



## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Bay County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Bradford County











## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Brevard County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning













Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Collier County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Duval County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Escambia County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Indian River County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning












#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Lee County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Leon County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Levy County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Monroe County







Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Palm Beach County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Pasco County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Johns County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








# Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Suwannee County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning Weekly count











### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Taylor County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County










#### Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning




