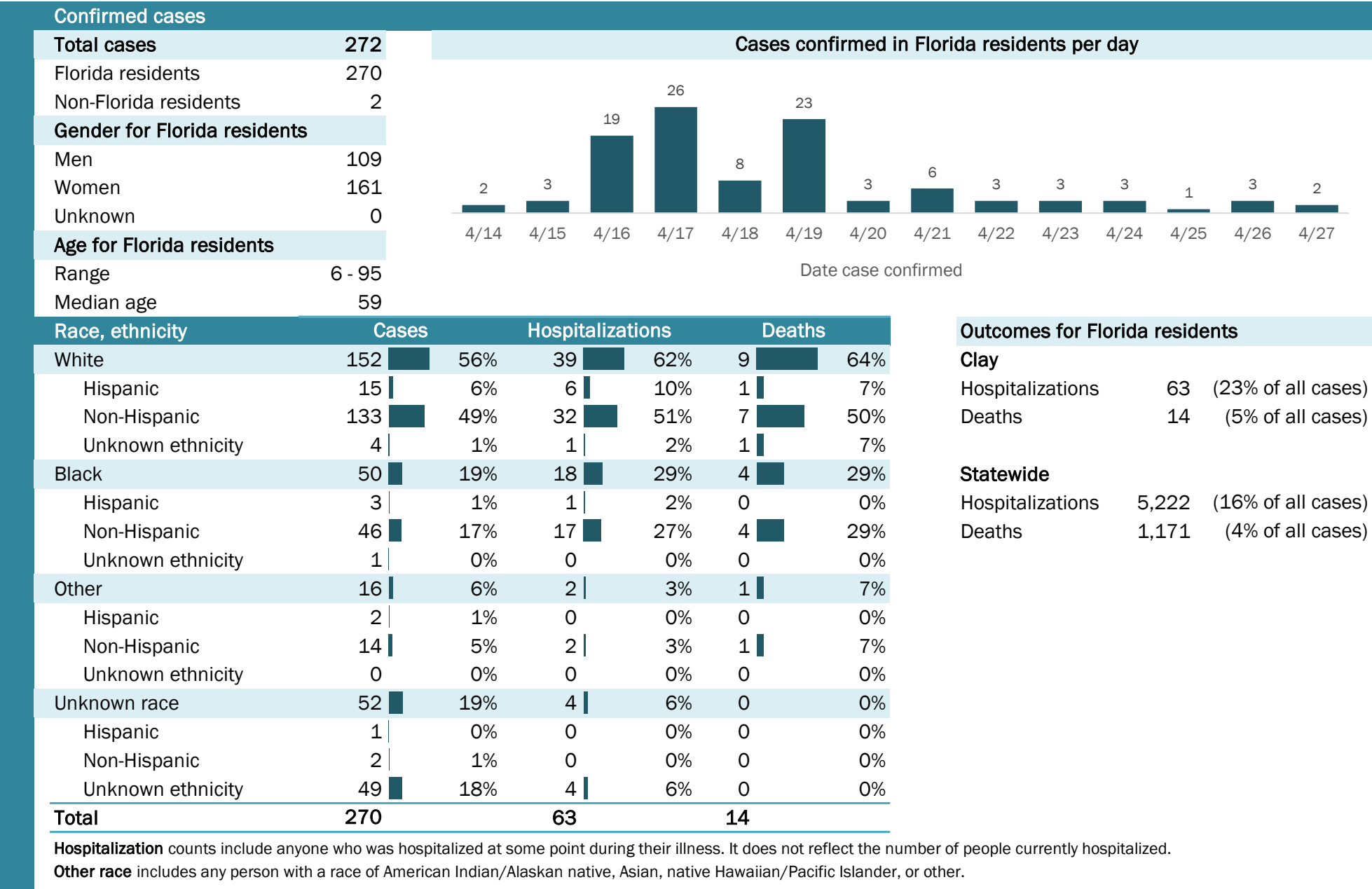

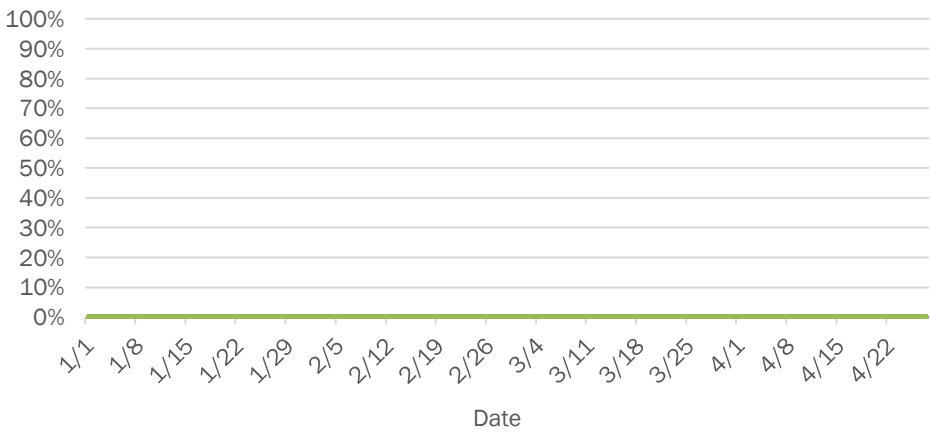


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Franklin County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

