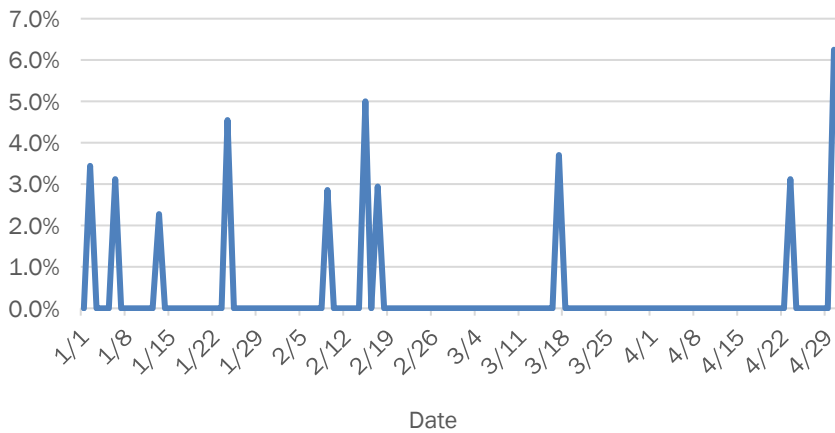

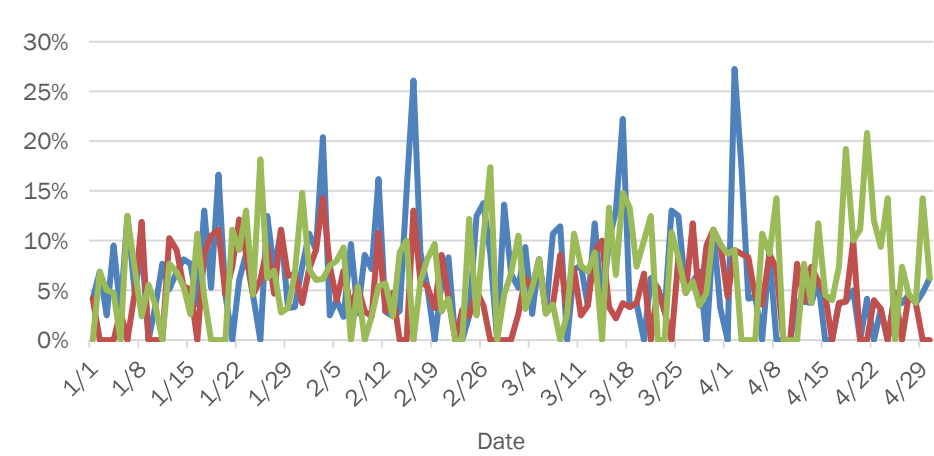


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Baker County

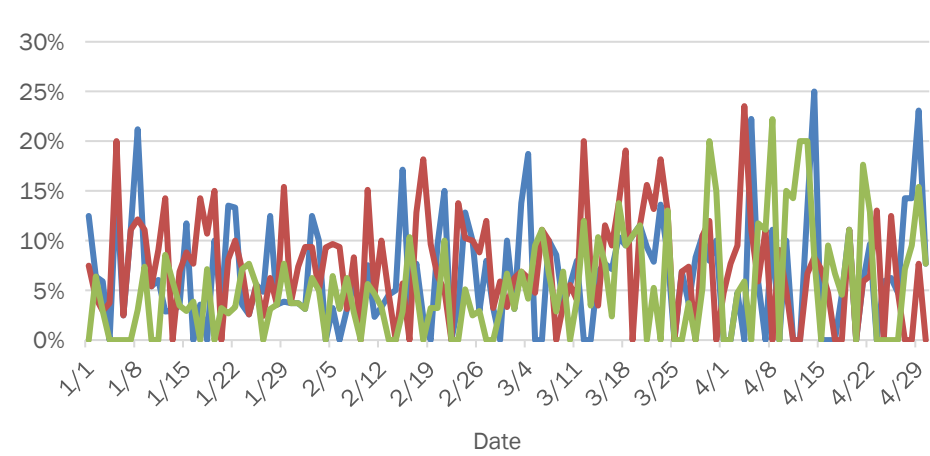


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Calhoun County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

