


Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents





Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Citrus County






Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Clay County










Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Dade County









Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning












Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents





Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Marion County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Sumter County





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning












Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents









Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Washington County