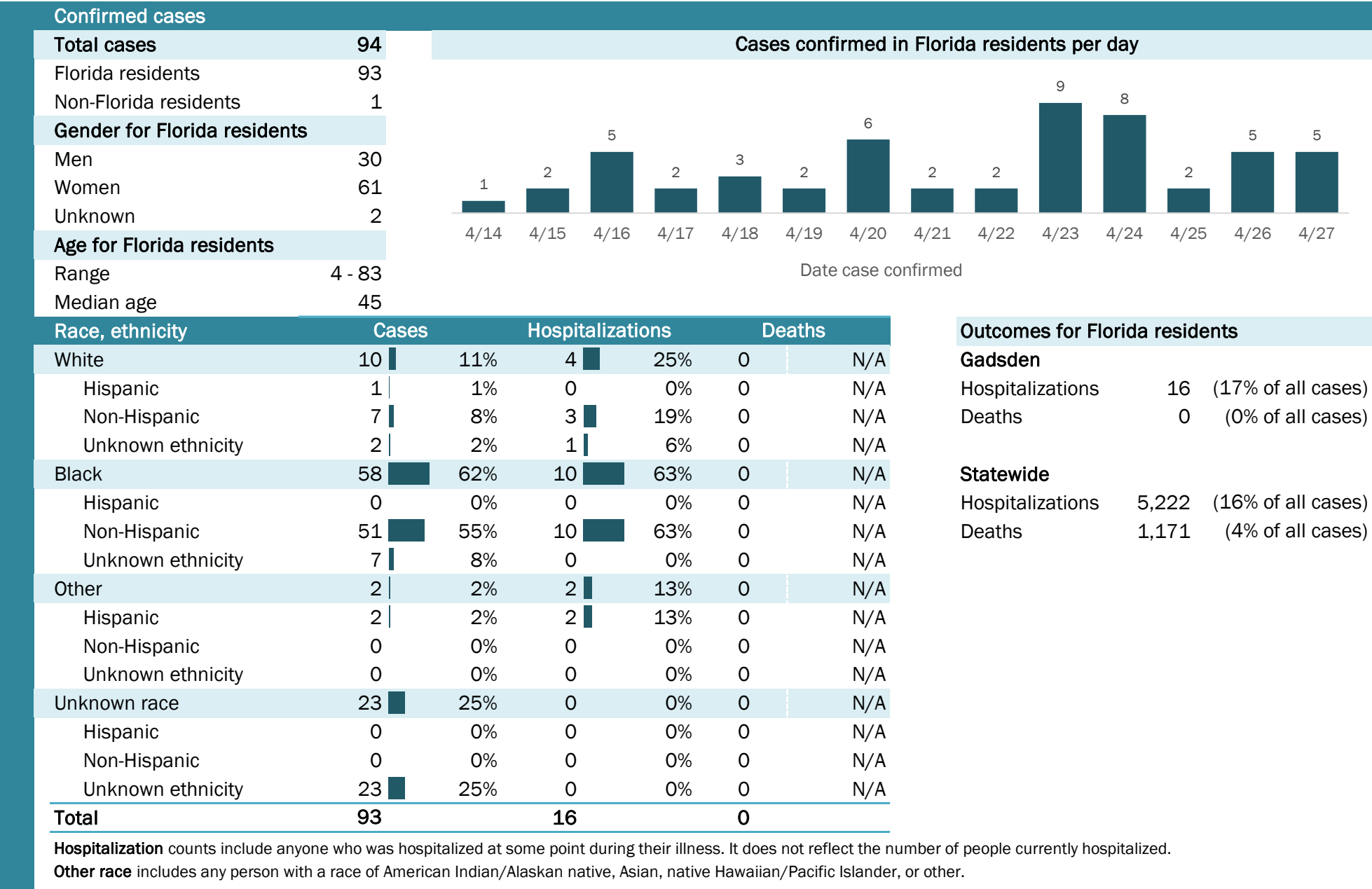

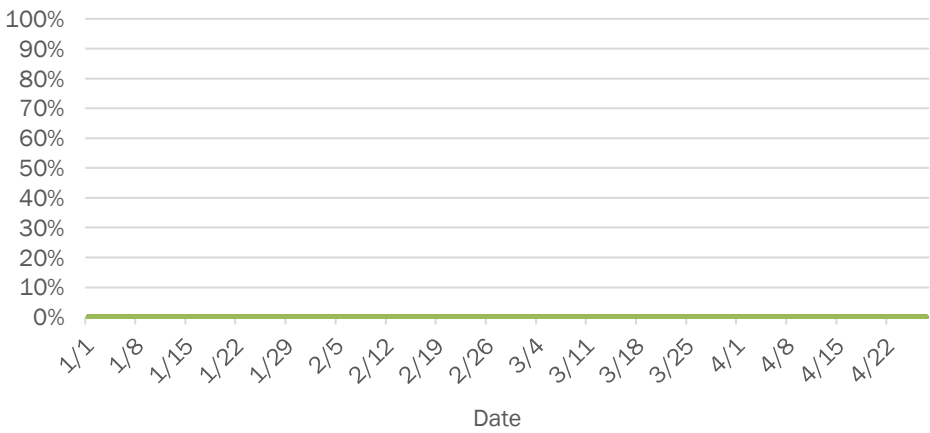


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Glades County

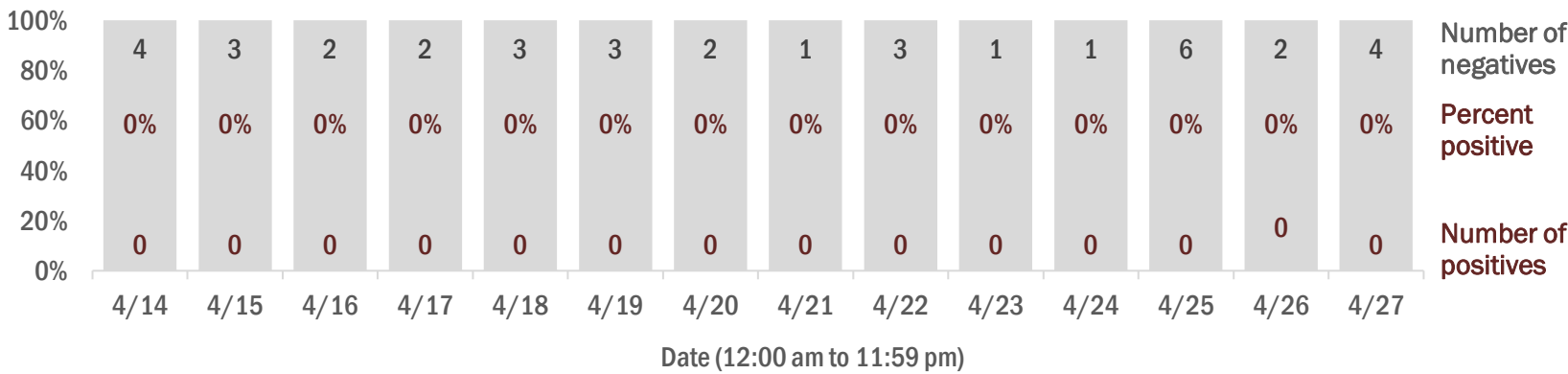

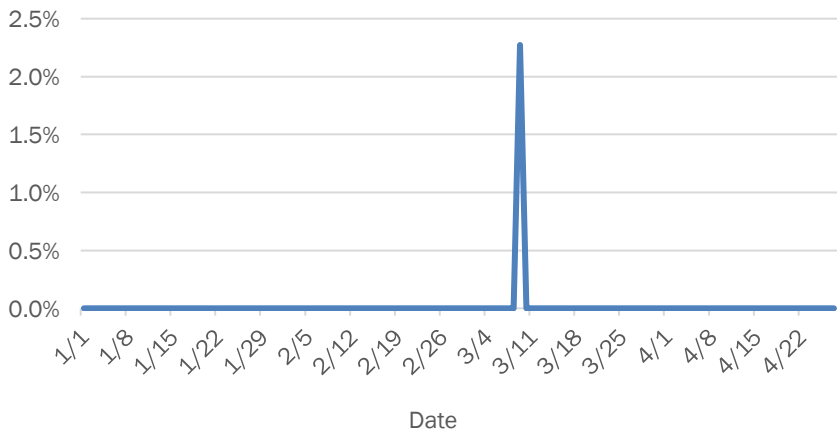

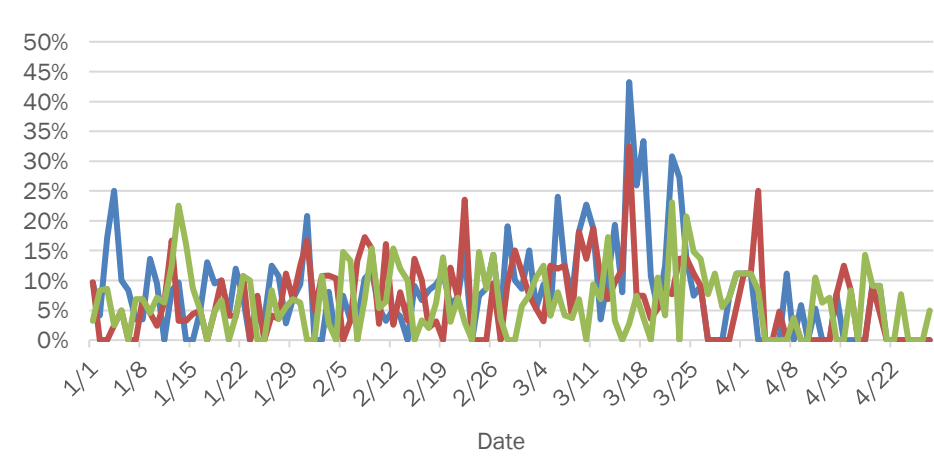


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County

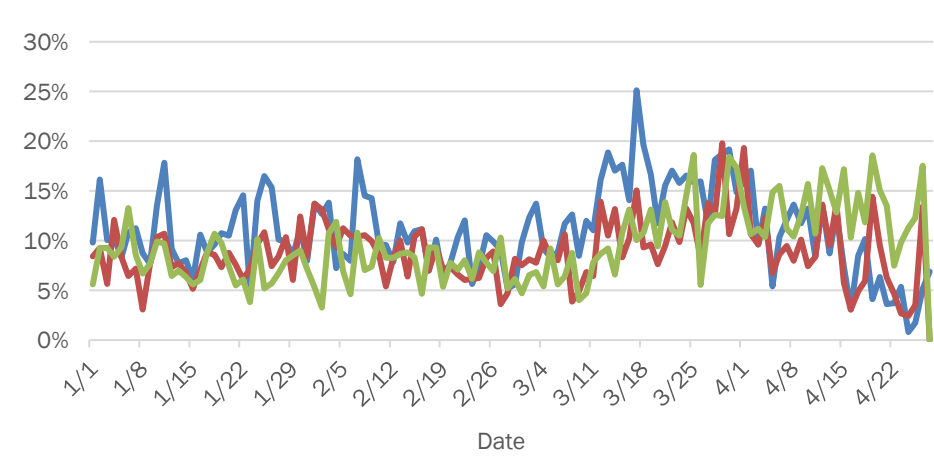


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Highlands County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

