





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



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

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


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



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






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Citrus County








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Clay County






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Columbia County






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Desoto County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Duval County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Escambia County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Flagler County




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hendry County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hernando County








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Highlands County






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Indian River County




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Leon County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



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


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Martin County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Monroe County






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Nassau County








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Okaloosa County








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Okeechobee County




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Palm Beach County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Pasco County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Santa Rosa County








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Sarasota County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Johns County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Sumter County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Suwannee County








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Taylor County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Washington County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions
