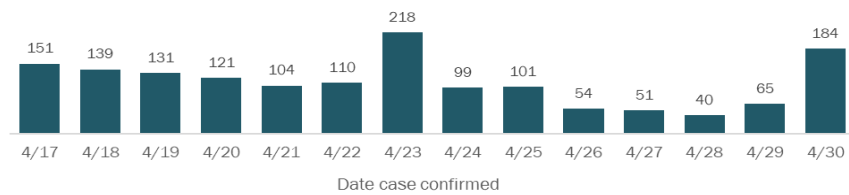

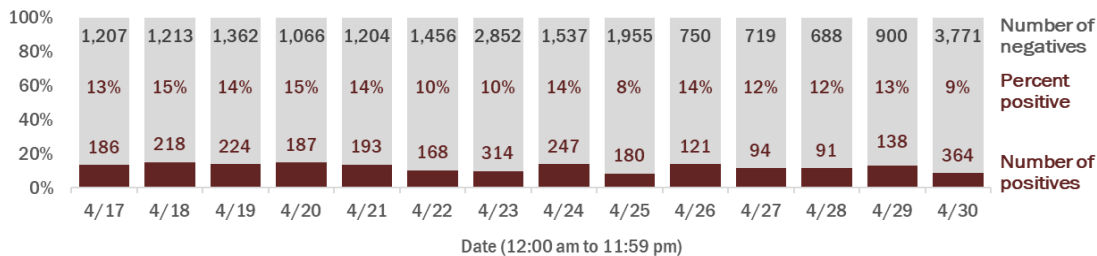

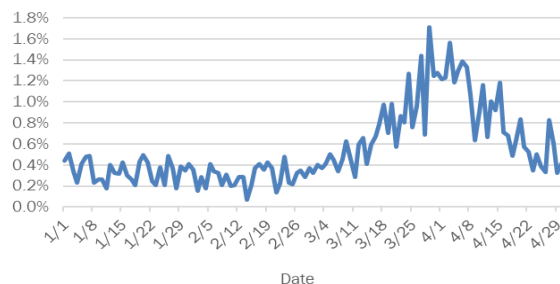

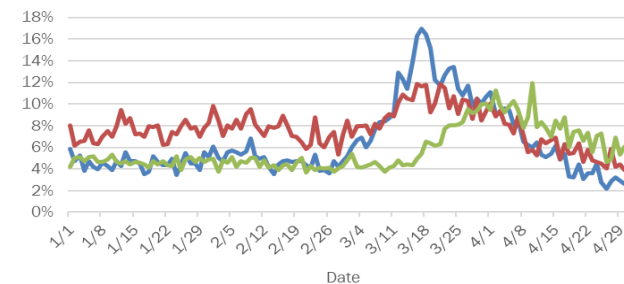


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County

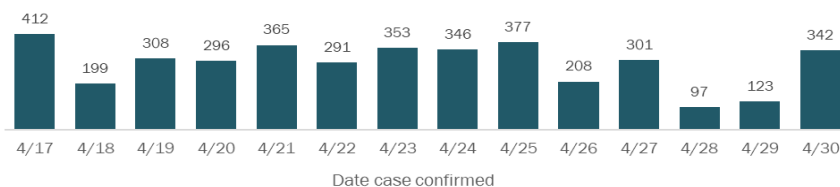

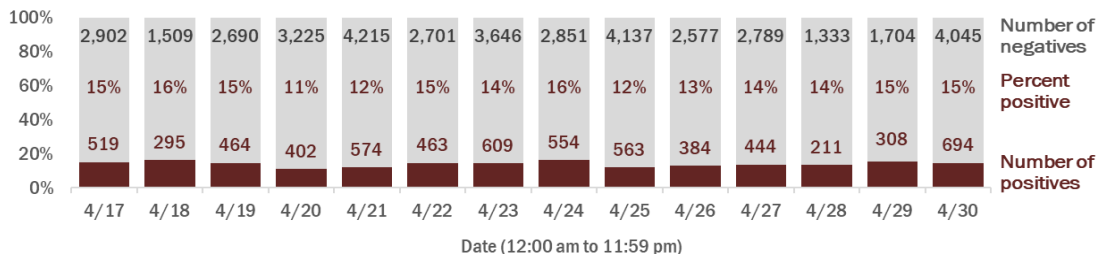

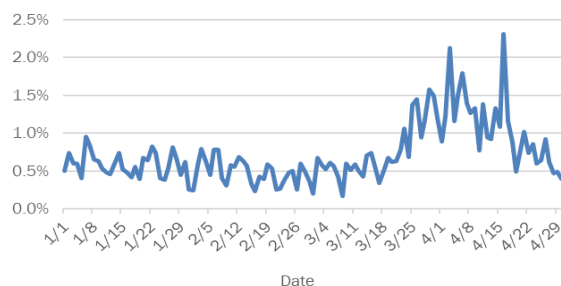