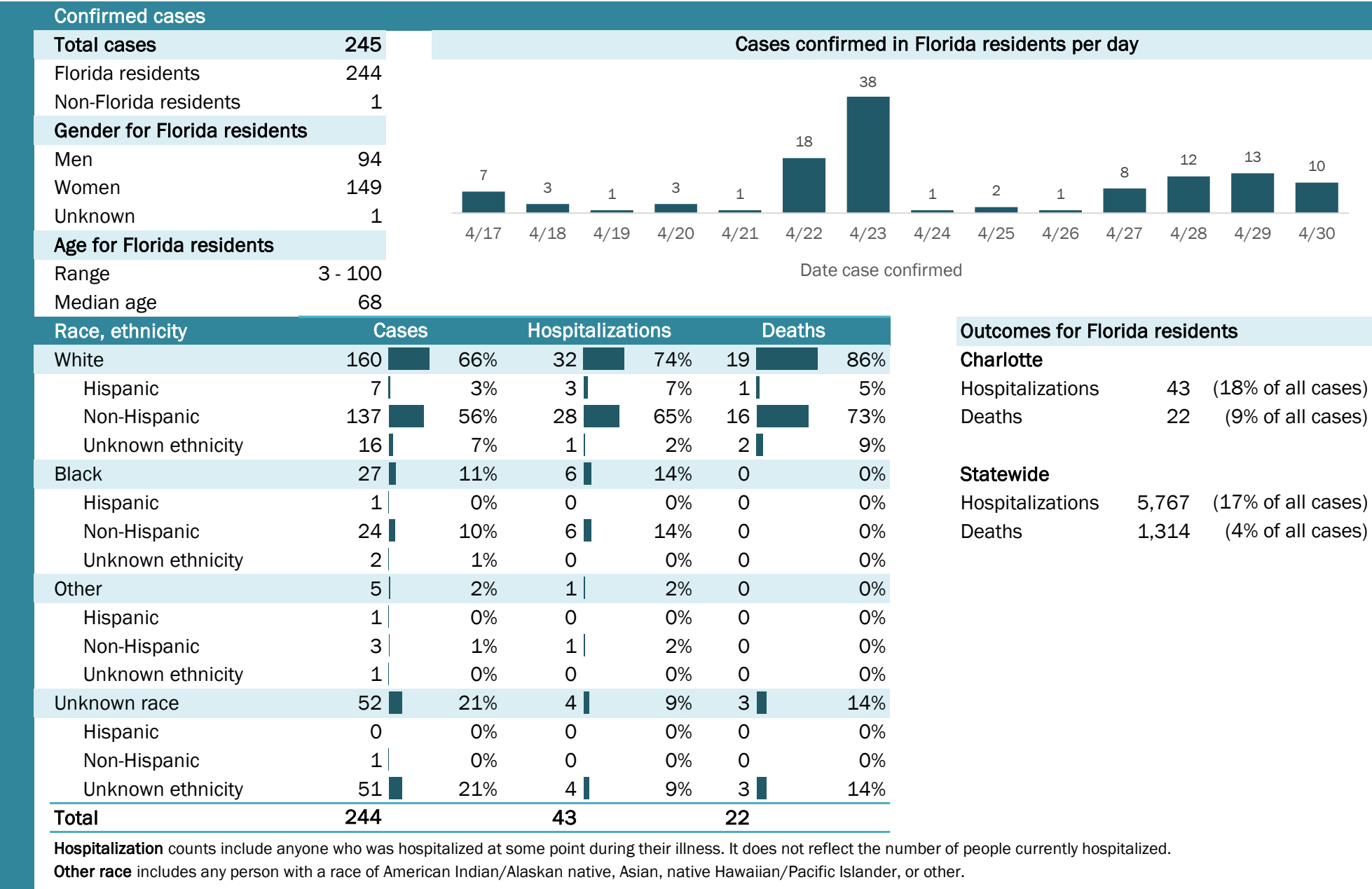

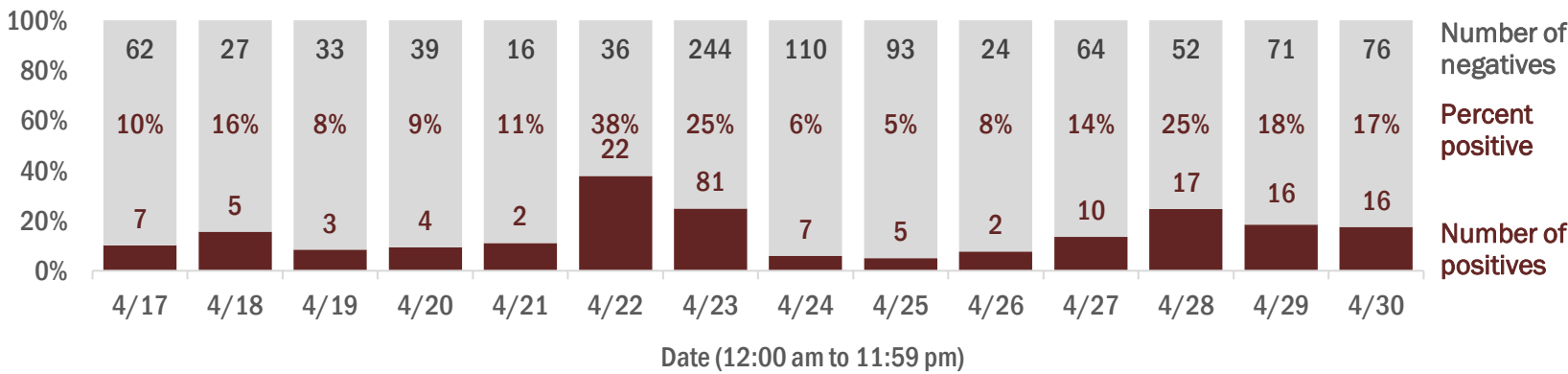

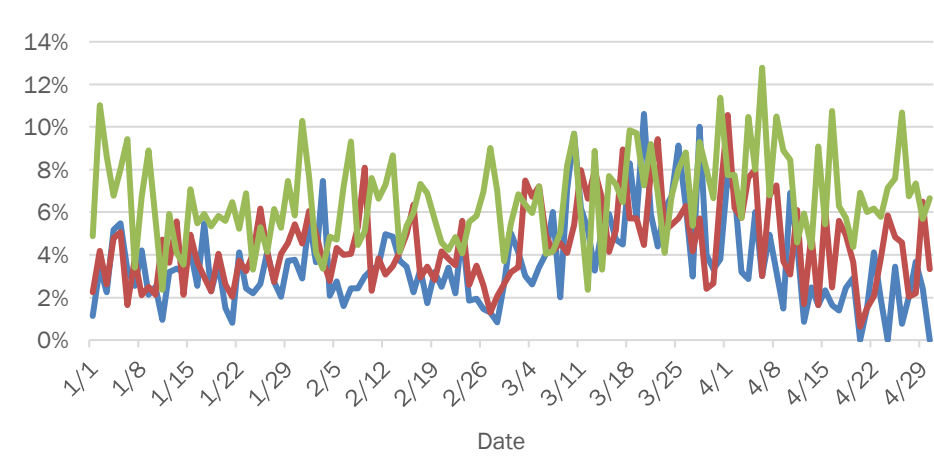


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Charlotte County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