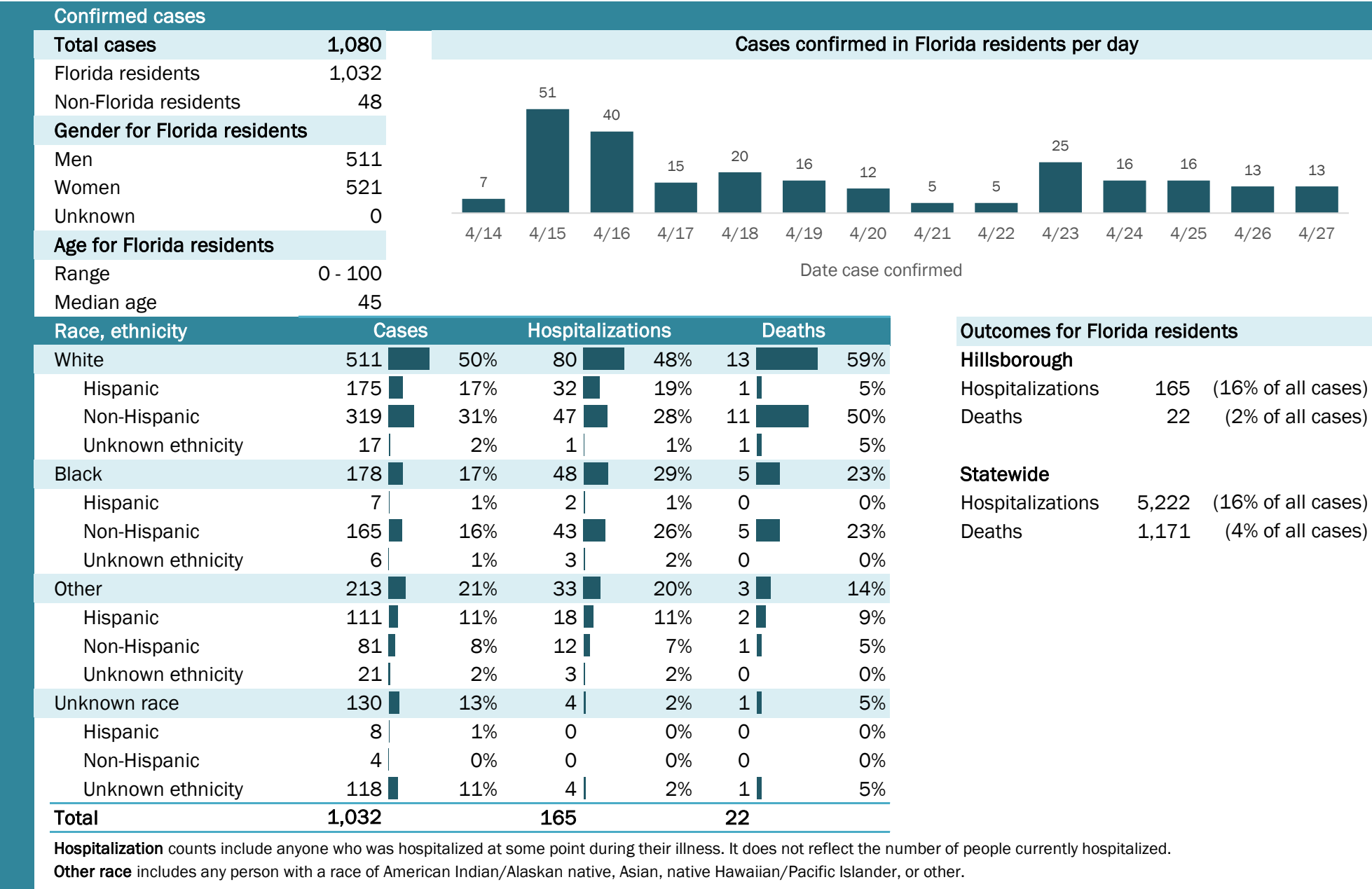

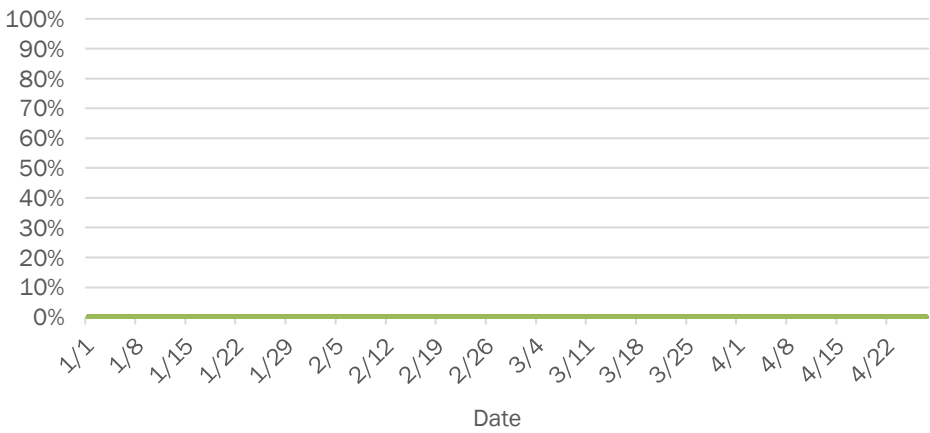


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Lafayette County

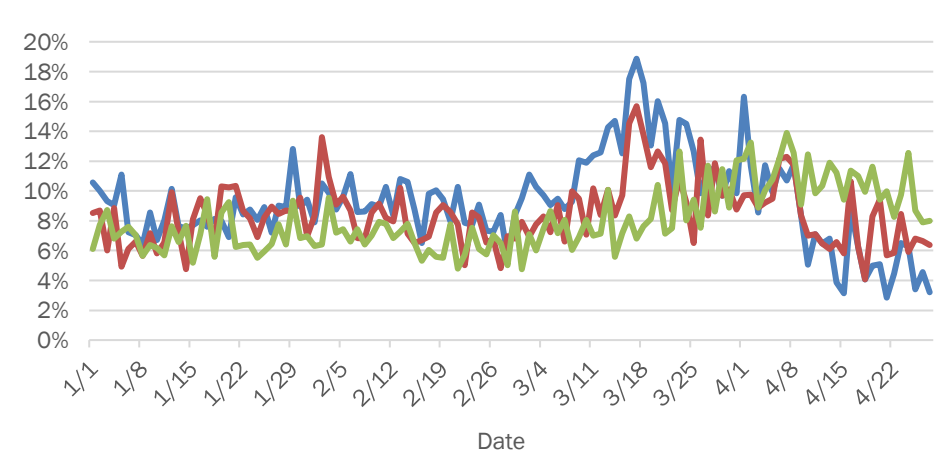


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Lake County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

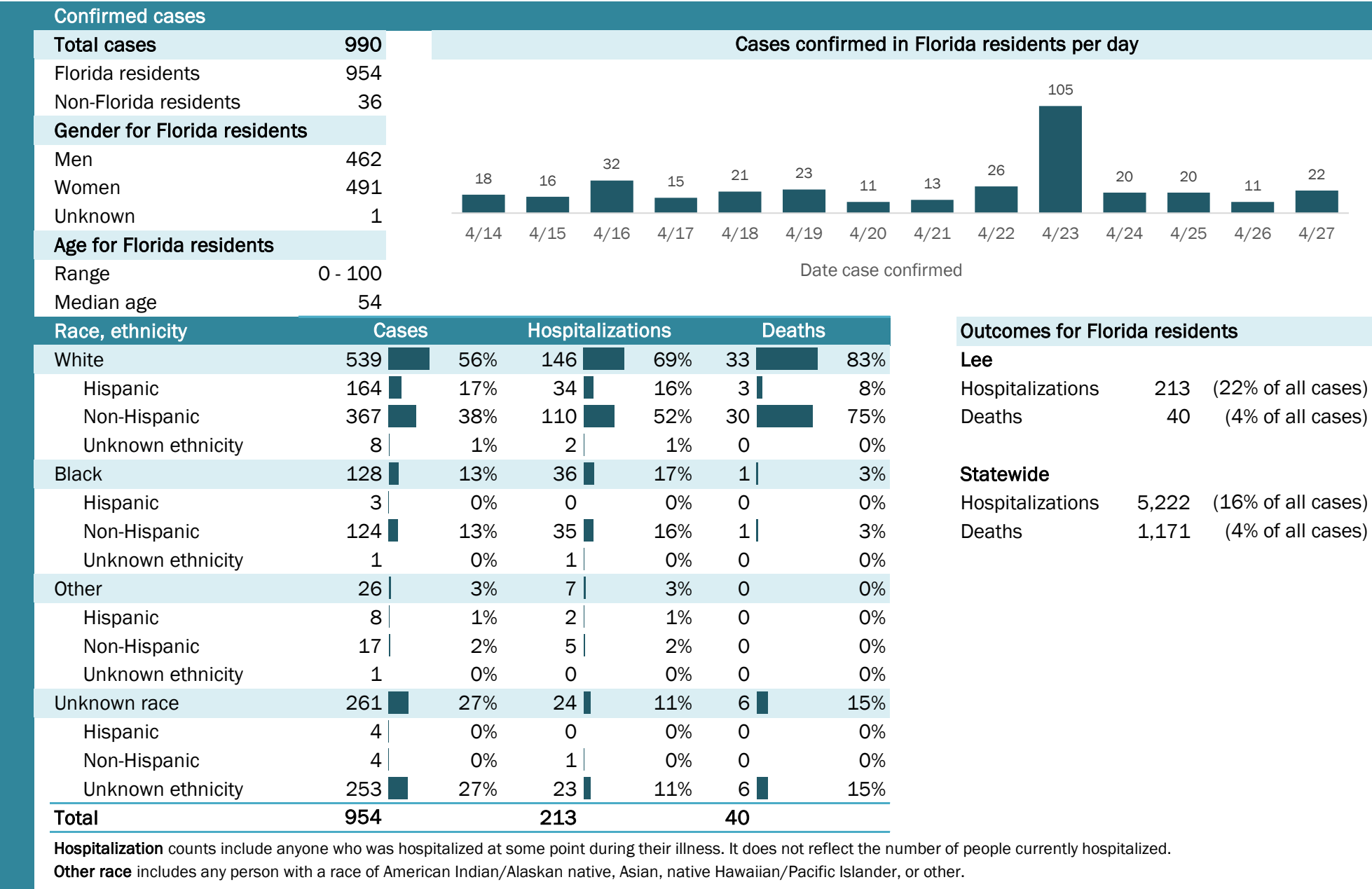

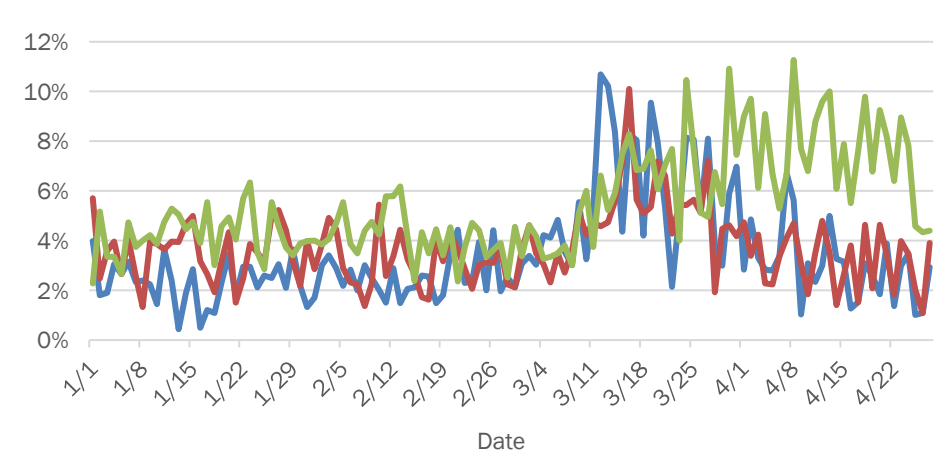


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Leon County

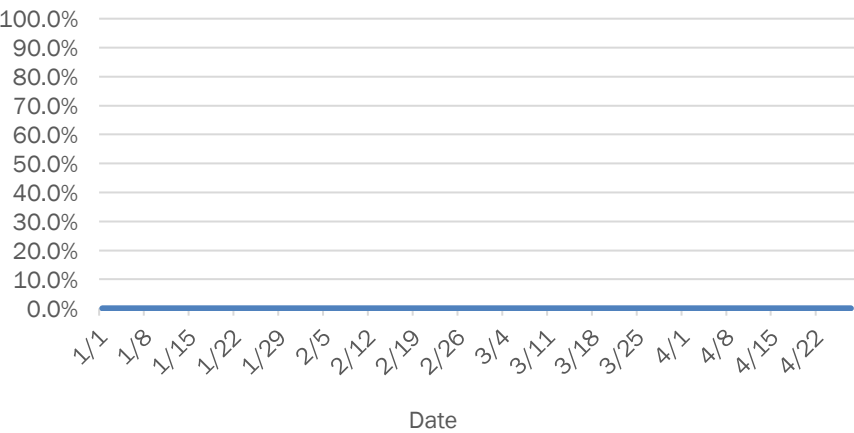

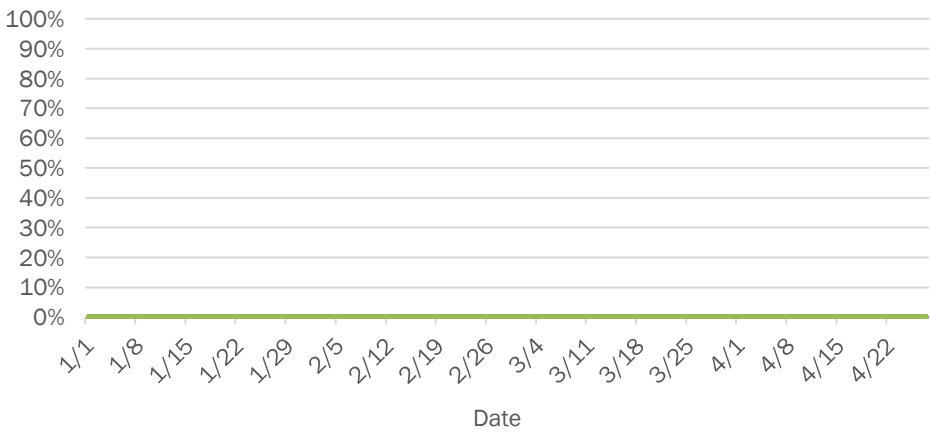


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Liberty County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