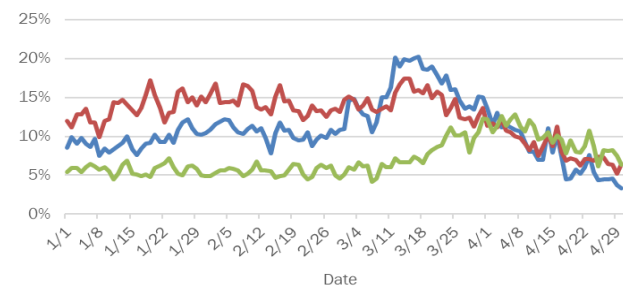


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Dade County

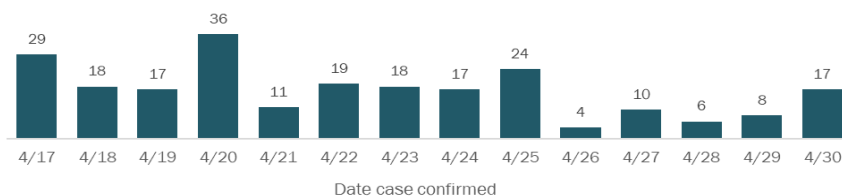

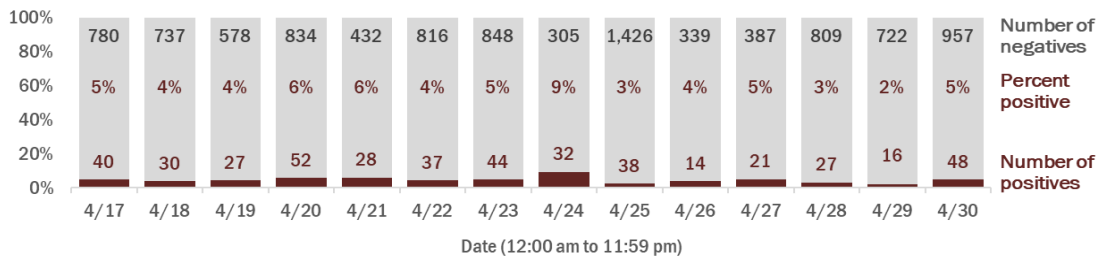

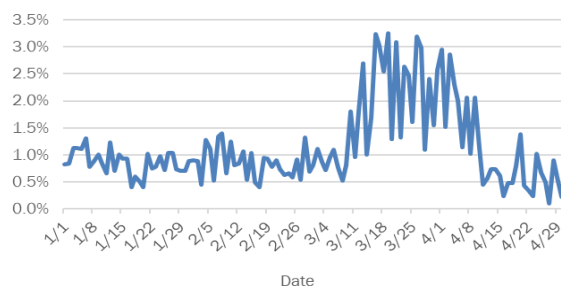

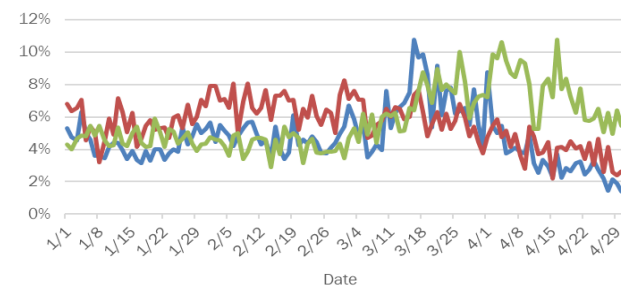


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Duval County

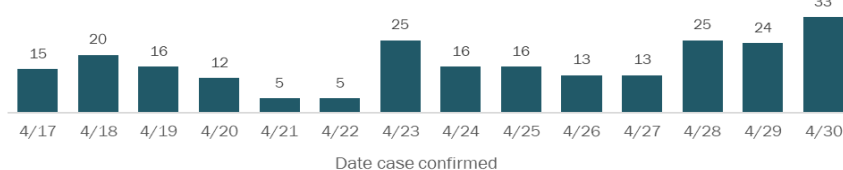

