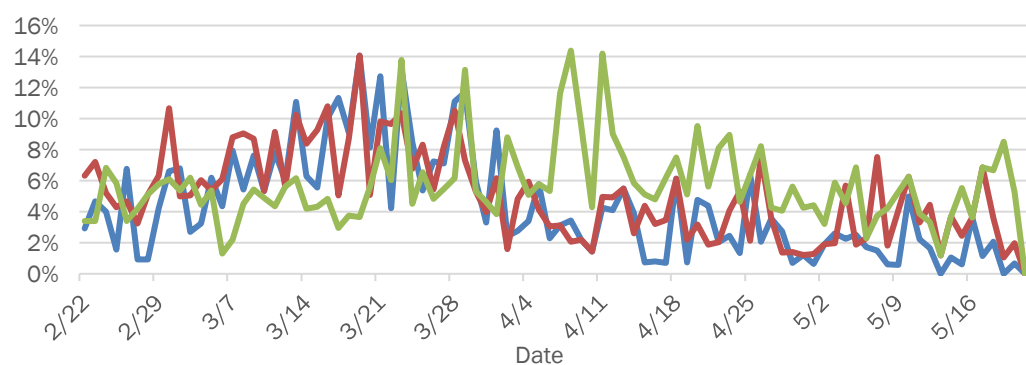

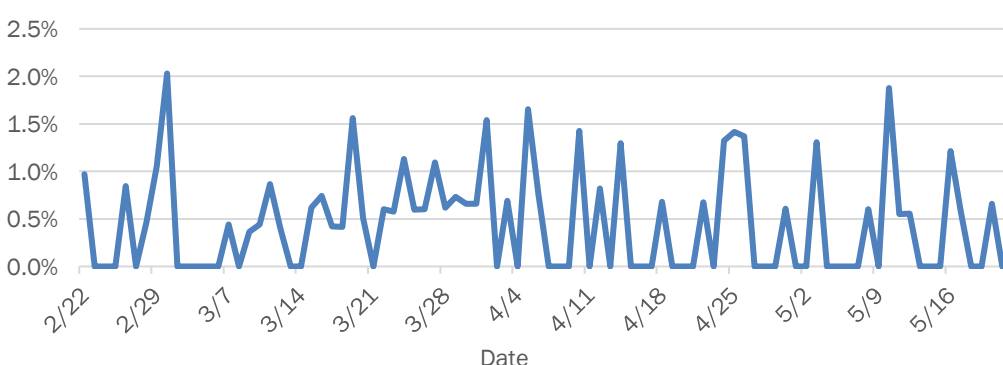


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Bay County

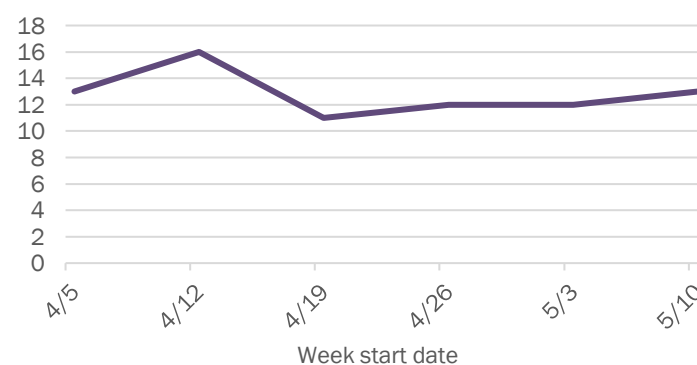
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



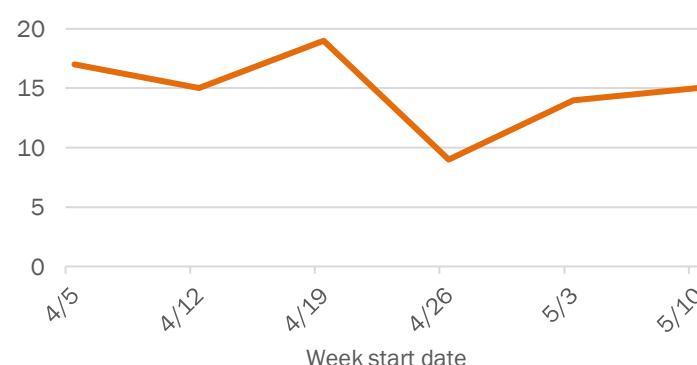
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

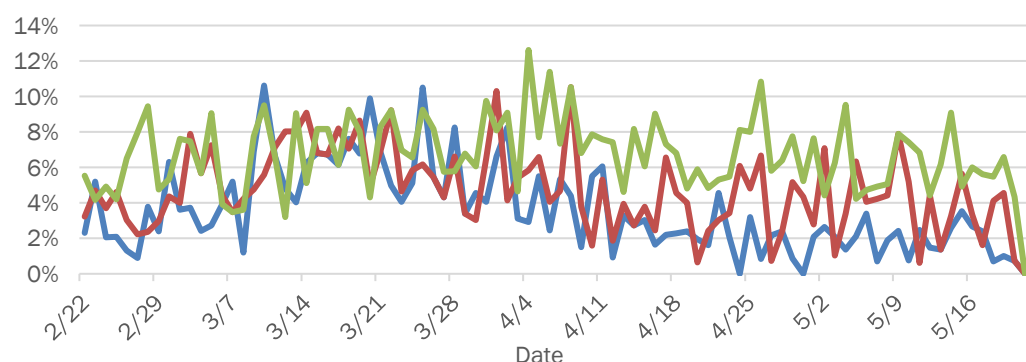

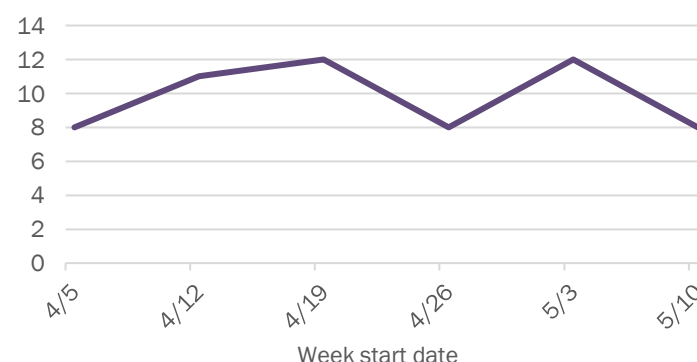


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Charlotte County

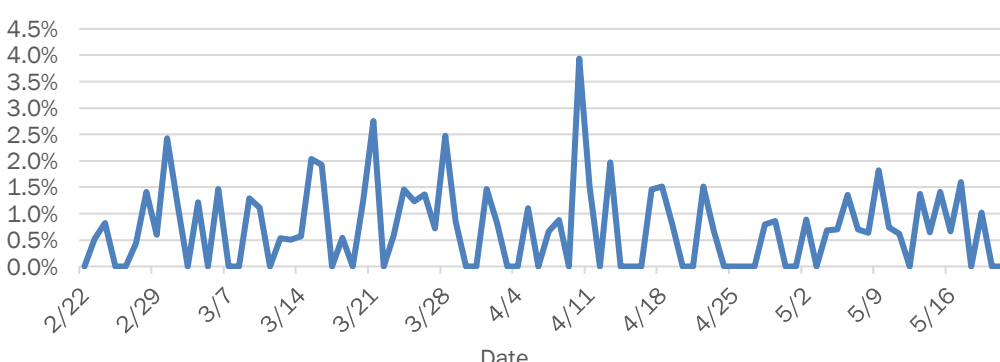
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