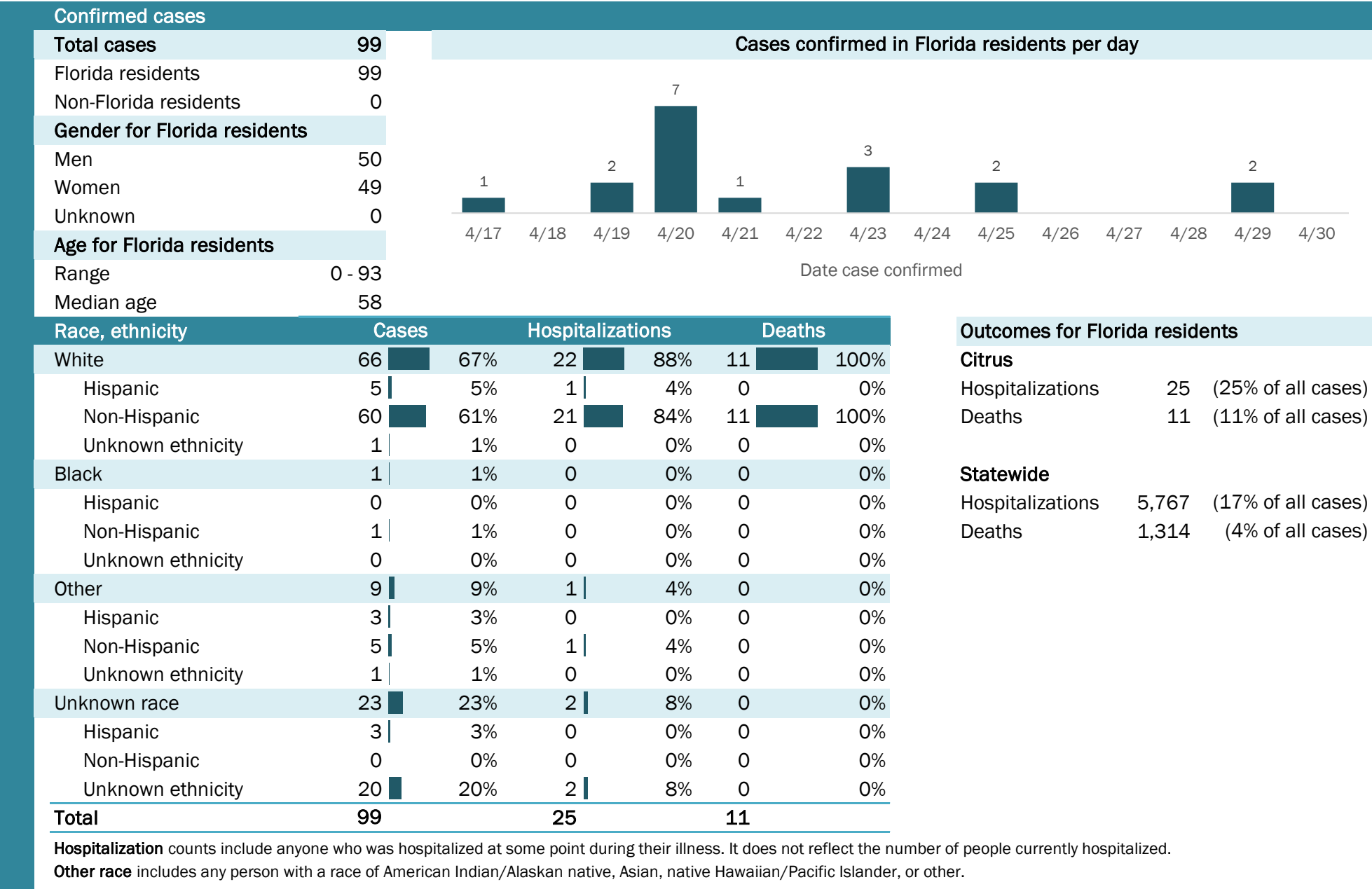

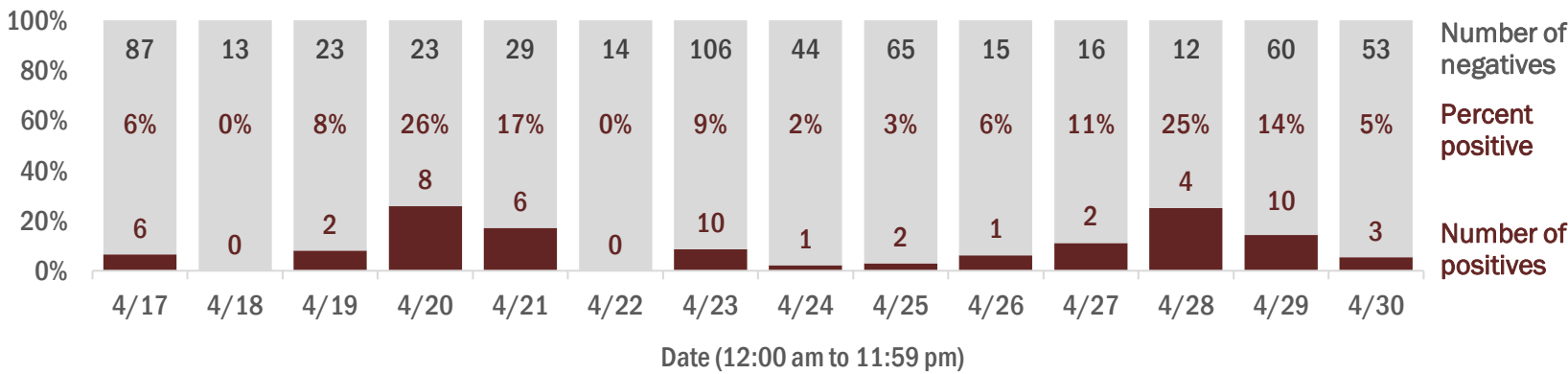

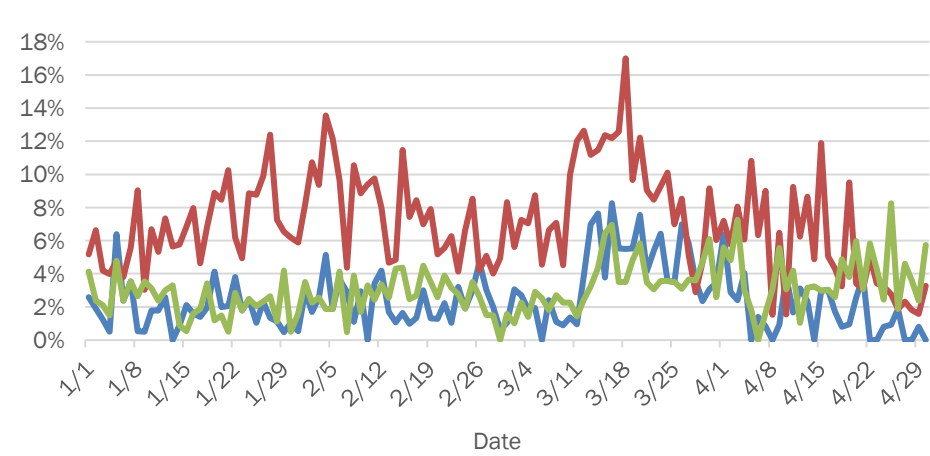


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Citrus County

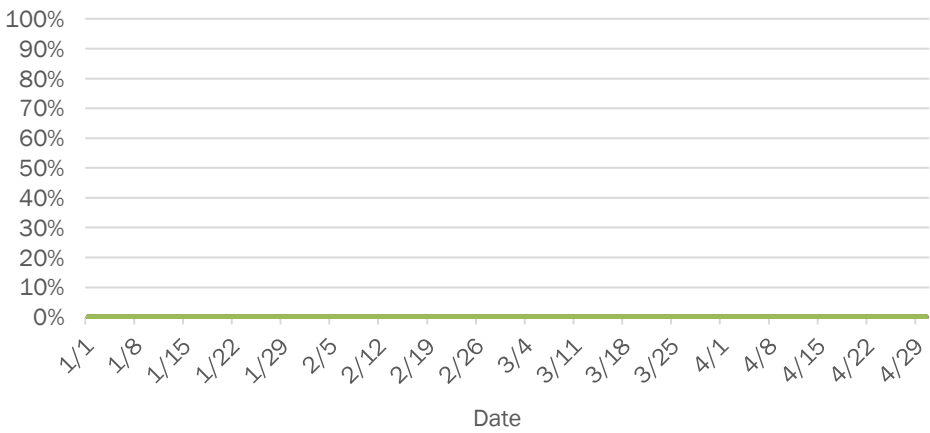


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Franklin County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

