


#### Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Florida County










### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**













Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness** 






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




#### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in

cough-associated admissions








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness** 








#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Citrus County









#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Clay County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




#### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness













Daily percent of ED visits resulting in









Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hernando County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Highlands County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness

#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Indian River County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness












Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**

















# Daily percent of ED visits mentioning


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions









Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness** 








#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Nassau County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Orange County













### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in












Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness













Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness











Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions












Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness























Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness** 










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








### Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents





Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions
















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



