


#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Baker County










#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Collier County




#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Escambia County










#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hardee County












Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning






# Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness







Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Manatee County










#### Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for