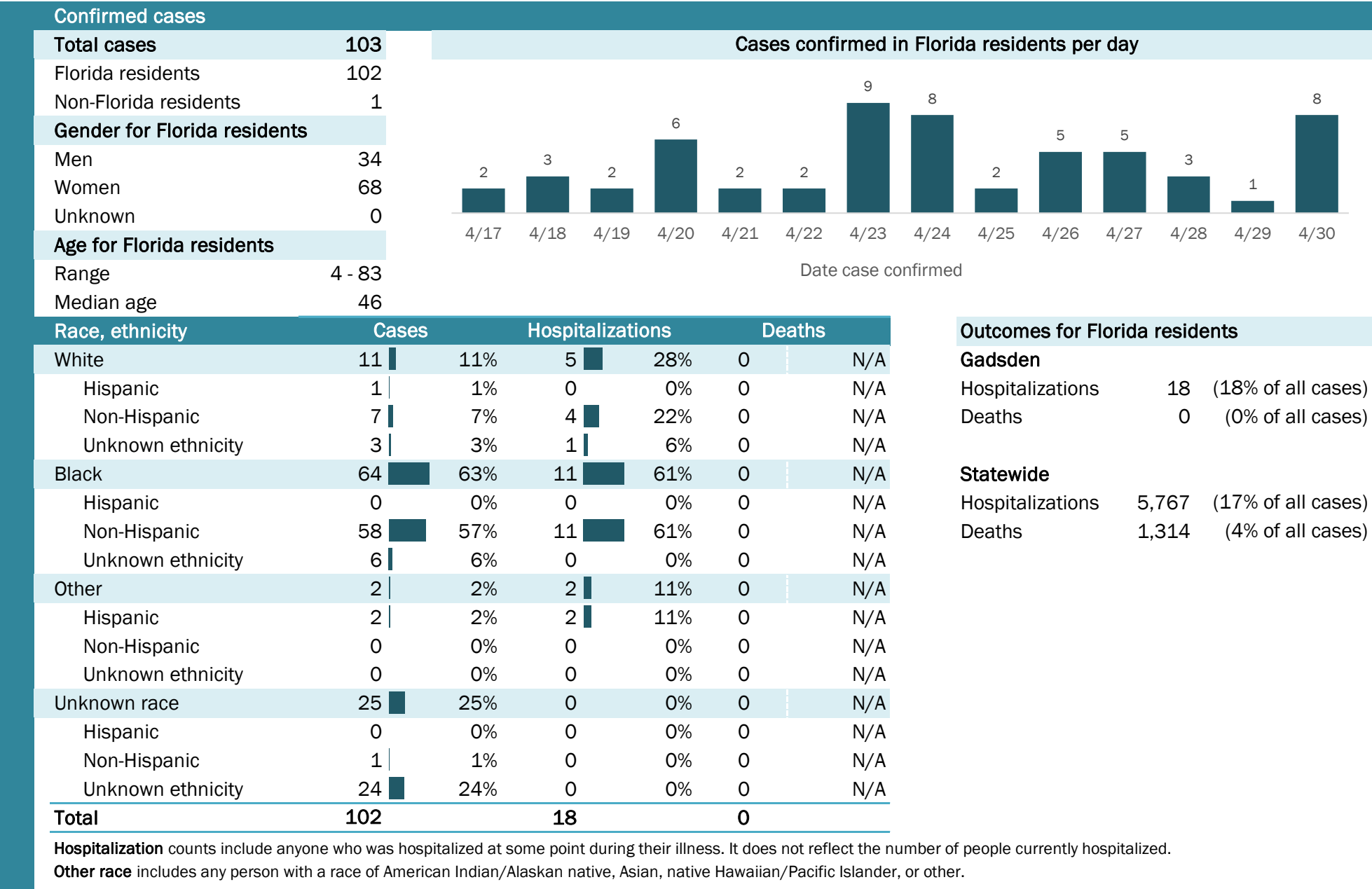

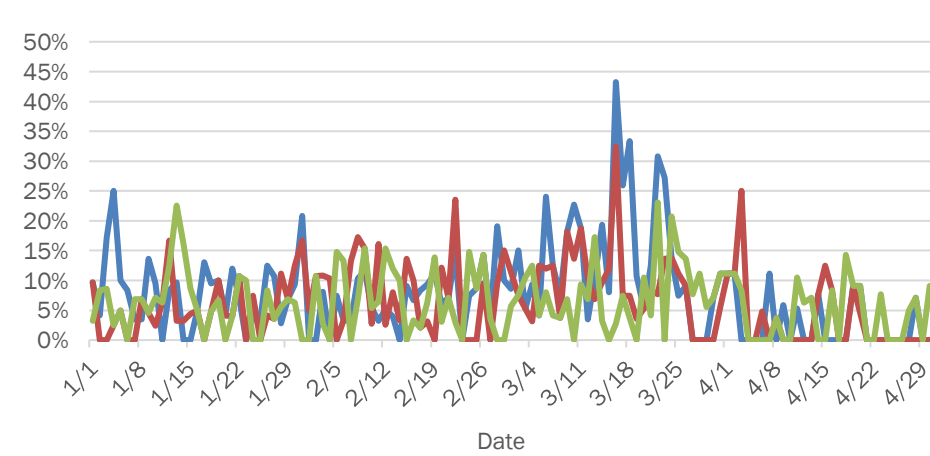


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

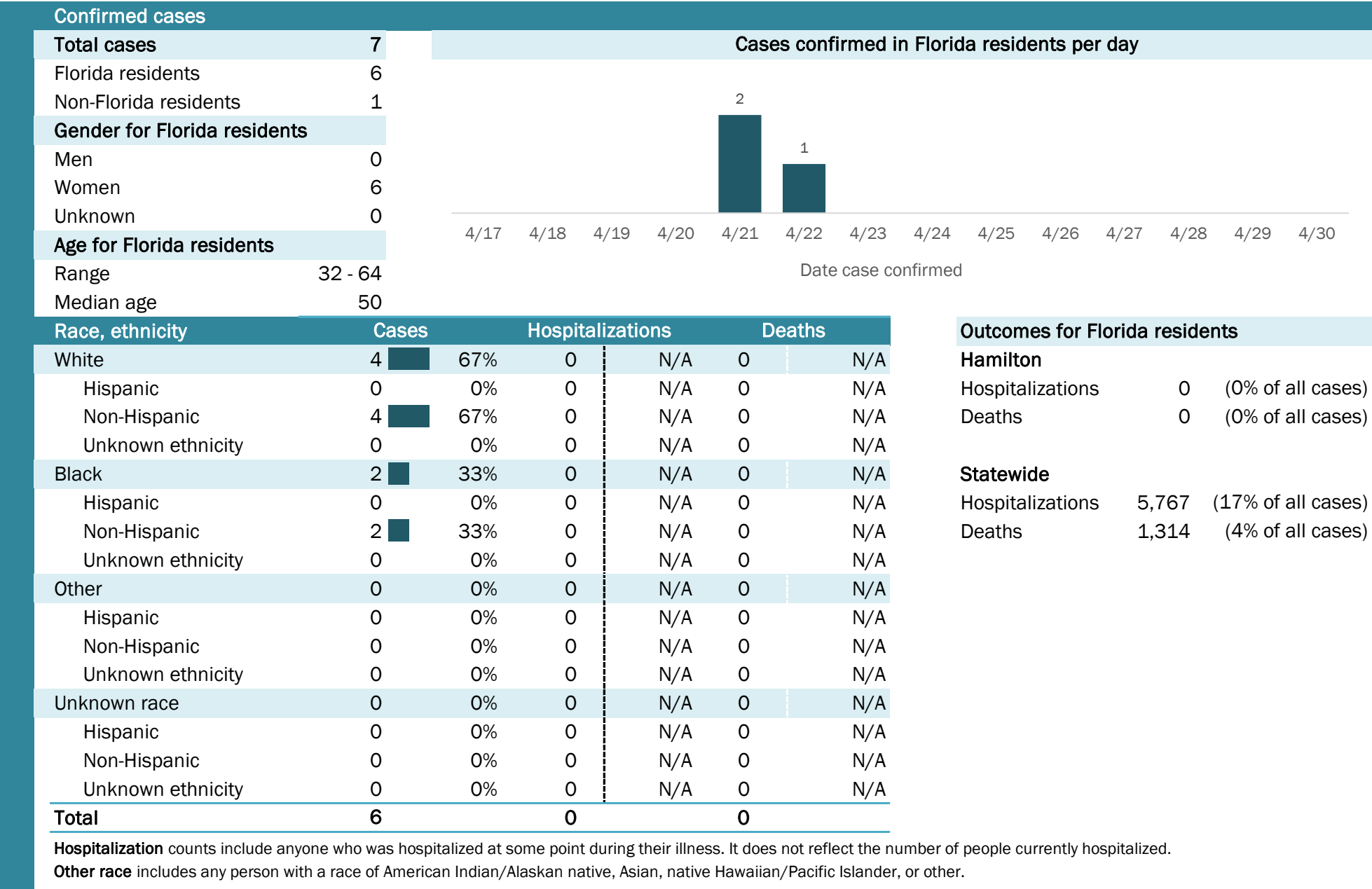

