



Number of persons who received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine










#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks







Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks












COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks

Number of persons who received their first dose of a two-dose series of the COVID-19 vaccine







#### Number of persons who completed the COVID-19 vaccine series








Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks






Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks








Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