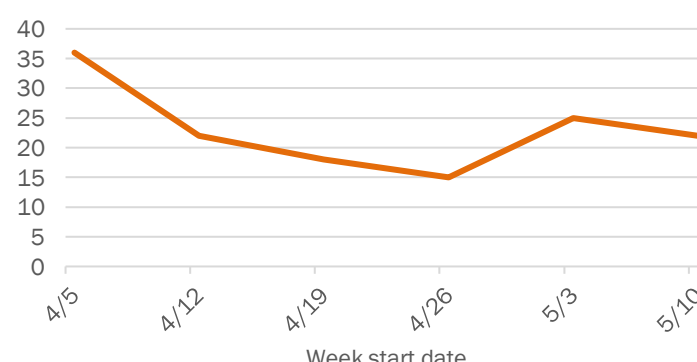
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

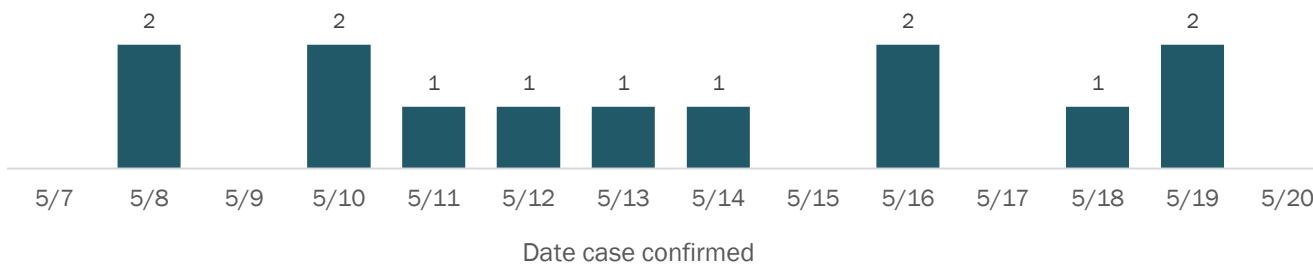

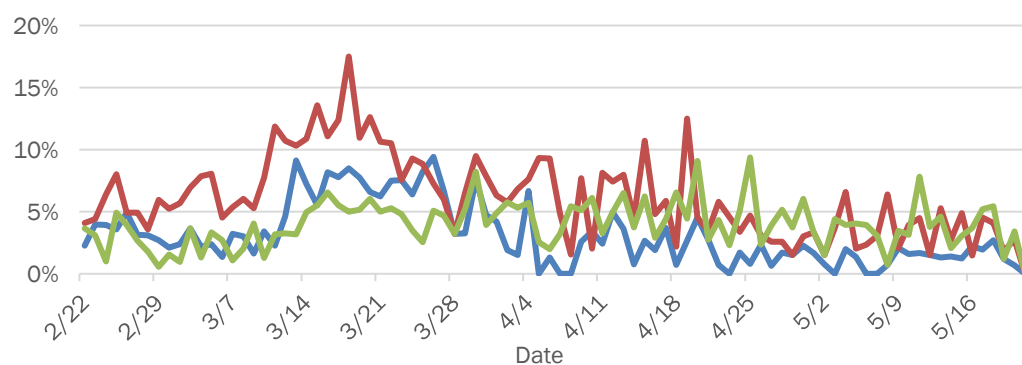

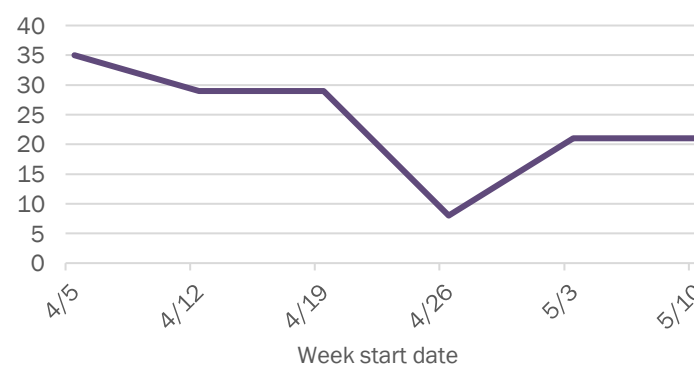


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Citrus County

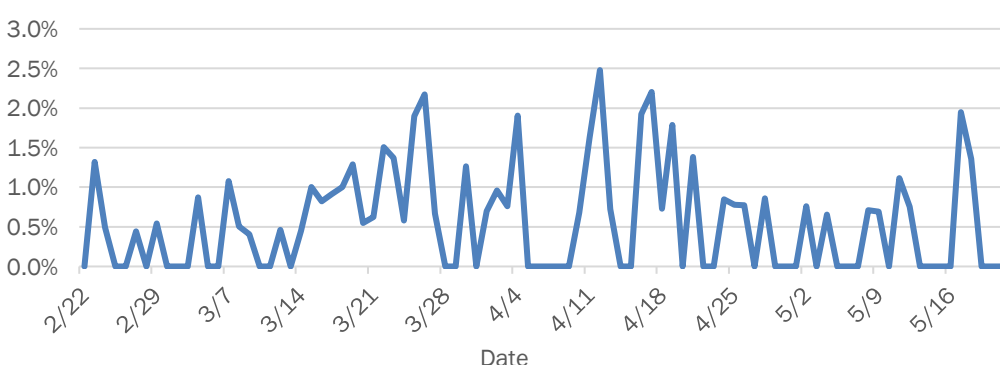
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



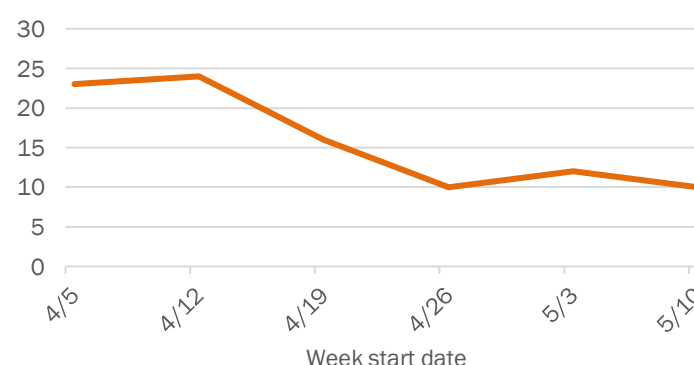
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

