




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for




Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for






### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Union County










### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County







### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County