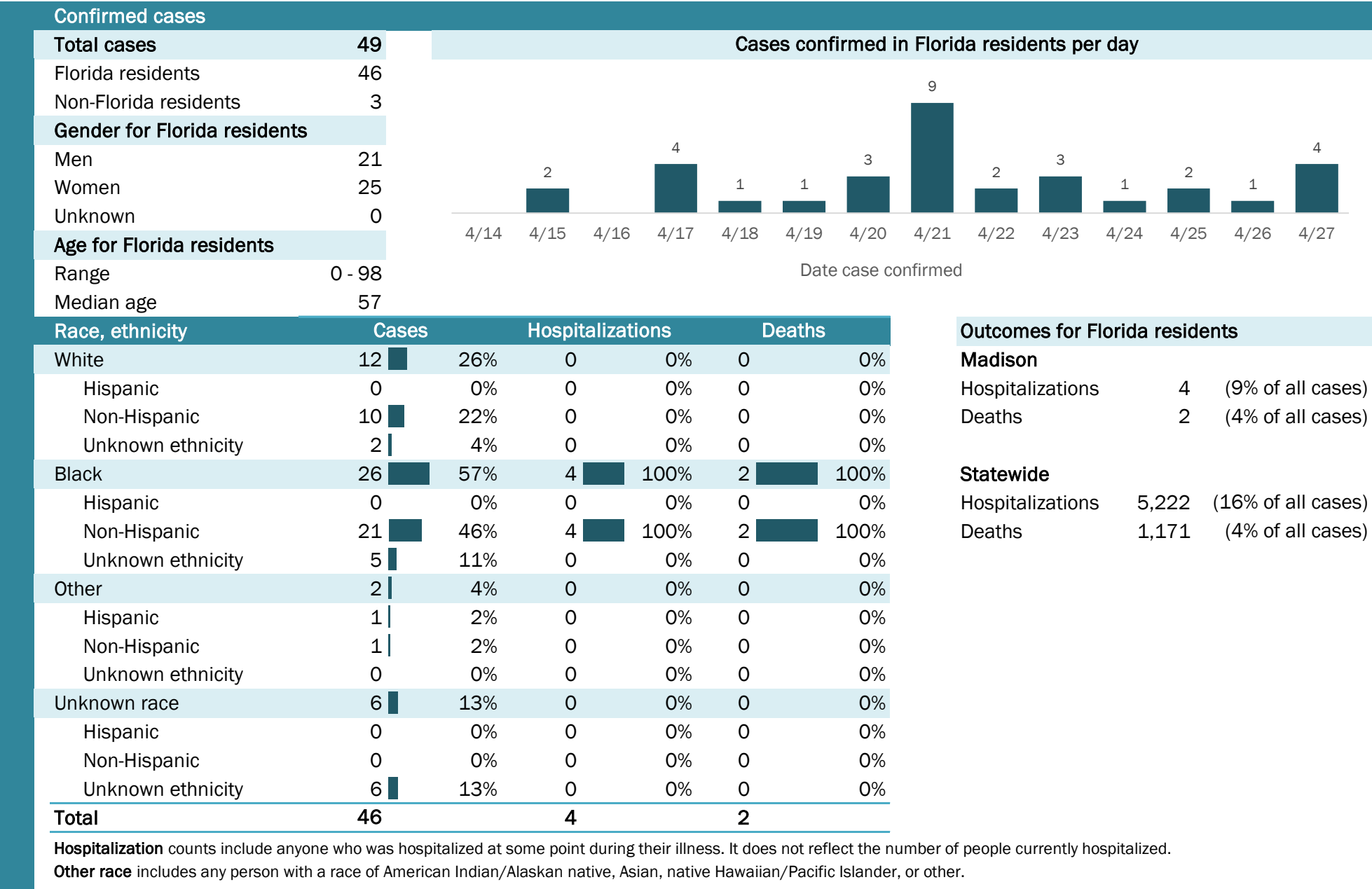

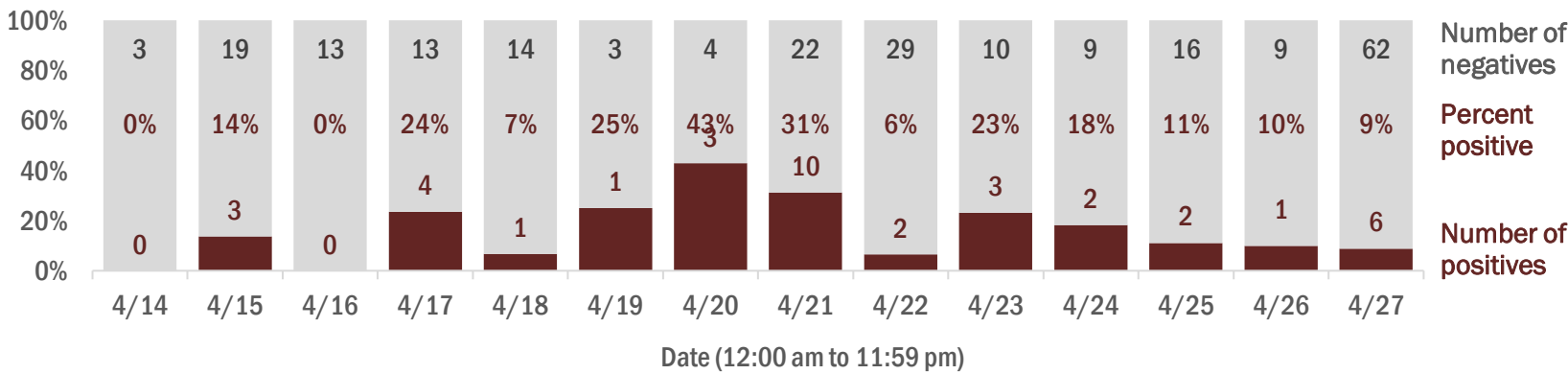

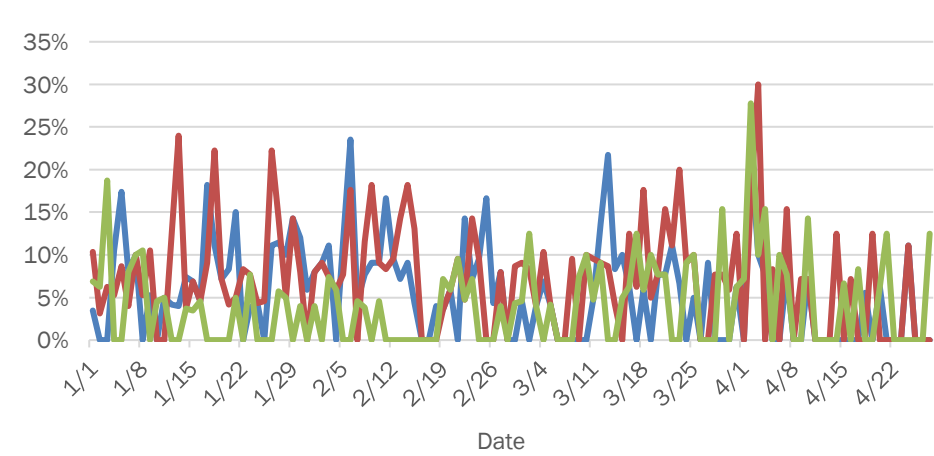


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Madison County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

