#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Florida County





#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**







Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness



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
### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions







#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Brevard County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness







Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**






### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**




#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Escambia County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions











Daily percent of ED visits resulting in

cough-associated admissions










#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Gilchrist County







#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Glades County



Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions







Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





## Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Lake County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness









Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**


### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**

Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Pasco County





### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Lucie County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness

#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Suwannee County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness












#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness







### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










#### Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**








#### Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents


