
#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hamilton County


#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Polk County