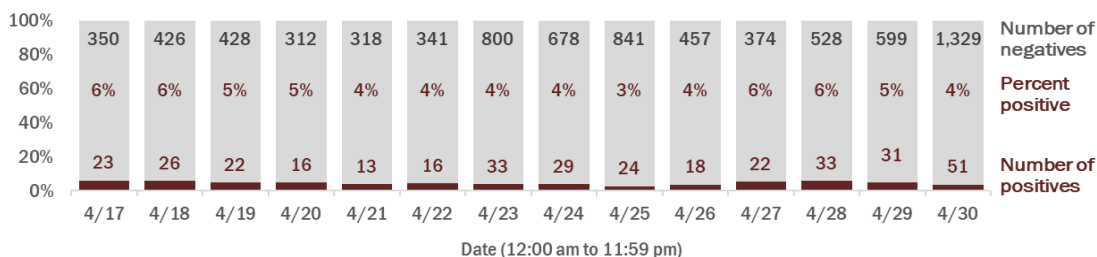

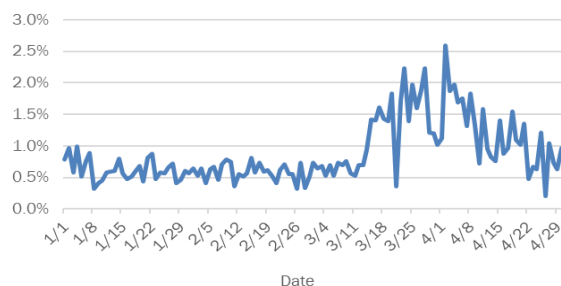

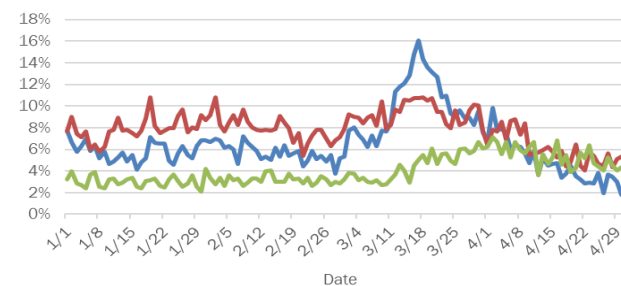


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County

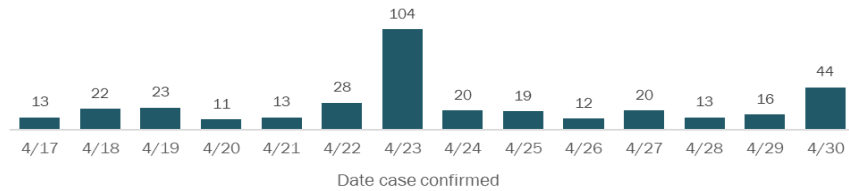

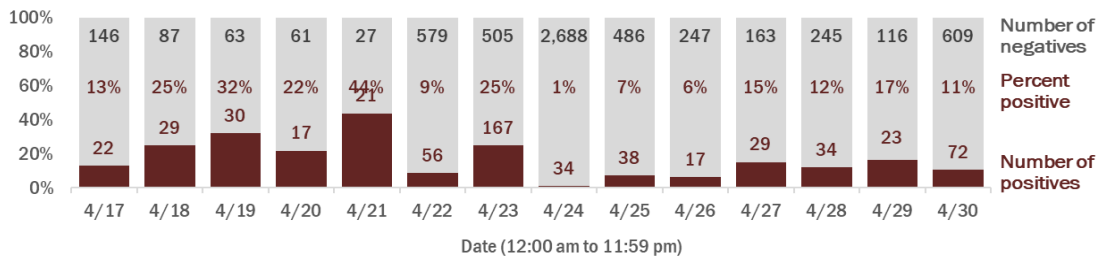

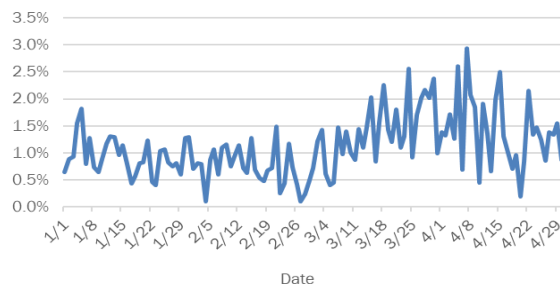

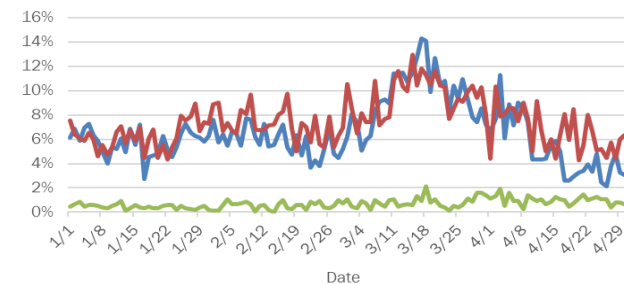


