
#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County

Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions





#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Columbia County



### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Jackson County








#### Percent positivity for new cases


#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County