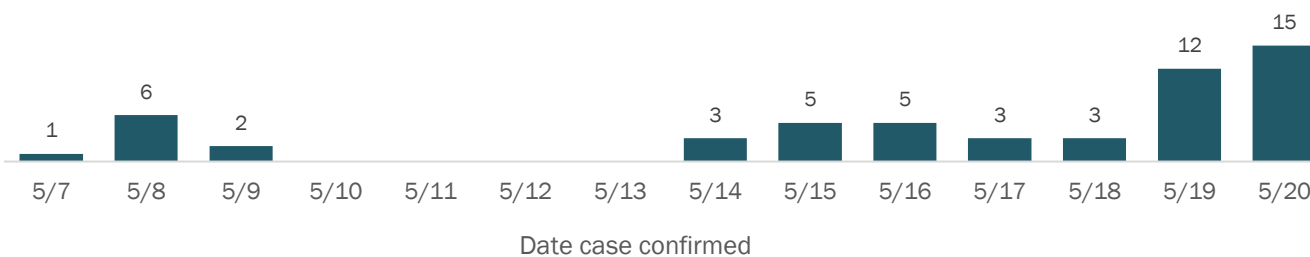

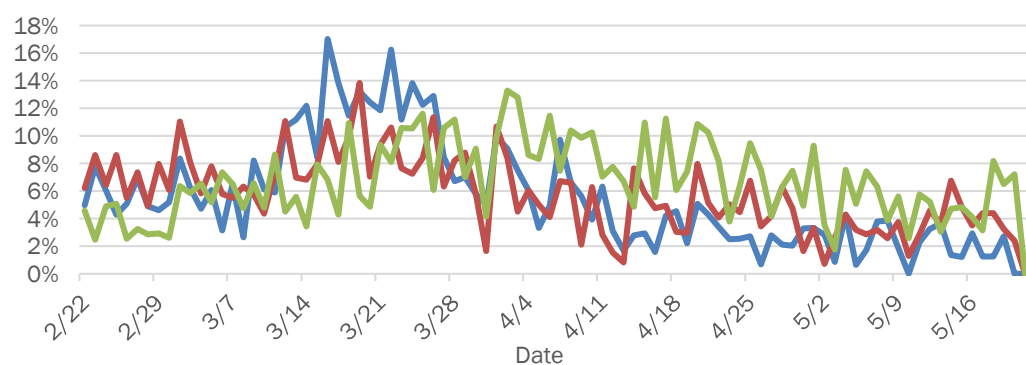

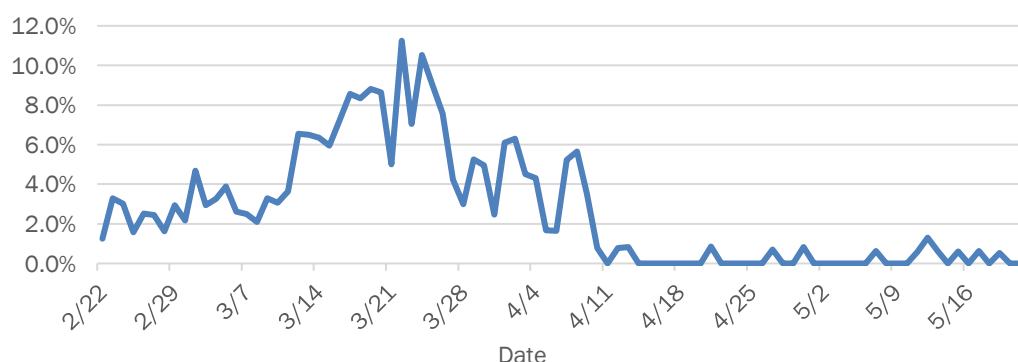


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Clay County

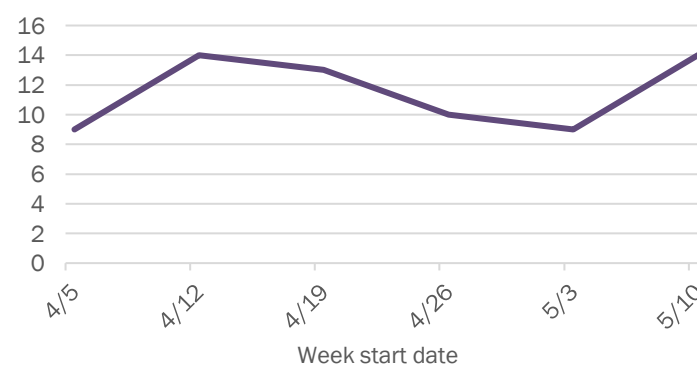
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



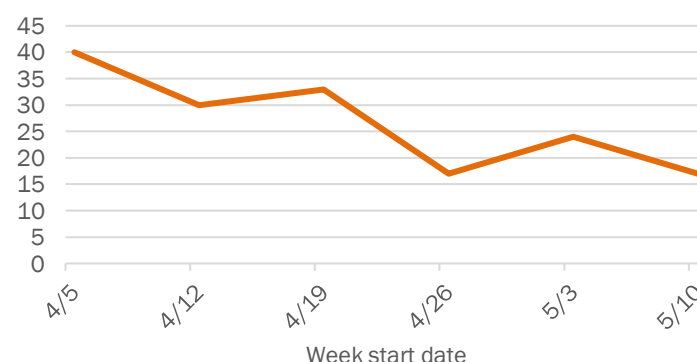
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