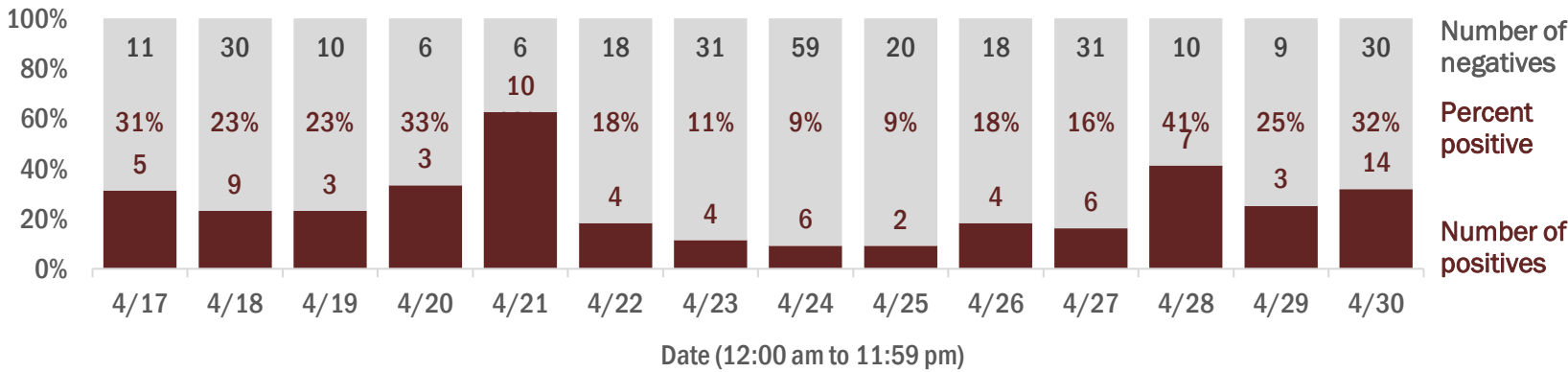

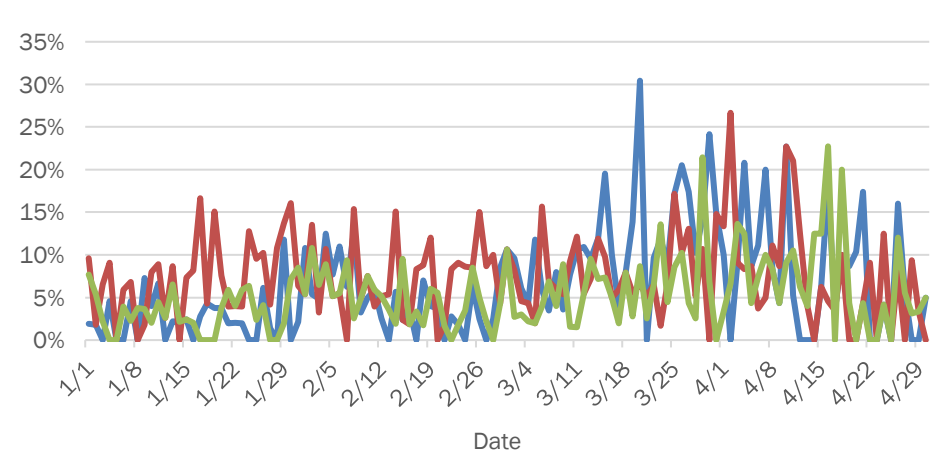


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hendry County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

