#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for County








### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




#### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**


#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Baker County








Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**





Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions











Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Broward County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Calhoun County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness









Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**









Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness









Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








### Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in

cough-associated admissions





Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness











Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions















Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness













Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness







Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




### Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning






#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Indian River County






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions














Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




## Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness










Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness













Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness





#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County




## Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness
















## Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**
