Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Brevard County

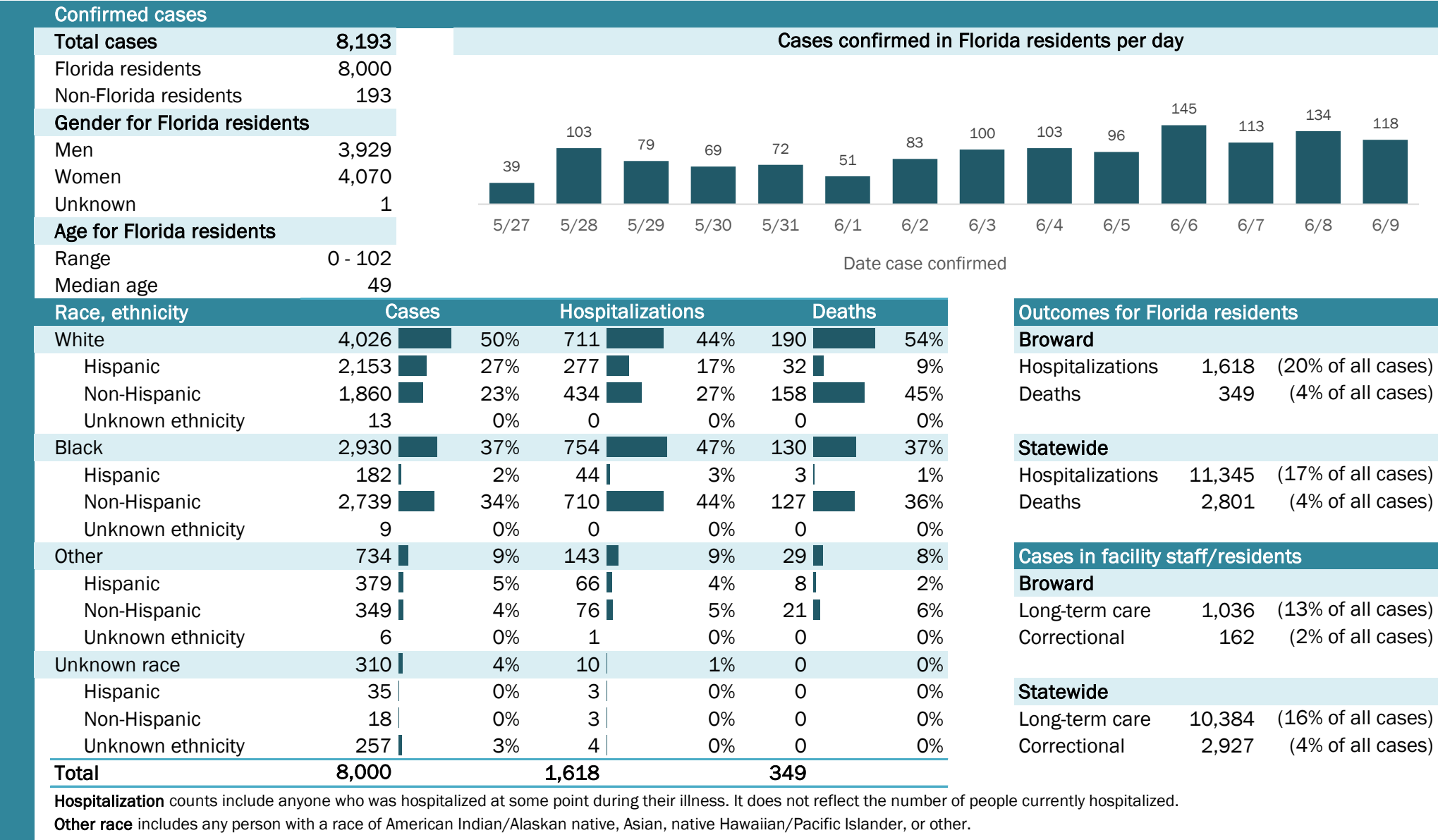