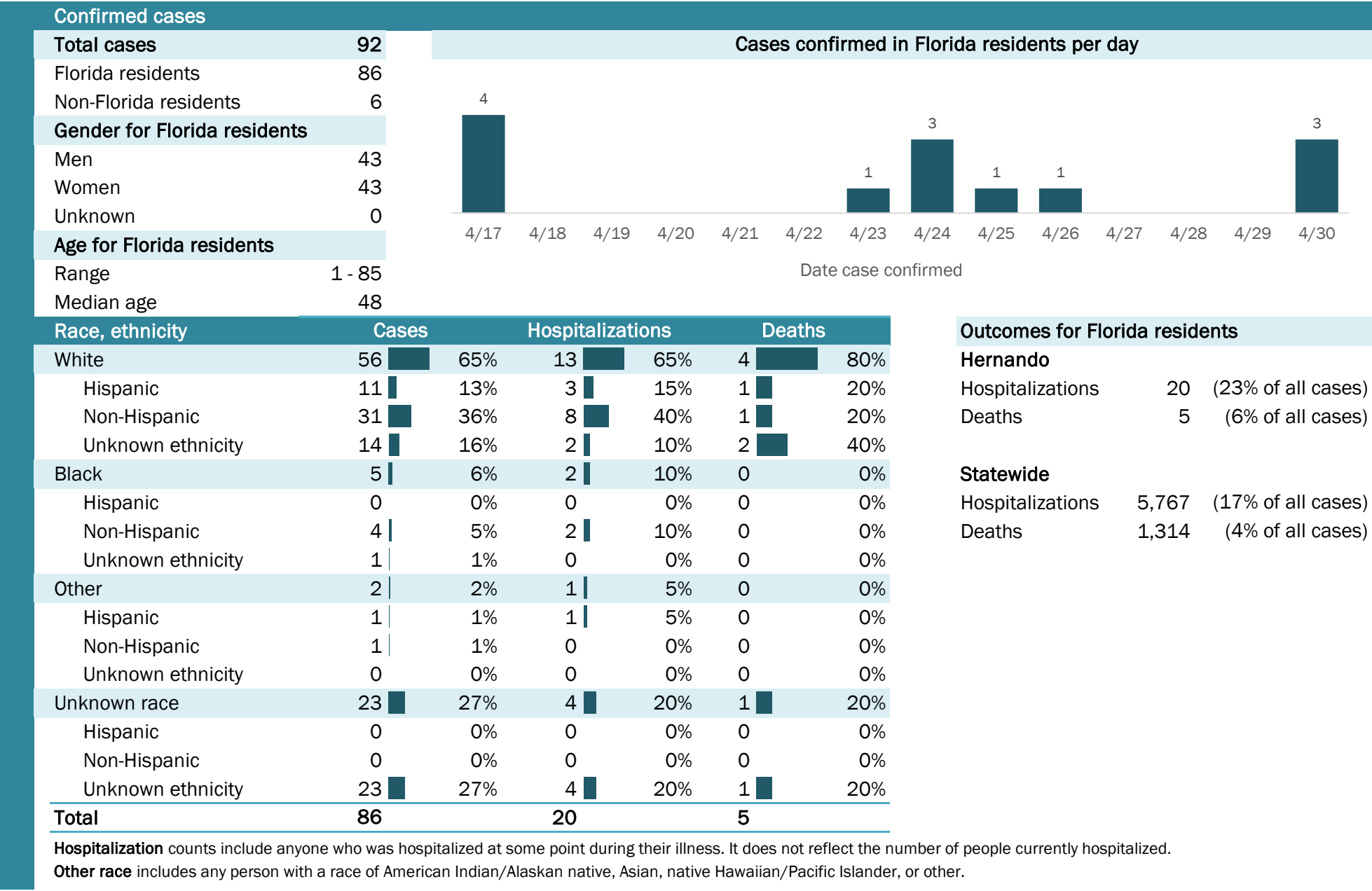

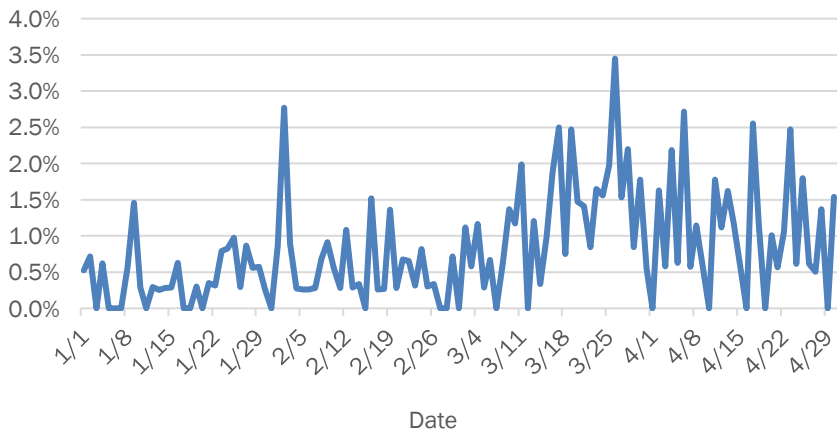

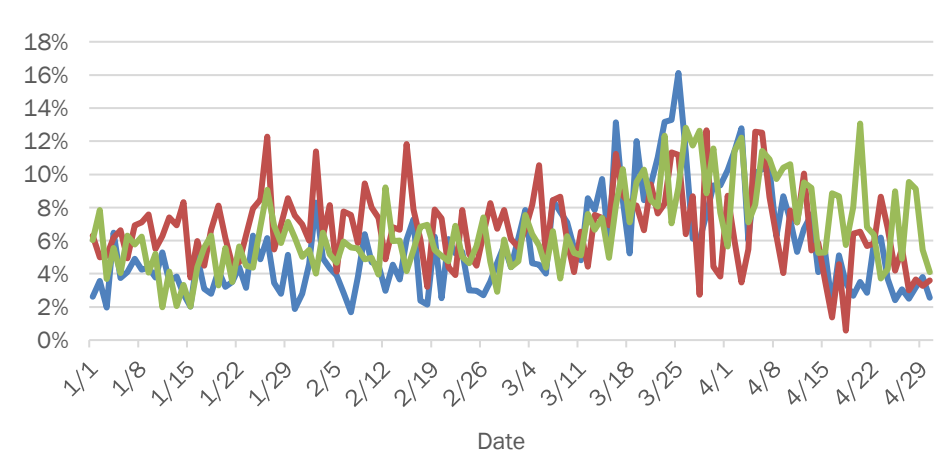


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hernando County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

