



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Escambia County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning













Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Highlands County




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Indian River County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning Weekly county














Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Lake County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Martin County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning












Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Putnam County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County













Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents







Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Lucie County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Suwannee County




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County





Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








