

WHAT IS MPOX?

(Formerly called monkeypox)

Mpox is a viral infection transmitted during prolonged, face-to-face contact, or during intimate physical contact, such as kissing, cuddling, or sex.

MPOX SYMPTOMS LAST 2-4 WEEKS



High Fever



Intense Headache



Swollen Lymph Nodes



Muscle Aches



Chills



Rash



Anyone can get mpox, but certain populations are at higher risk and should take precautions and consider vaccination.

MPOX PREVENTION



STAY INFORMED

Visit CDC or DOH websites to get up-to-date guidance.



CONTACT

If you have symptoms, call your healthcare provider and ask about testing.



PROTECT

Get vaccinated. If you have symptoms, cover sores and avoid contact with others.