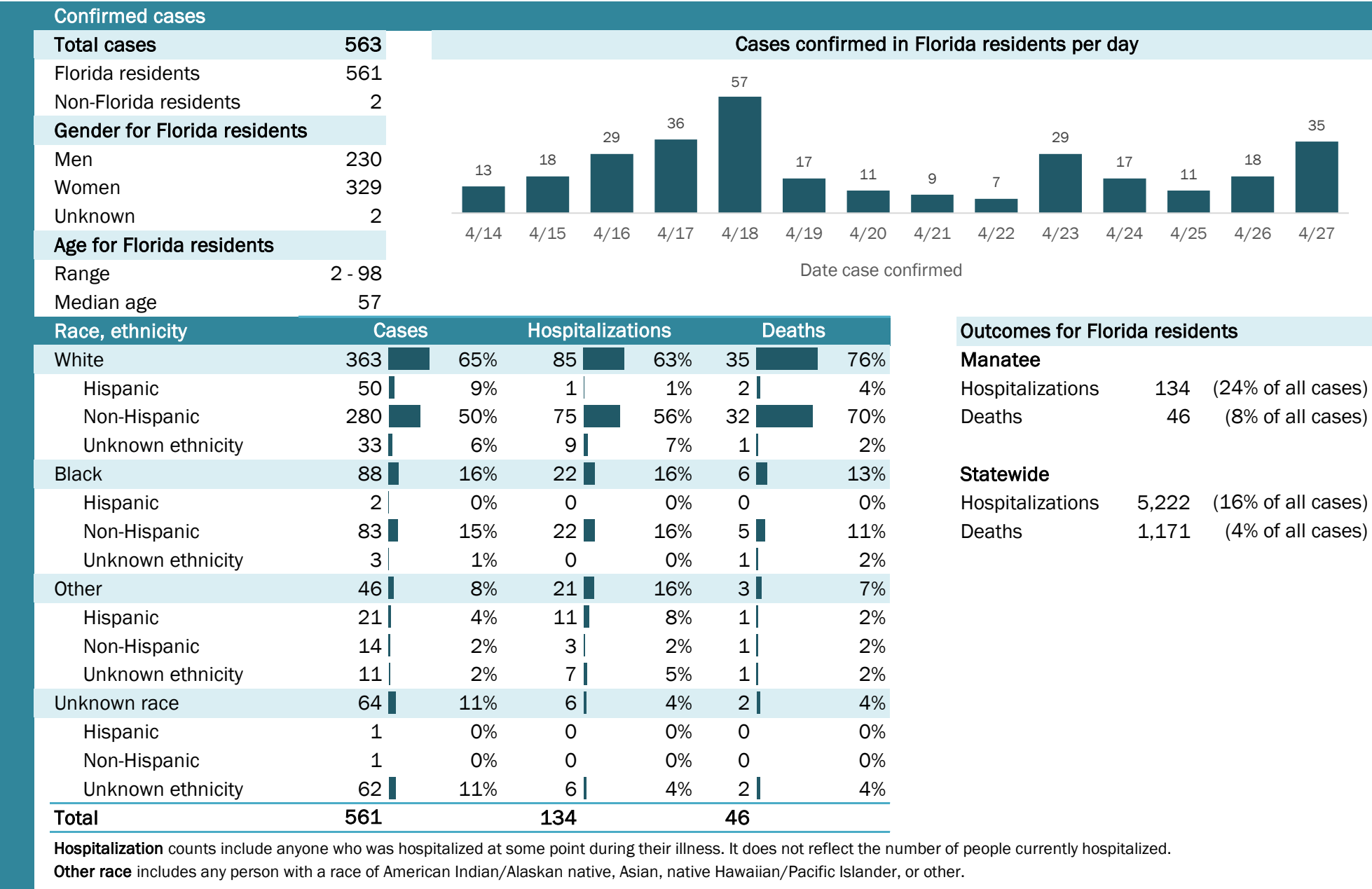

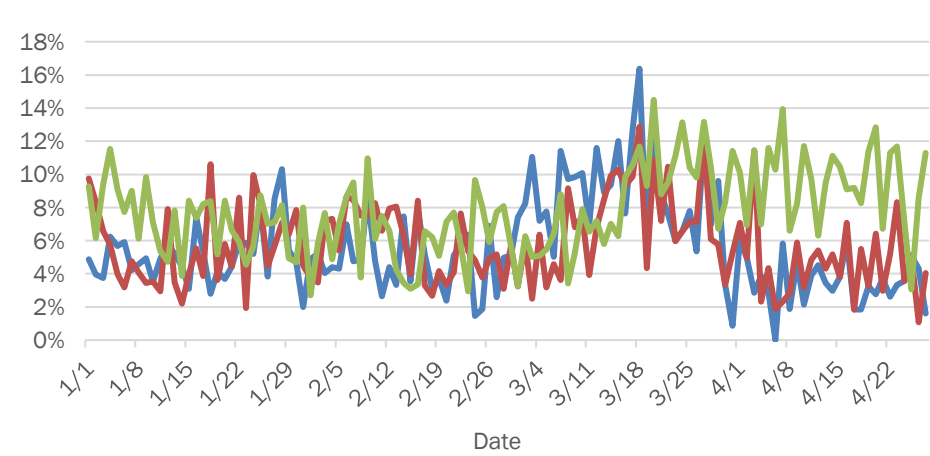


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Martin County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

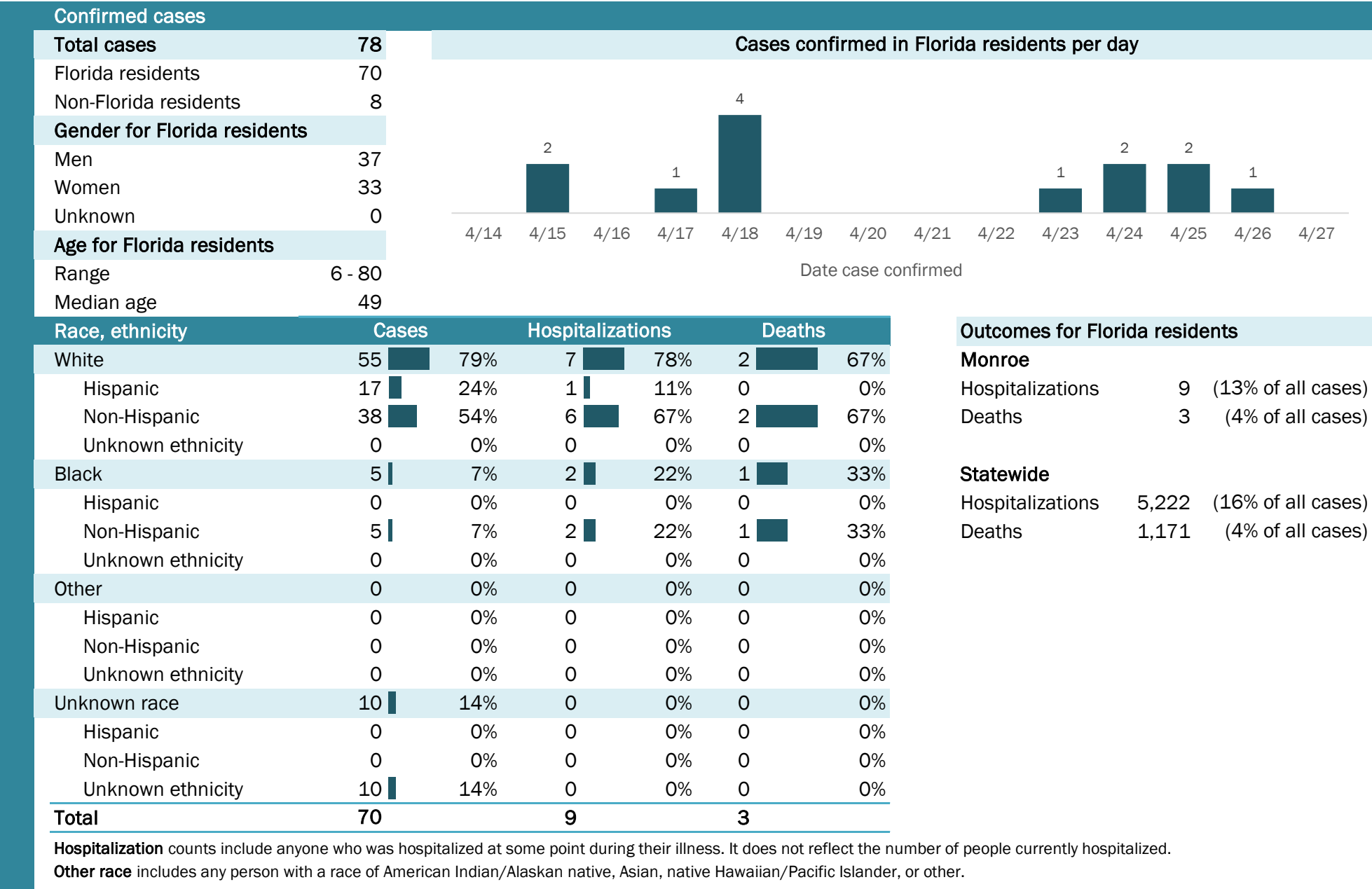

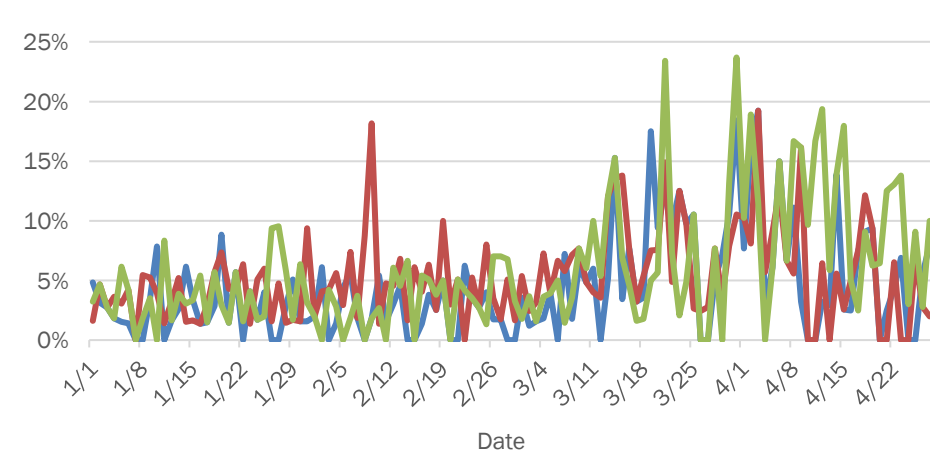


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Nassau County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

