


Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Alachua County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Brevard County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in

cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Duval County




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness



Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents



Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Escambia County








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Gulf County




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness



Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for **COVID-like illness**



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness







Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness





Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Liberty County




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness



Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness



Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Nassau County




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions






Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness

Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Okaloosa County








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Putnam County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness


Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness




Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness

Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness






Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness





Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents





Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County








Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions


Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness








Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County



Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for influenza-like illness




Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions Weekly count of ED and FSED visits for COVID-like illness
