Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath



Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated




Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath


Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Calhoun County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated




Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath

Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Columbia County Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated





Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath












Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Desoto County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Duval County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated





Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated





Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Marion County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Martin County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Monroe County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated





Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Osceola County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated




Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Pasco County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Pinellas County

Daily percent of ED visits that mention cough, fever, or shortness of breath






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Putnam County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Santa Rosa County




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Sarasota County




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Sumter County Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated

Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Suwannee County Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated







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


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Union County

Daily percent of ED visits that result in cough-associated