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Lee County

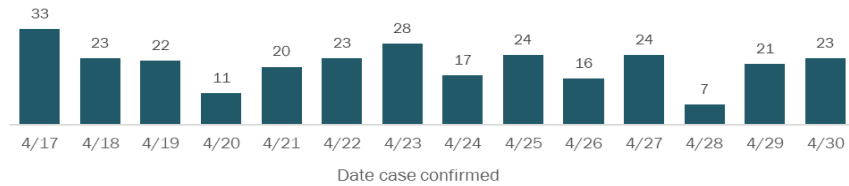

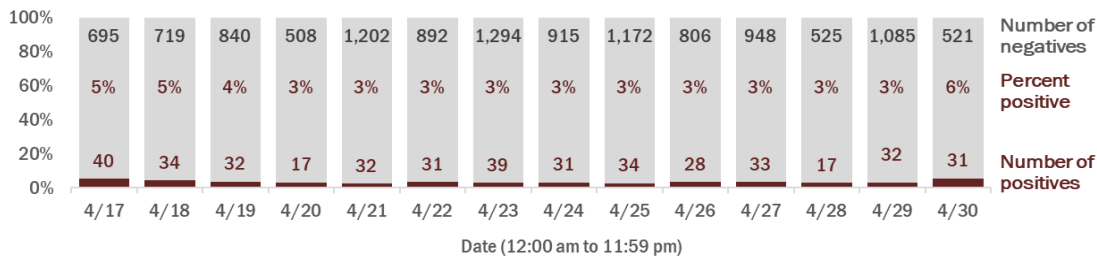

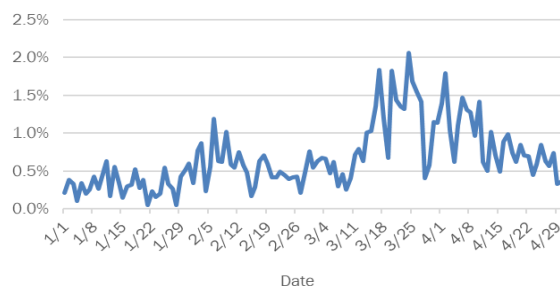

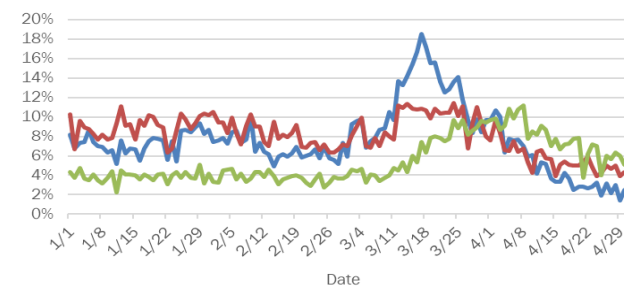


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Orange County

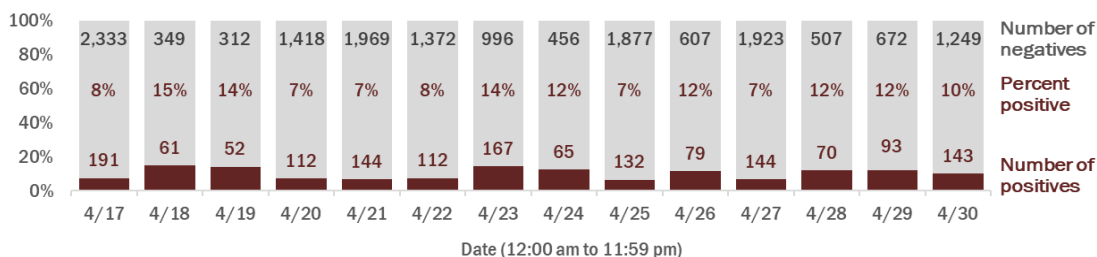

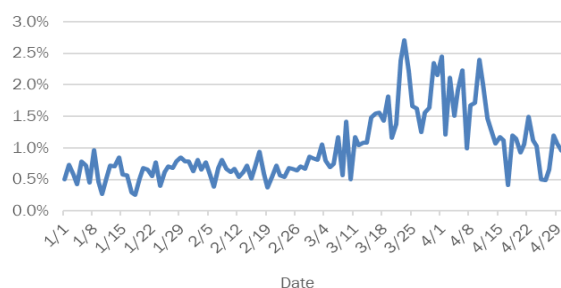