Weekly count of ED visits for COVID-like illness



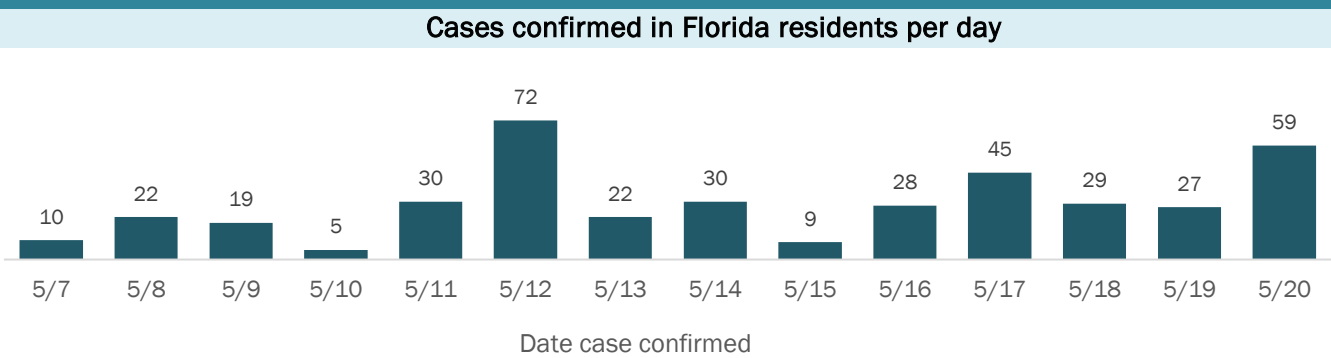

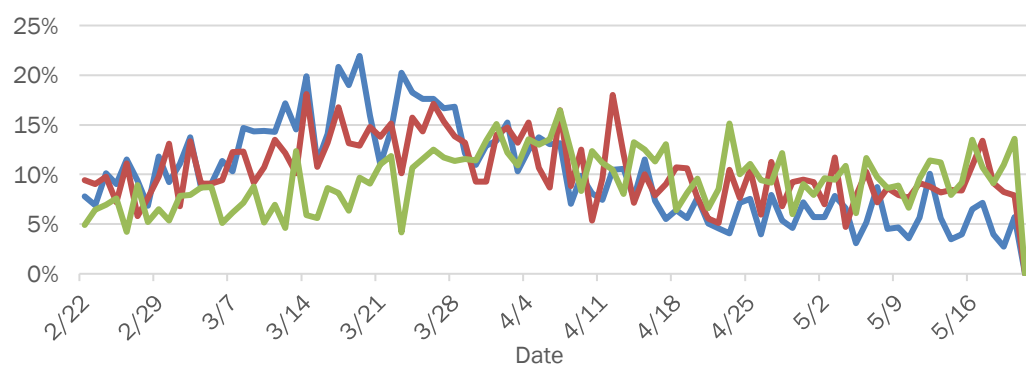

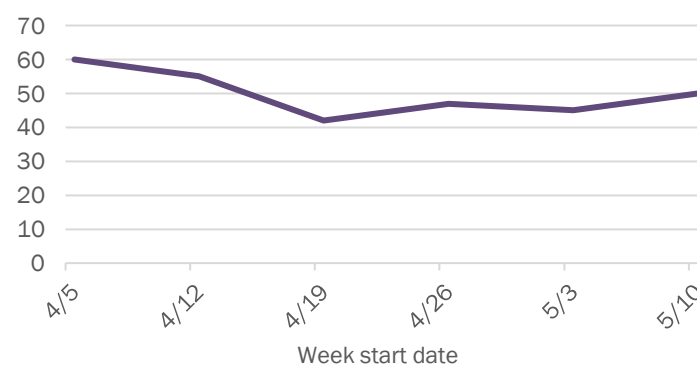


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Collier County

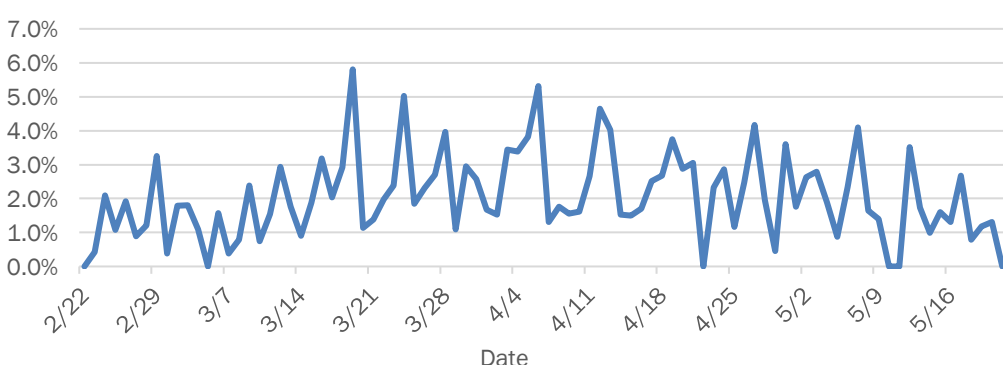
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



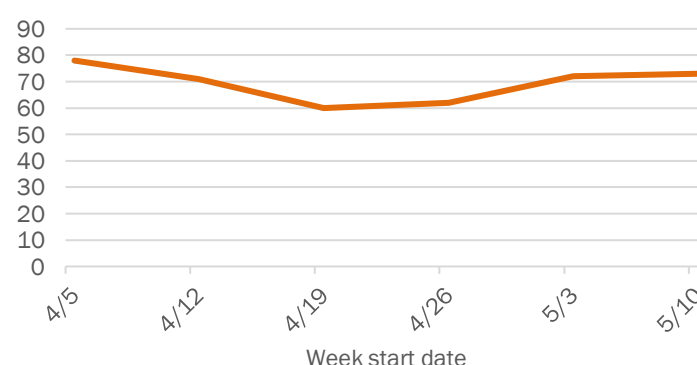
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

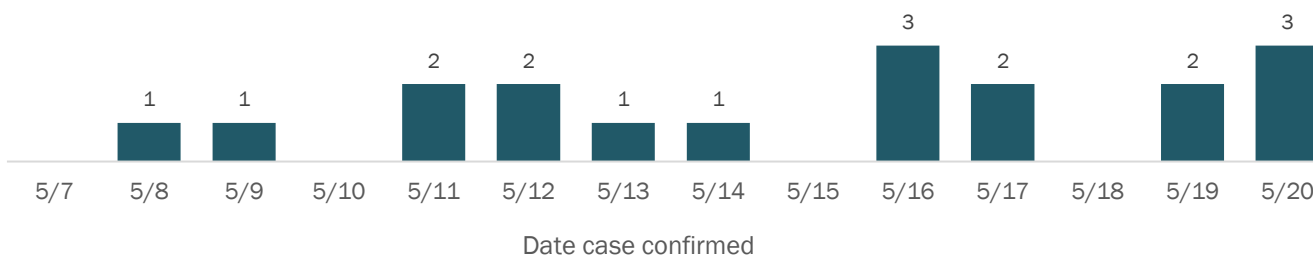

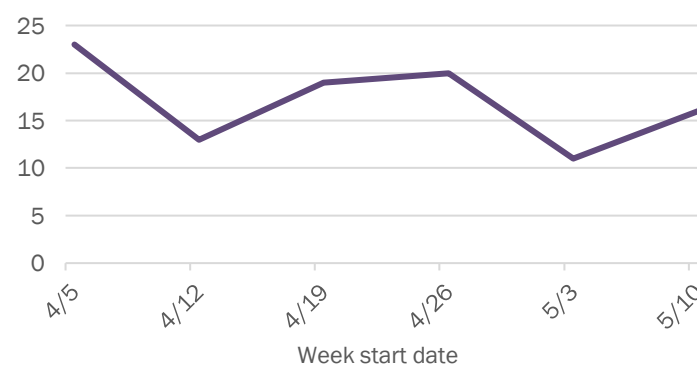


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Columbia County

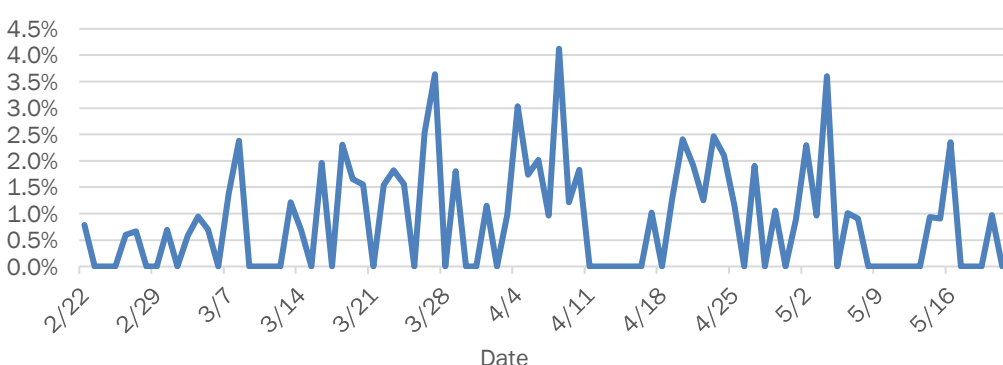
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



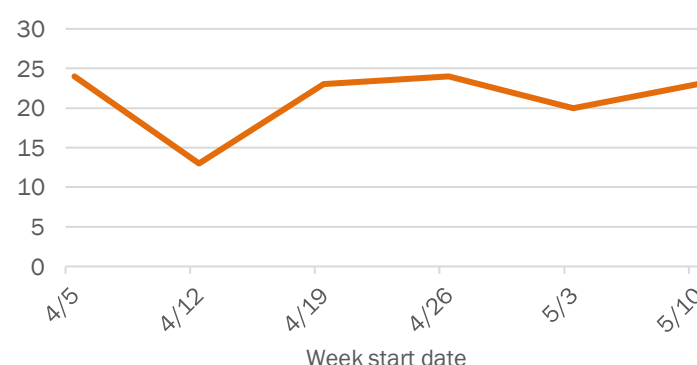
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

