Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Lake County




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


