


Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Jefferson County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Lafayette County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Lake County










Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Leon County