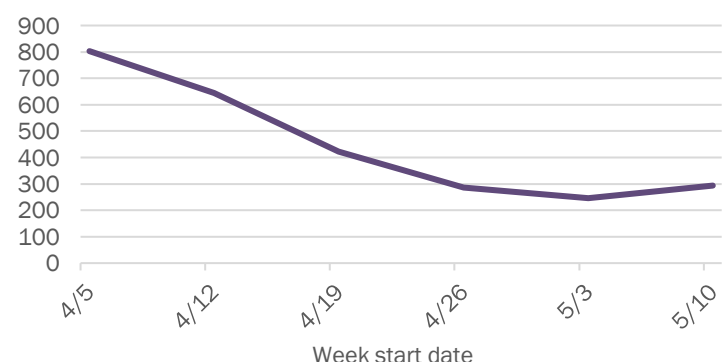
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



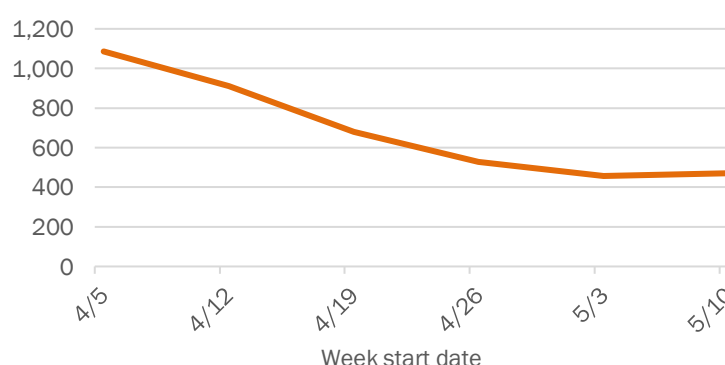
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

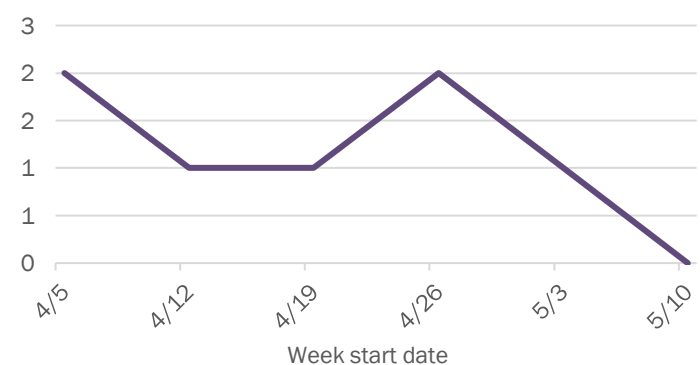

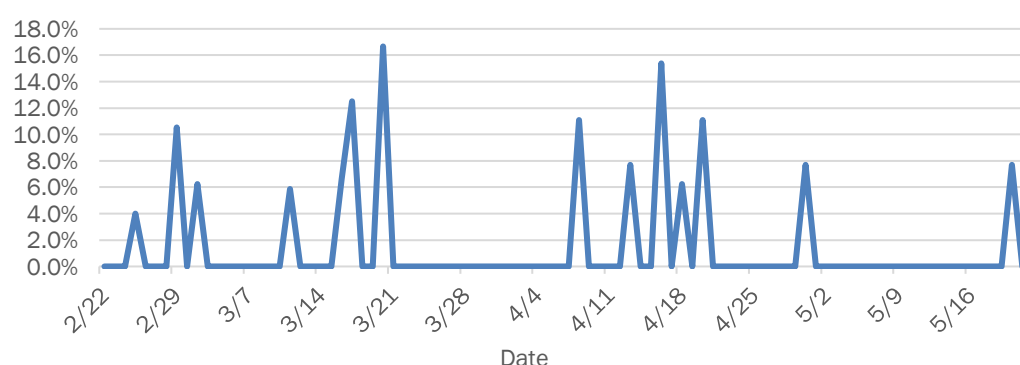
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath

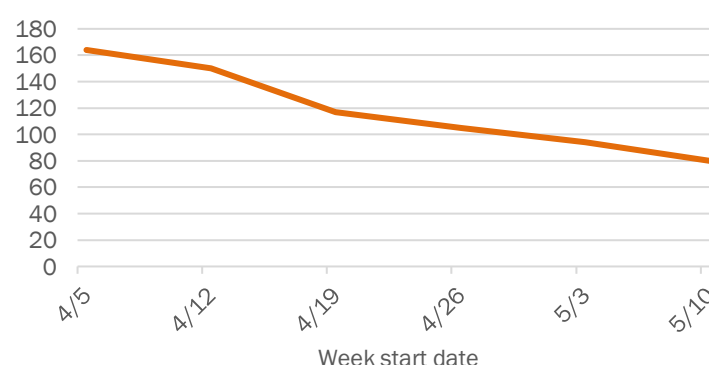
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

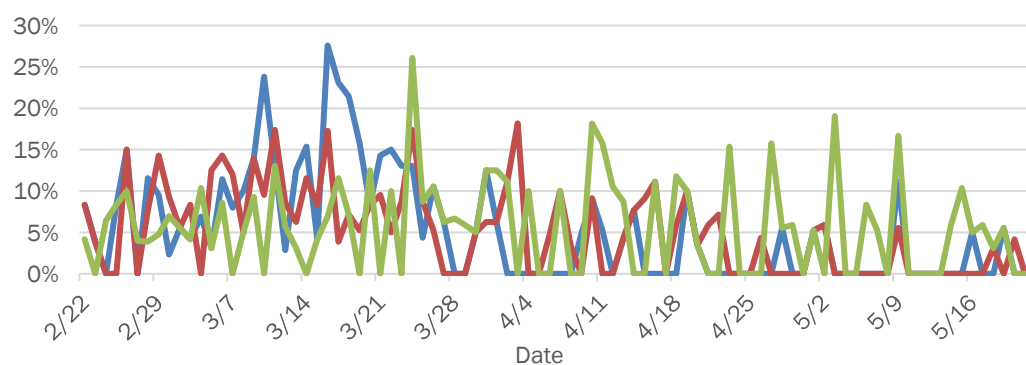

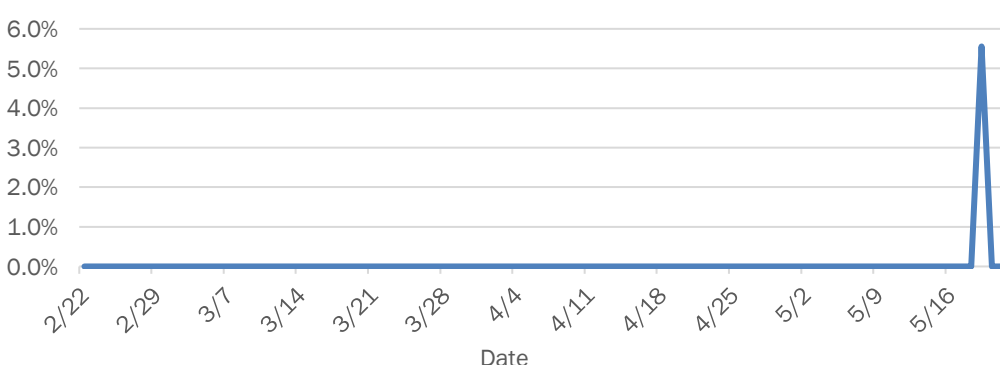

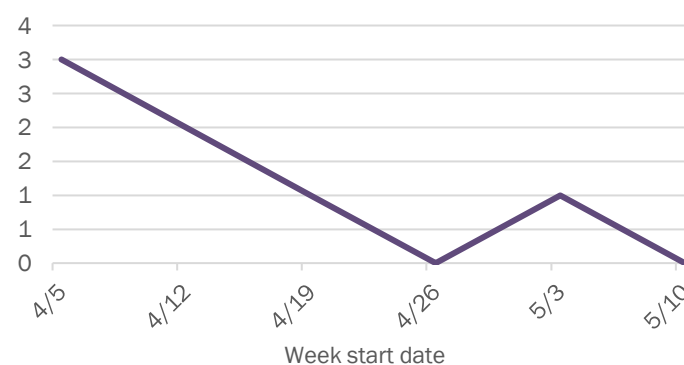
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath