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Dixie County

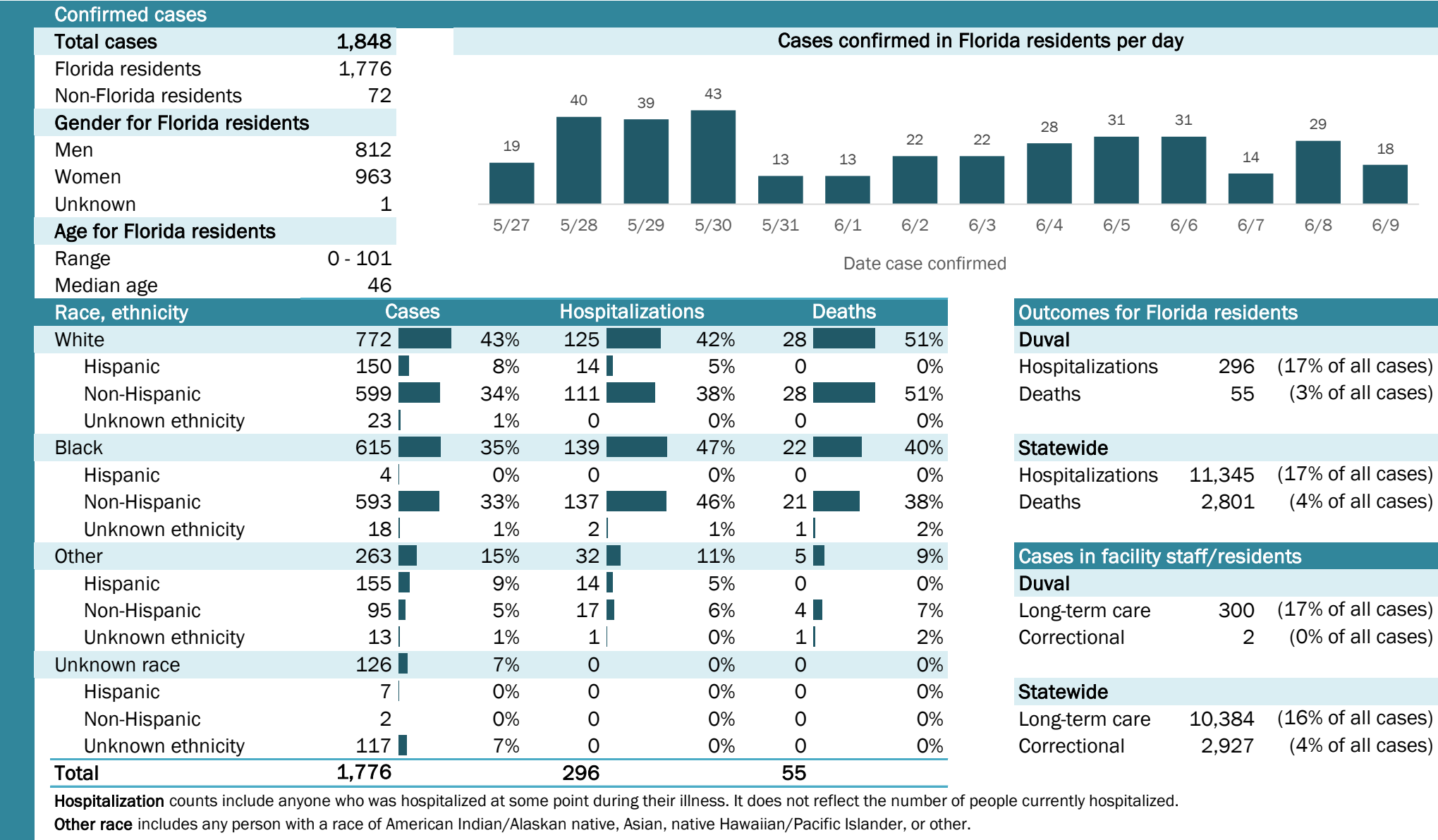
