




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Franklin County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hernando County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Lafayette County