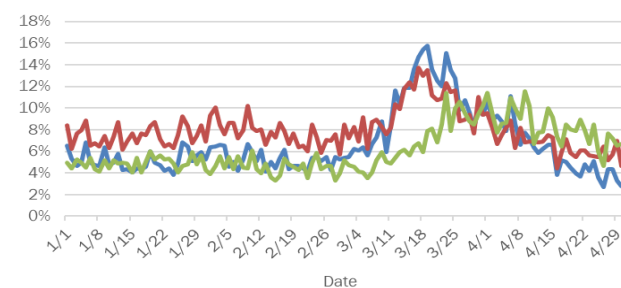


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Palm Beach County

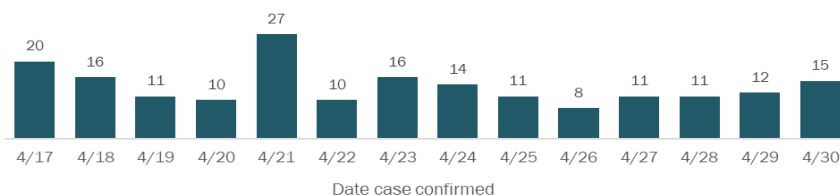

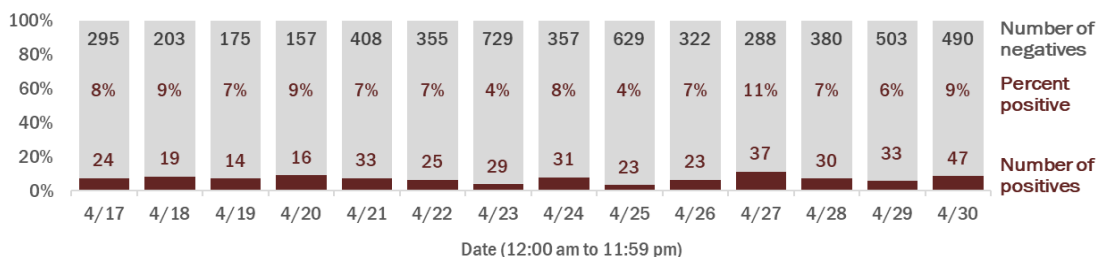

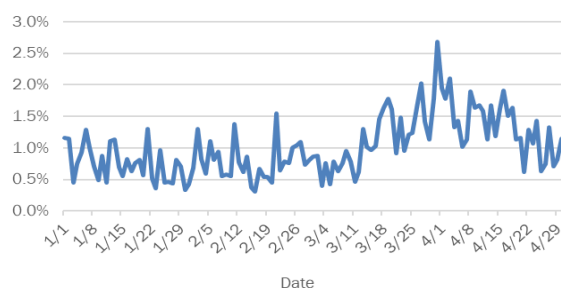

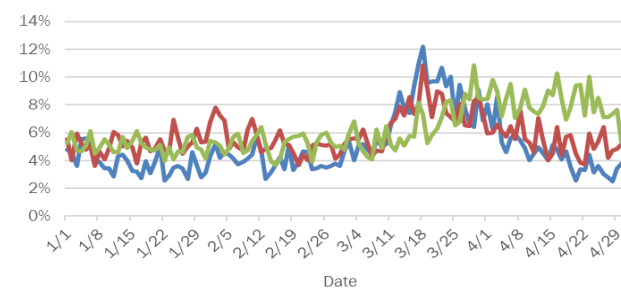


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Pinellas County
