



### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Florida County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for

influenza-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning