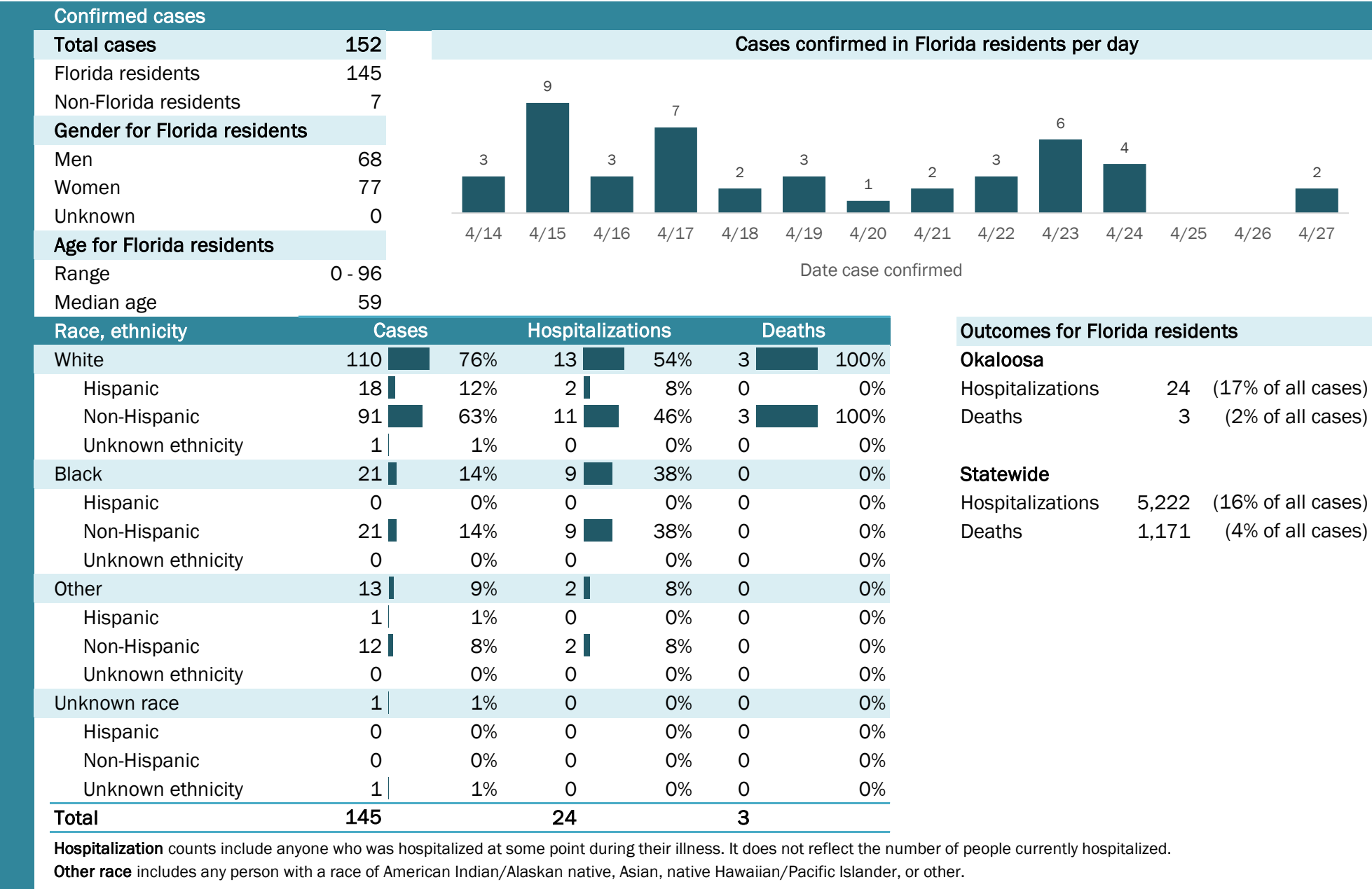

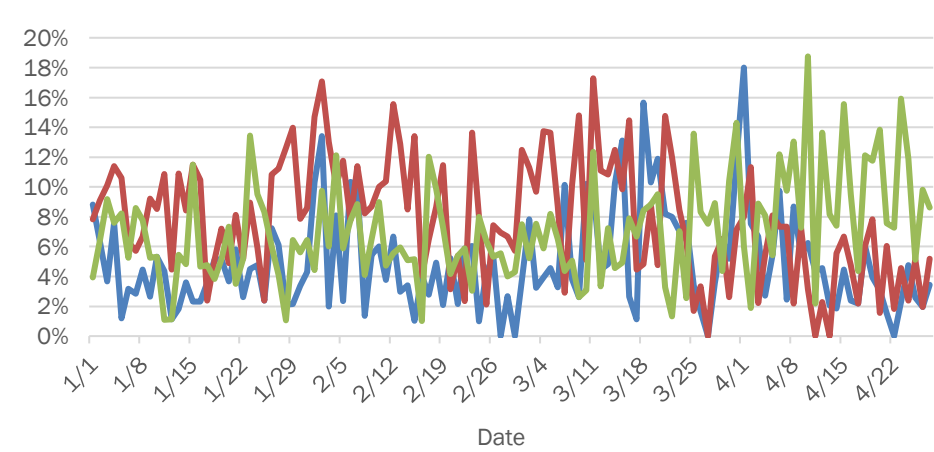


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Okeechobee County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

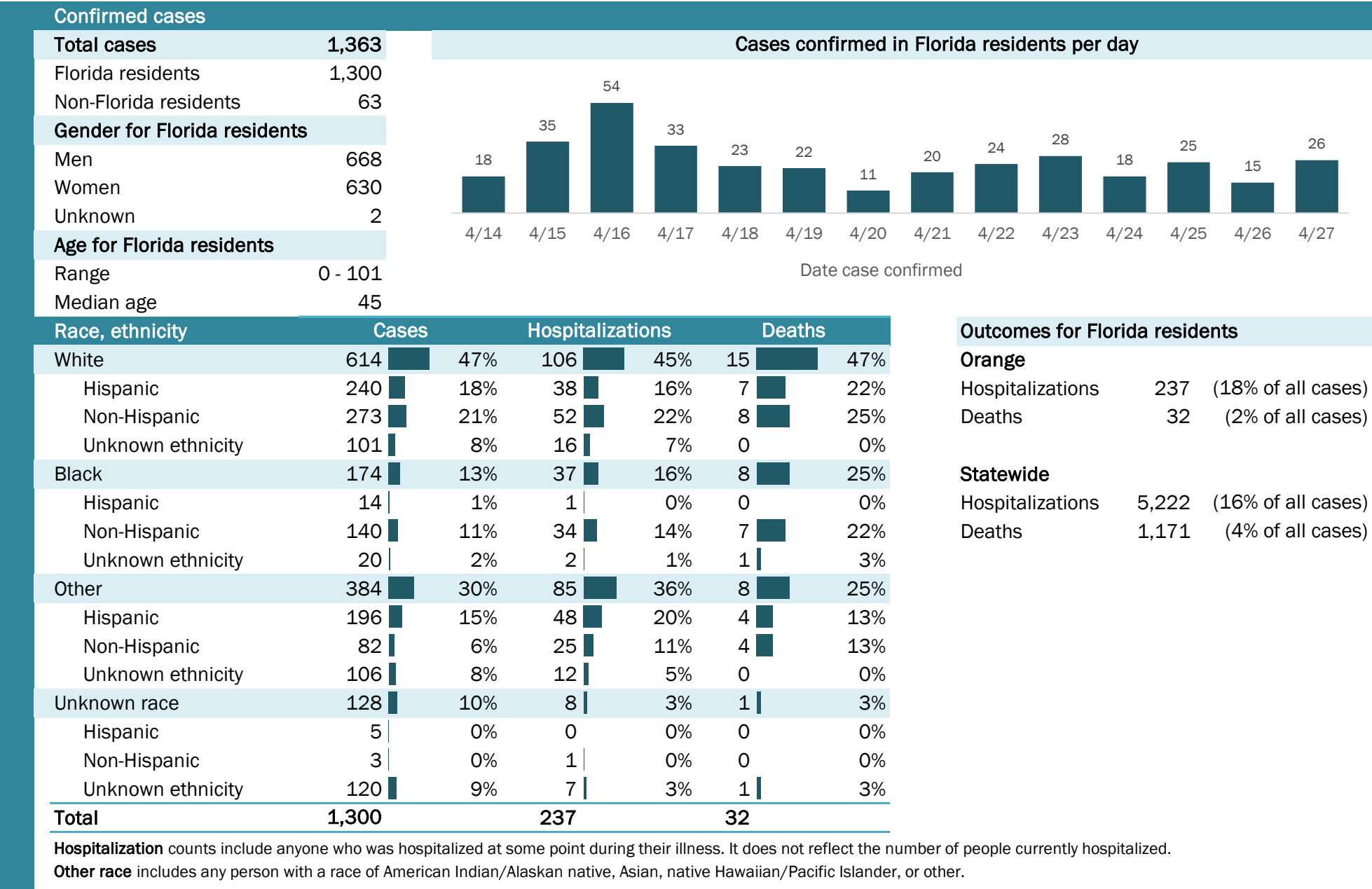

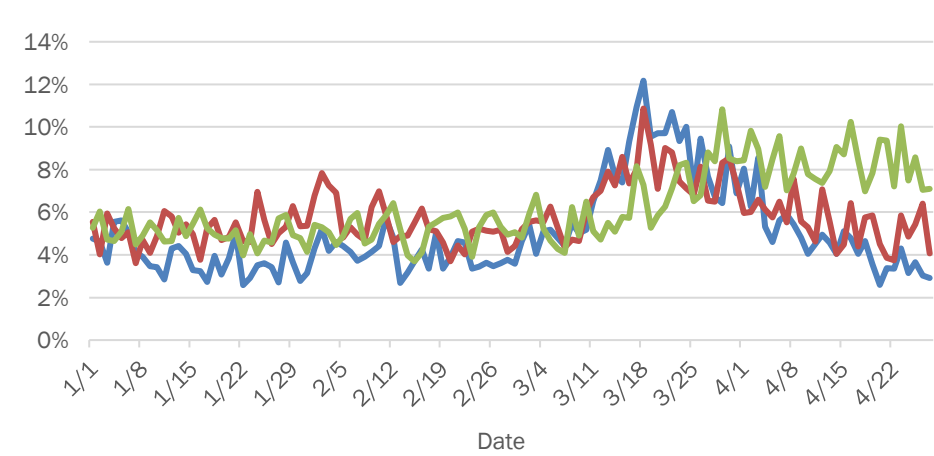


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Pinellas County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