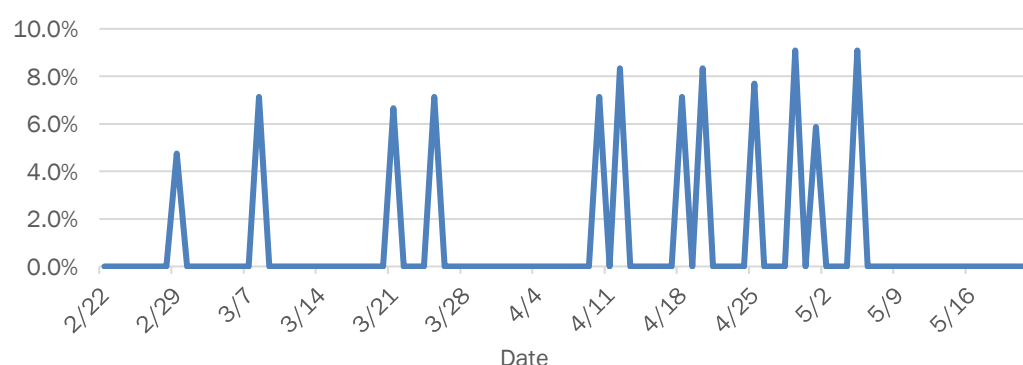

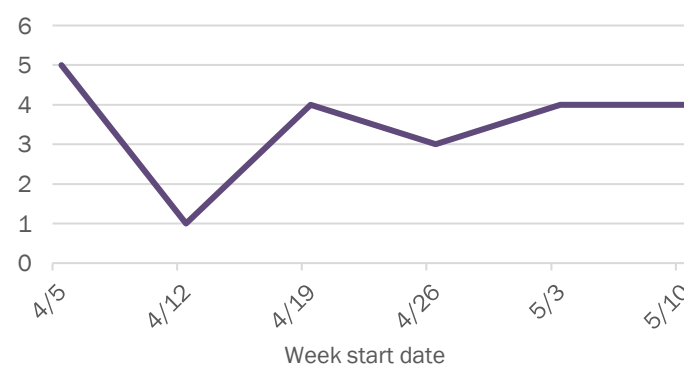
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



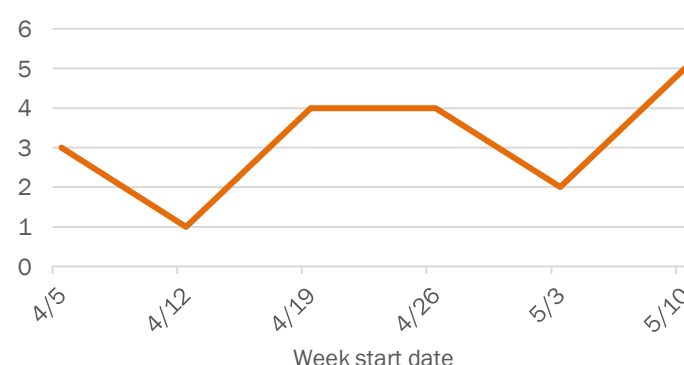
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

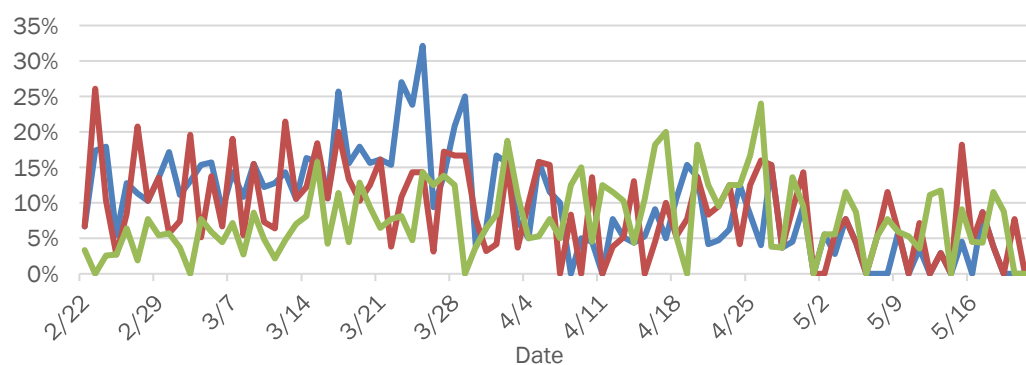

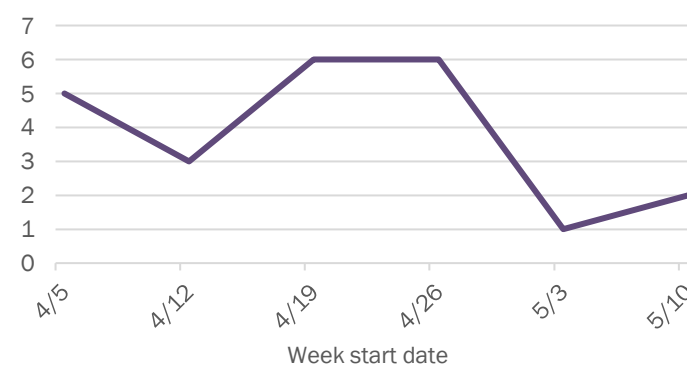


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hardee County

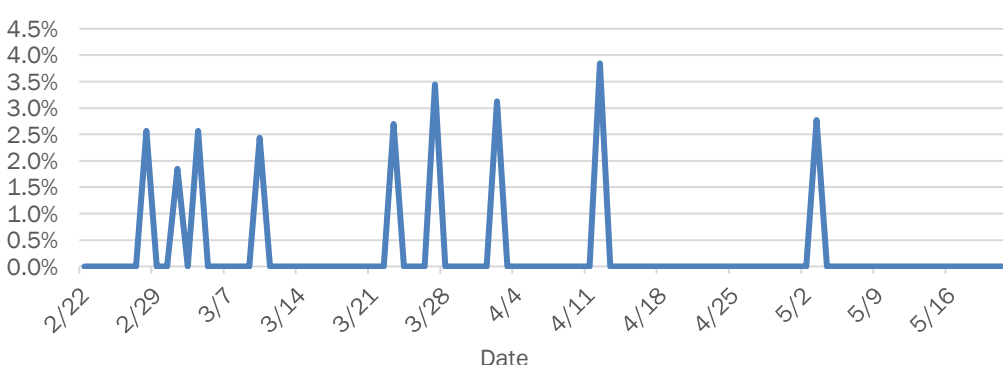
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



