Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for






### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Duval County










Daily percent of ED visits mentioning




### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hamilton County










Daily percent of ED visits mentioning




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

influenza-like illness









Daily percent of ED visits mentioning




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











Daily percent of ED visits mentioning















## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Suwannee County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning












#### Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents





## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County