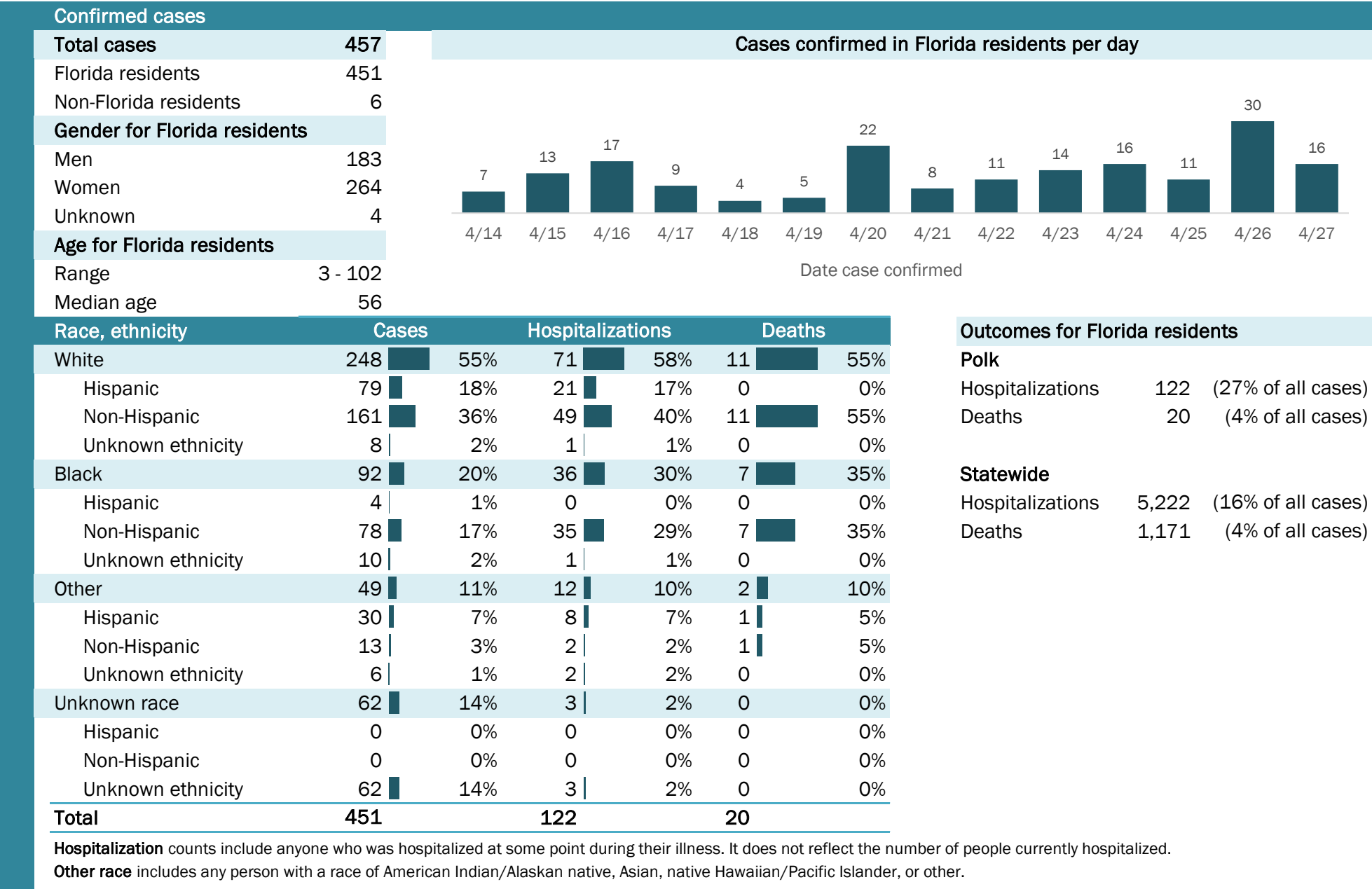

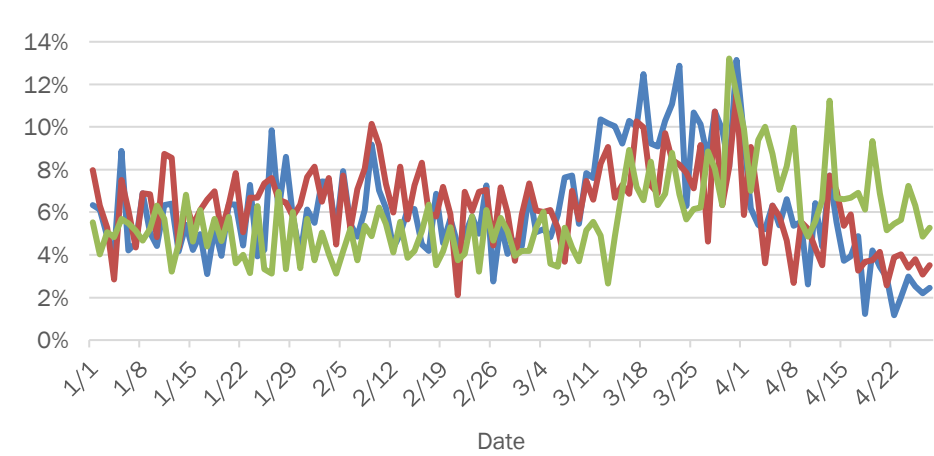


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Lucie County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

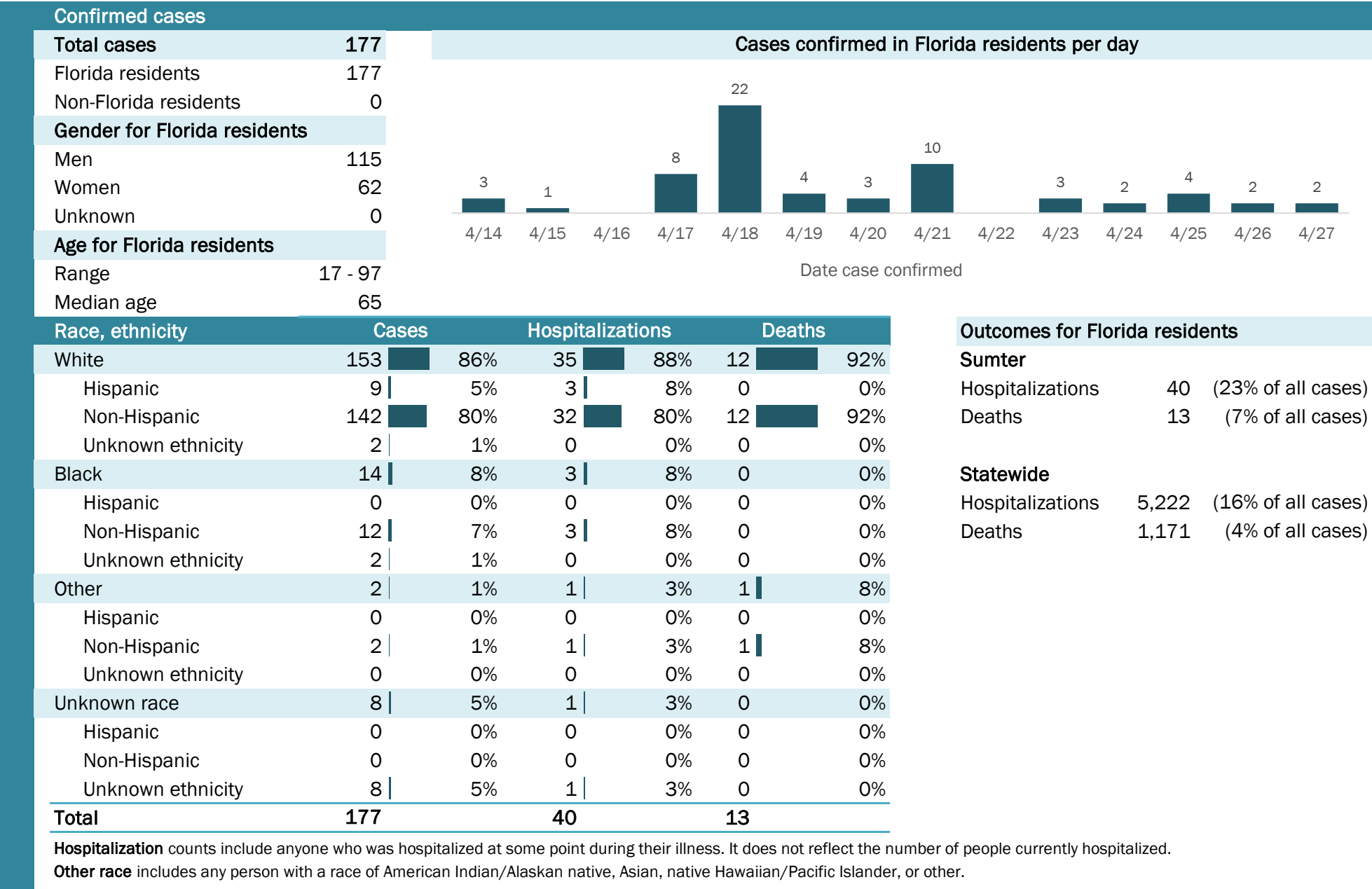

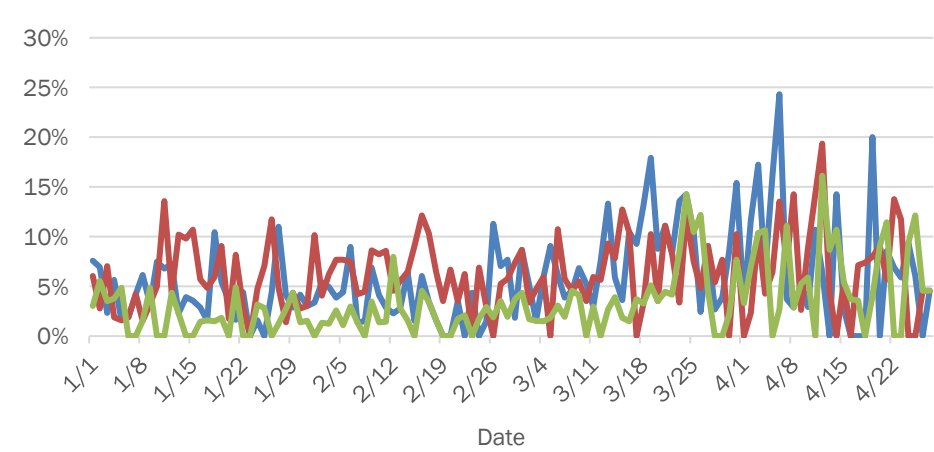


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Suwannee County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