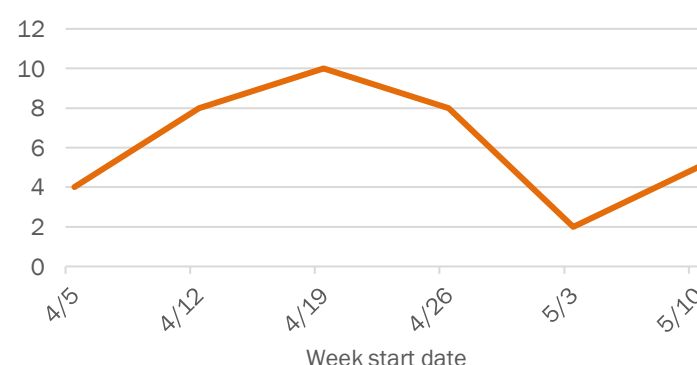
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

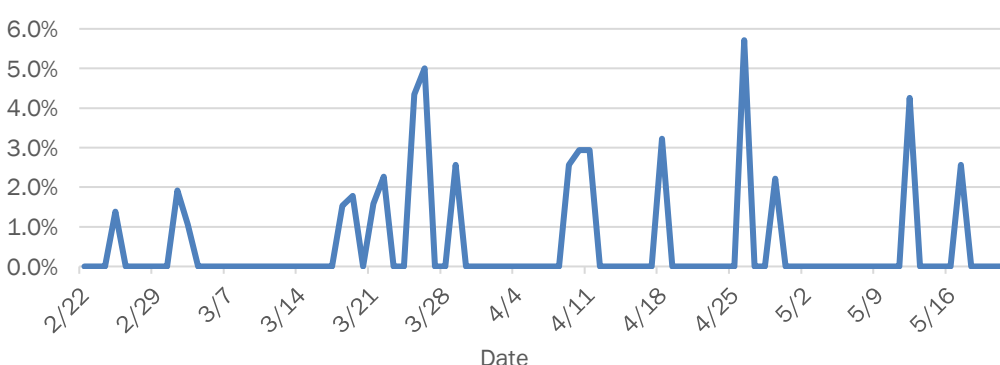

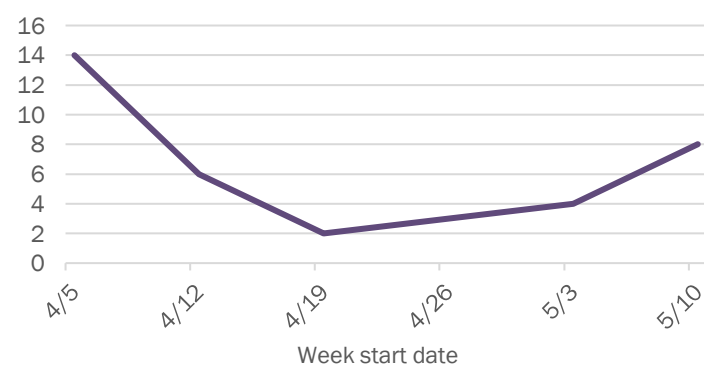
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



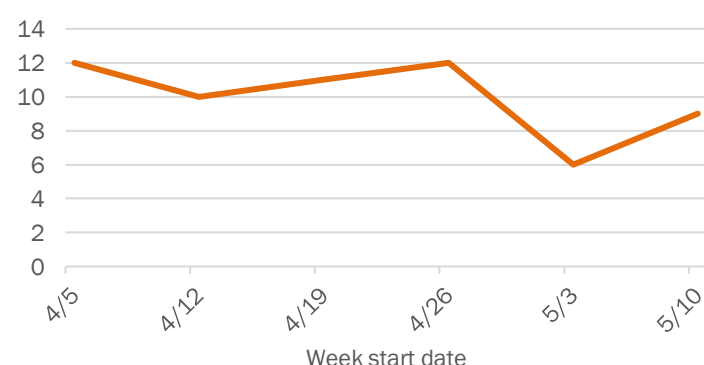
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

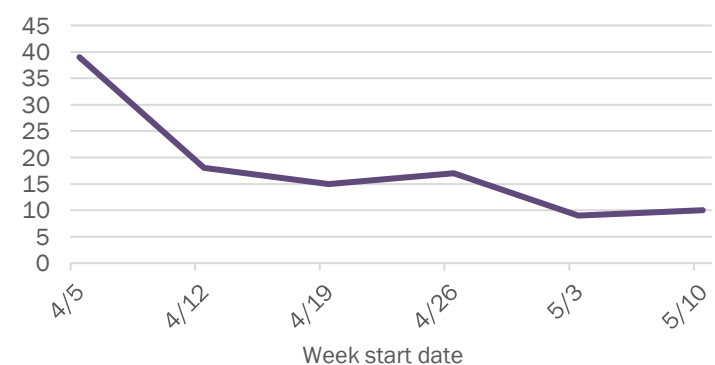

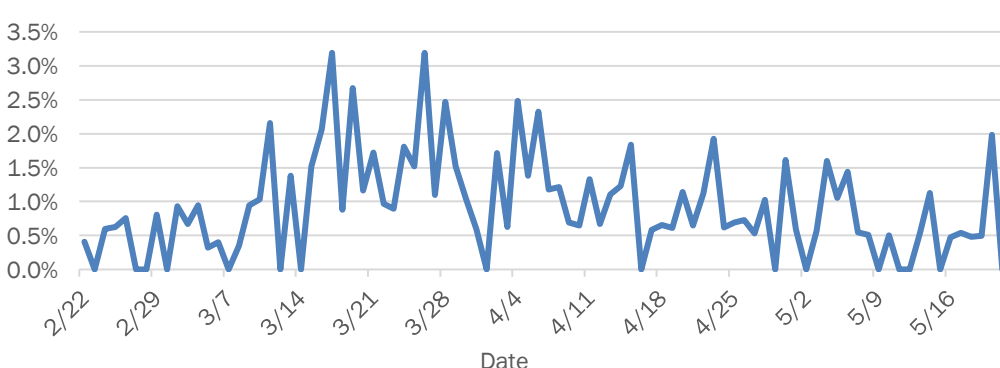
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



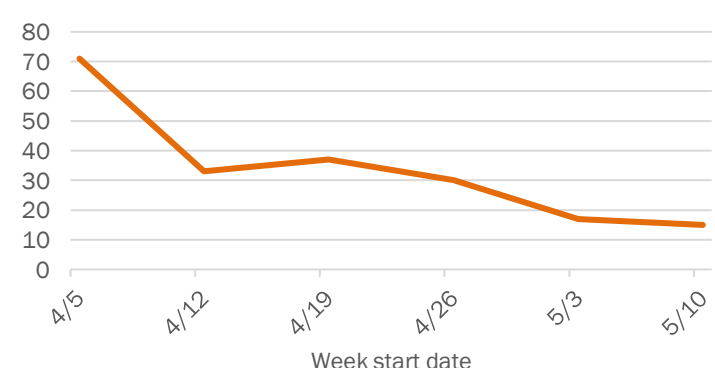
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

