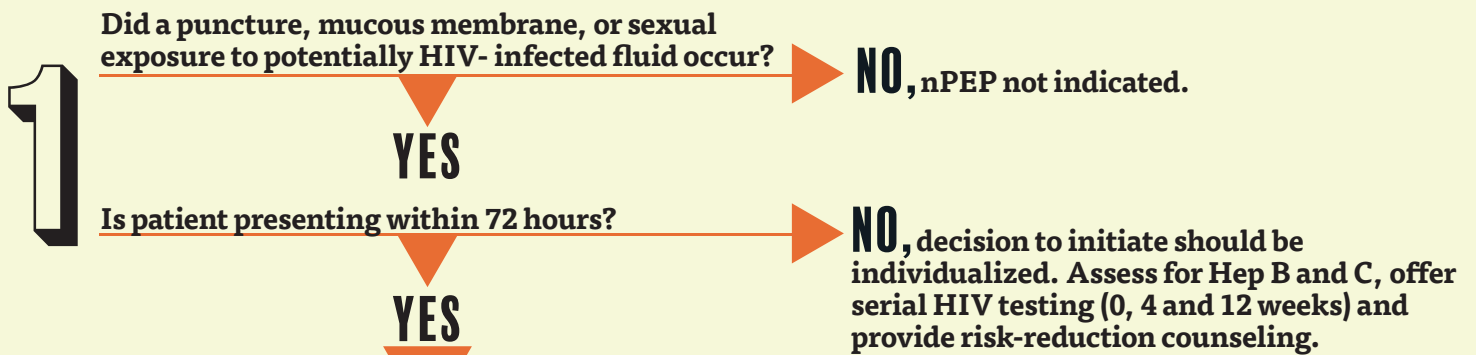




PEP TRIAGE

PEP WHEN YOU NEED IT

EVALUATE EXPOSURE: IS nPEP INDICATED?



2 **INITIATE FIRST DOSE OF nPEP REGIMEN**
See *Recommended Regimen* on back.

PERFORM BASELINE TESTING

3 **EXPOSED PERSON:**

- HIV Test
- Pregnancy Test for Women
- GC/CT NAAT (based on site of exposure)
- RPR for syphilis
- Assess for Hep B and Hep C

SOURCE PERSON:

- Obtain HIV test with turnaround time <1 hour.
- If results are not immediately available, continue nPEP while awaiting results.
- If result is negative but there may have been exposure to HIV in the previous 6 weeks, obtain plasma HIV RNA assay.
- Continue nPEP until results of the plasma HIV RNA assay are available.

4 **PROVIDE COUNSELING AND REFERRAL**

- Provide risk-reduction counseling; consider need for intensive risk-reduction counseling services.
- Refer for mental health and/or substance use program when indicated.
- Discuss future use of PrEP with person with ongoing risk behavior.