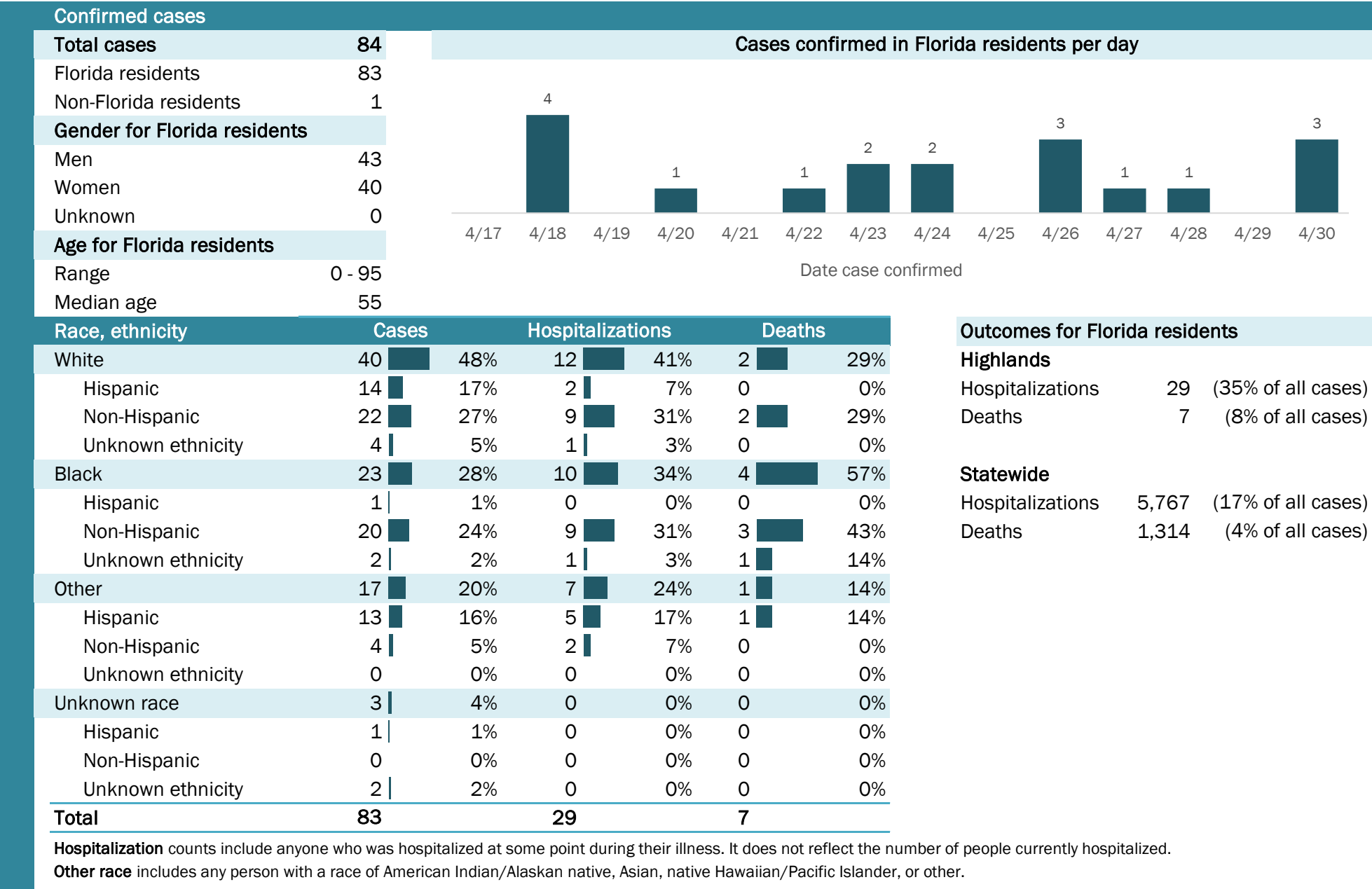

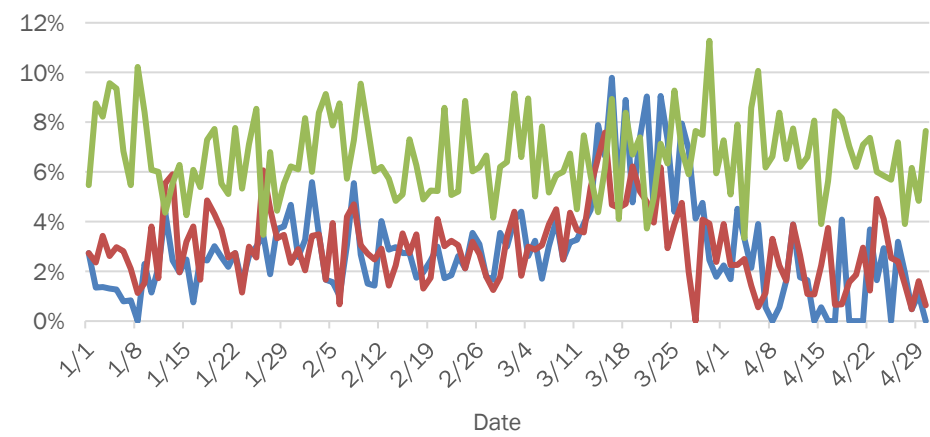


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Indian River County

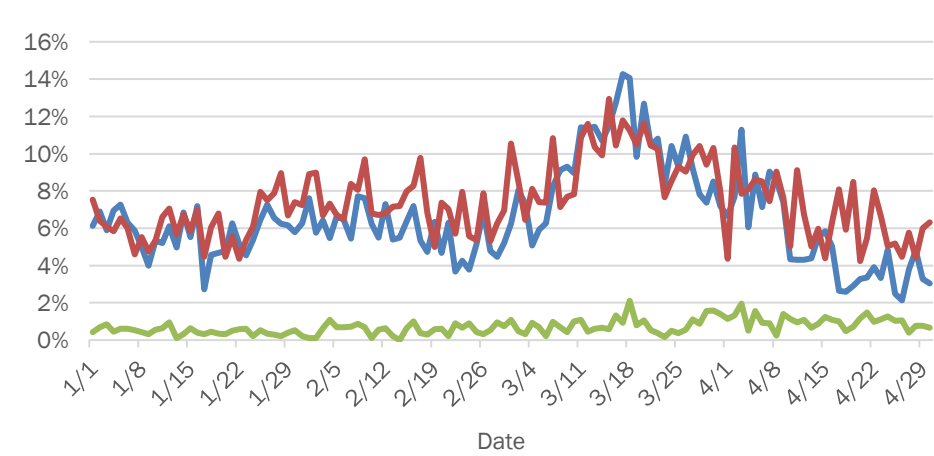


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Lee County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