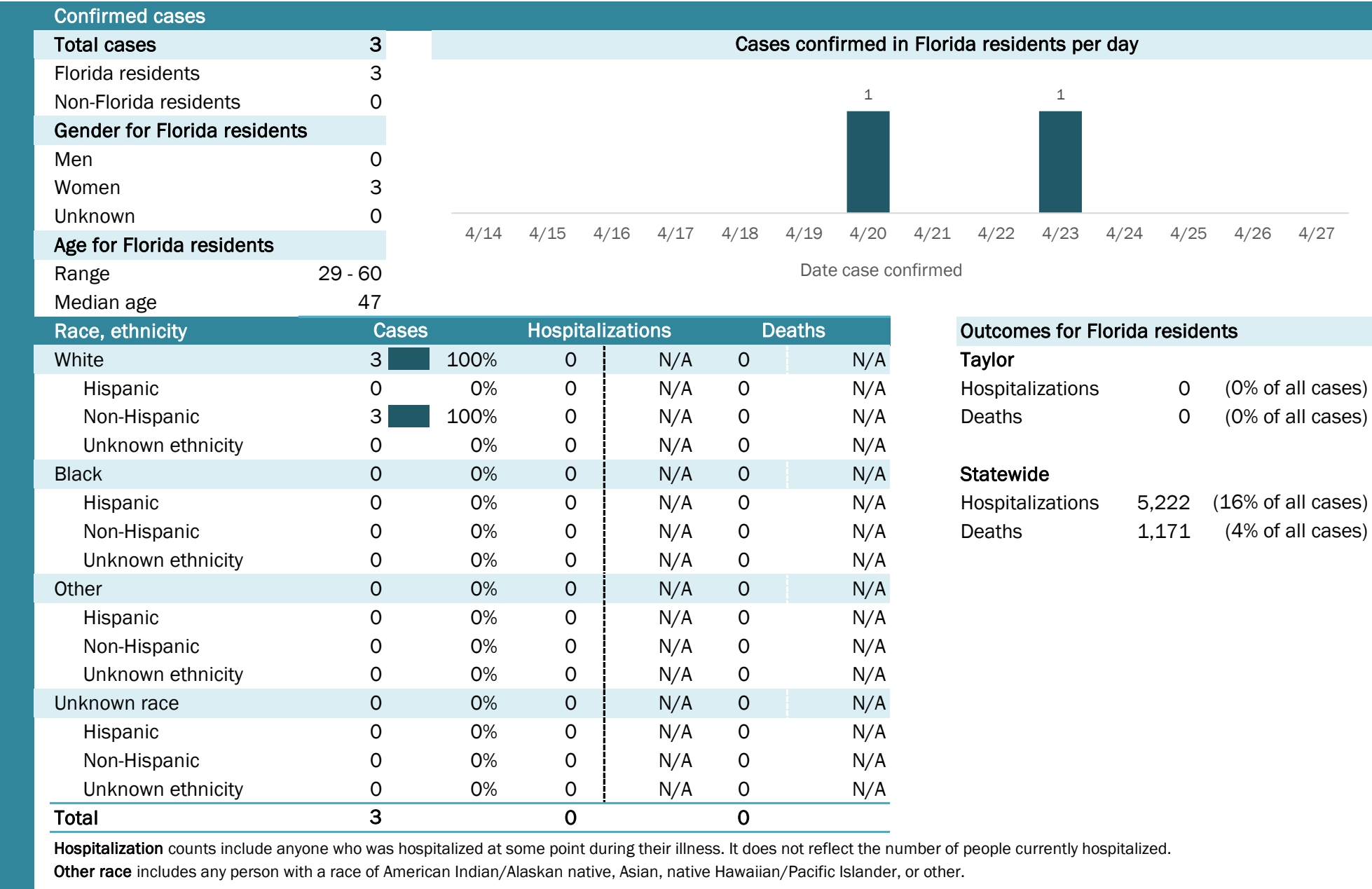

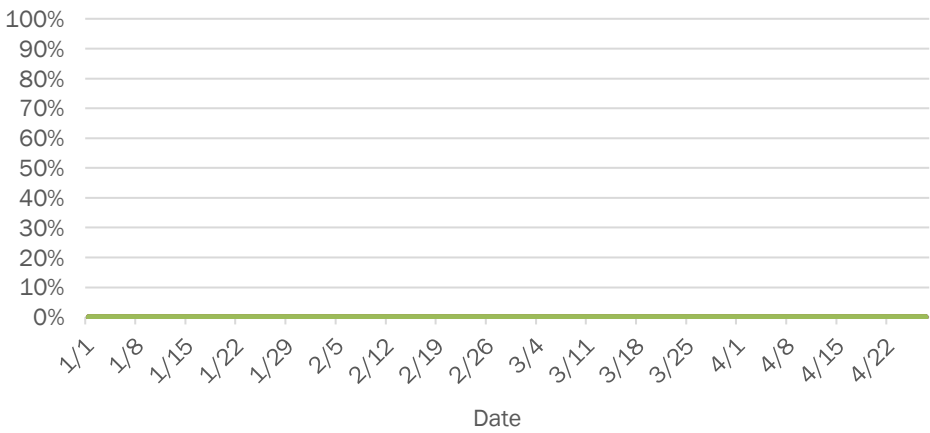


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

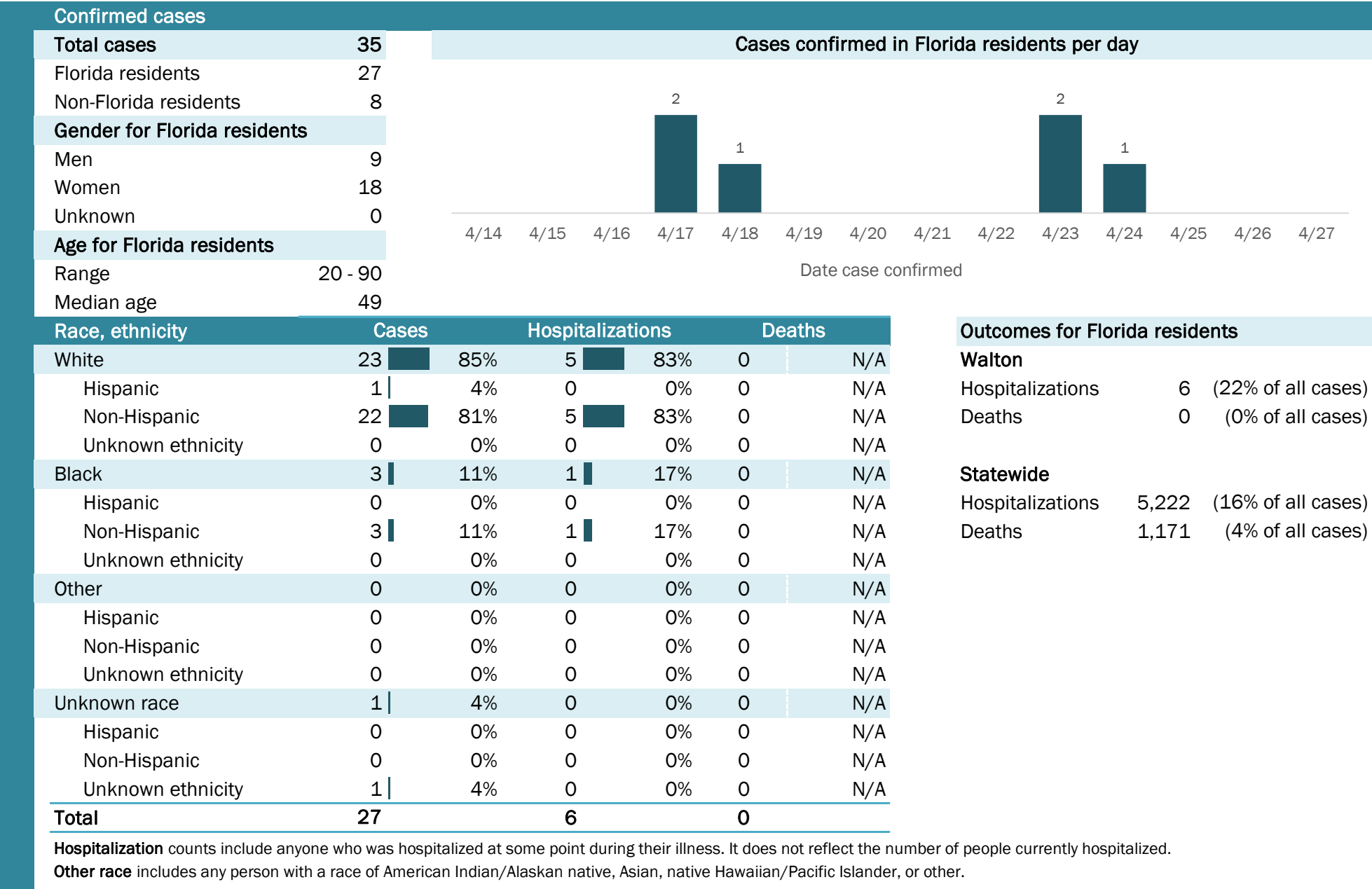
