



### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks










### Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks


















































#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


#### Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks




#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks




#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks






















#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks






#### COVID-19 doses administered for the past 2 weeks


Persons vaccinated for COVID-19 for the past 2 weeks






