

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



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


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath







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


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions





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


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Brevard County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Citrus County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath










Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Dade County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions














Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Flagler County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Franklin County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hamilton County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hardee County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath
















Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Marion County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Martin County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Osceola County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Palm Beach County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Pasco County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Pinellas County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Johns County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness




Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Lucie County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Union County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath