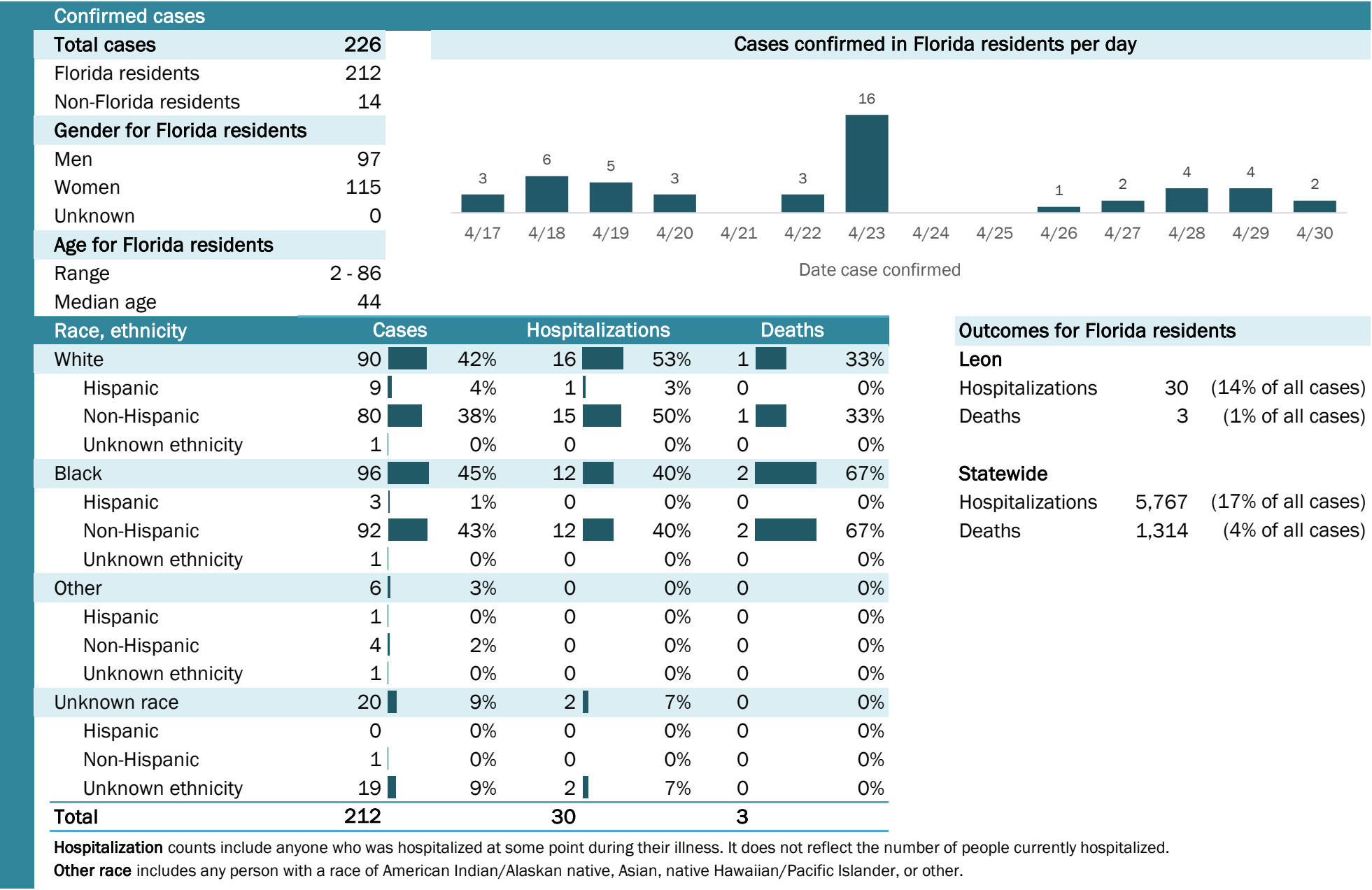

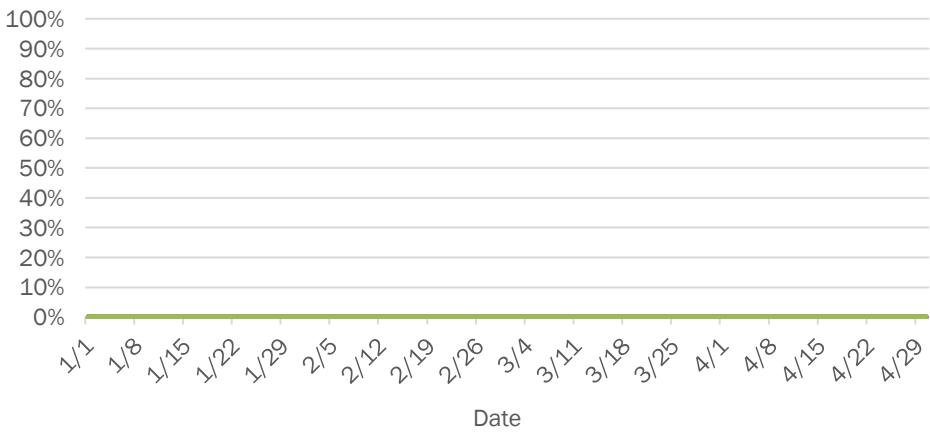


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Levy County

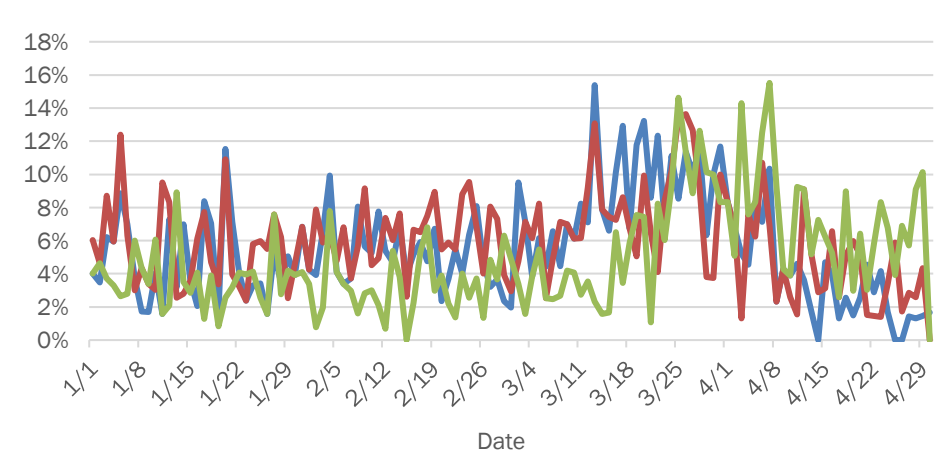


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Monroe County

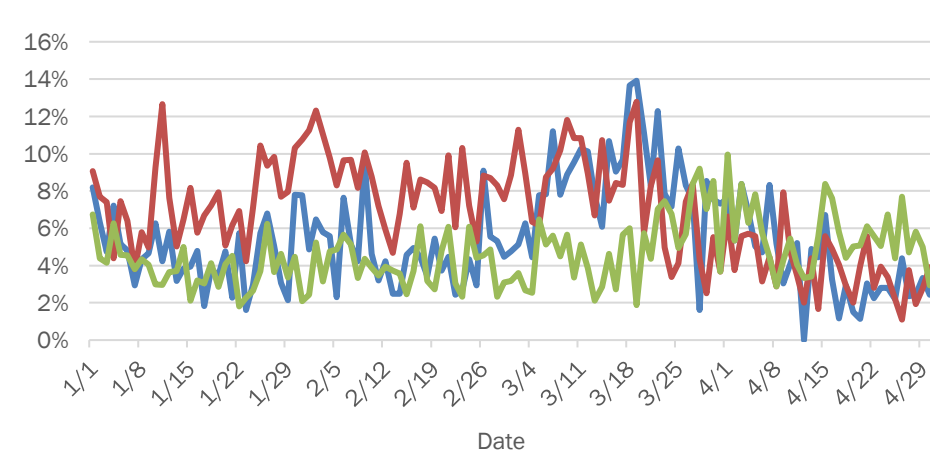


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Okaloosa County

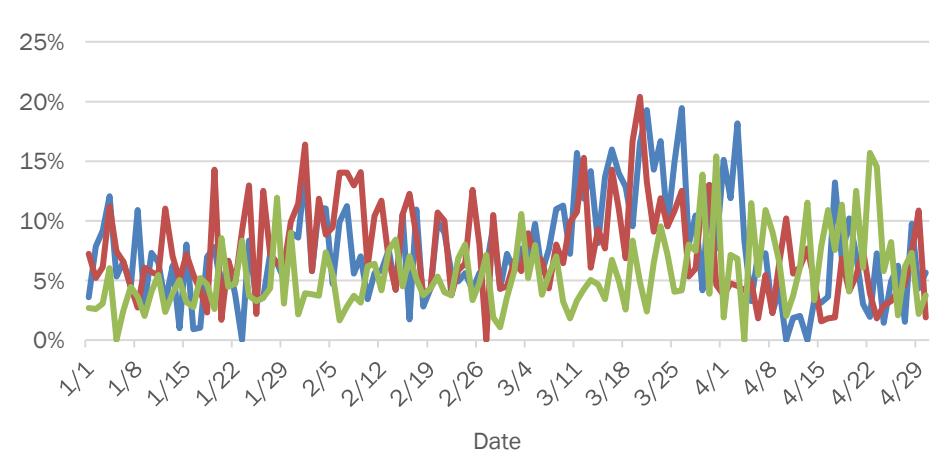


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County
