


Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Brevard County






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Dade County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning Weekly










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Osceola County






Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County









Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County