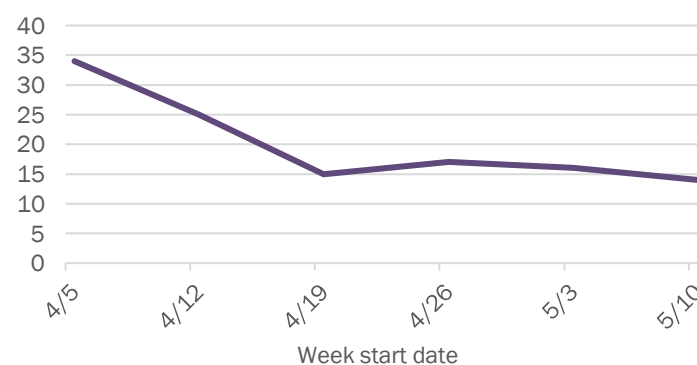

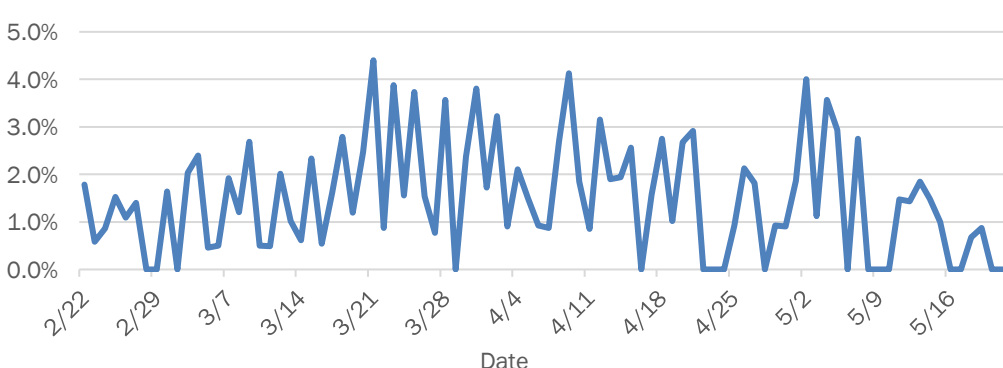
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



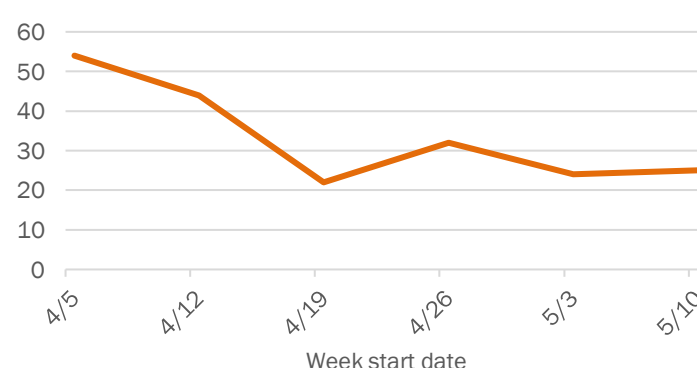
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

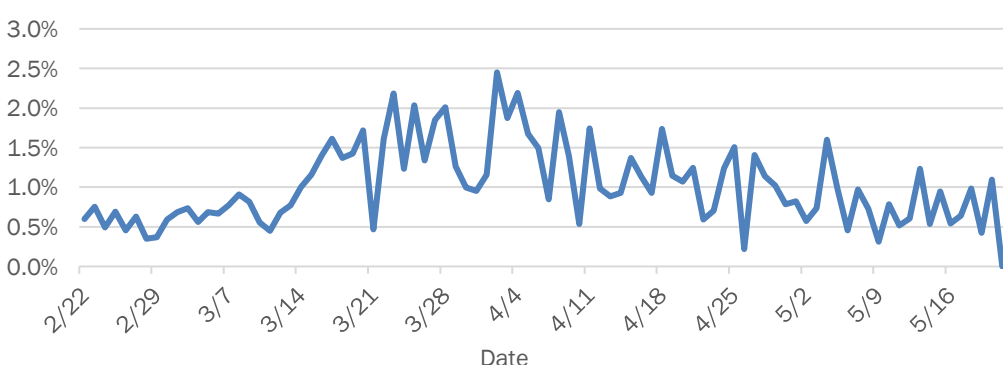


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County

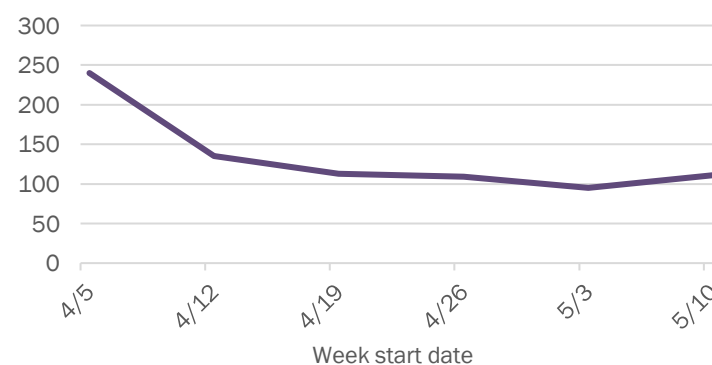
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



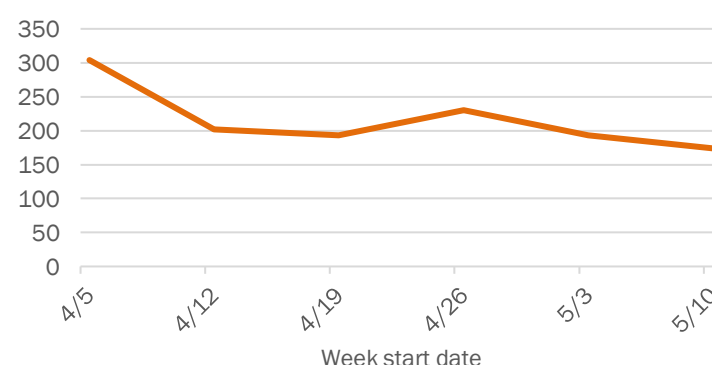
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

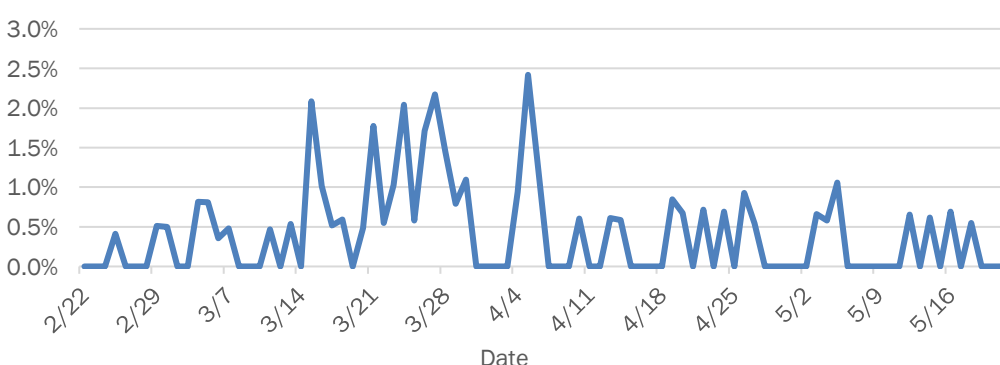

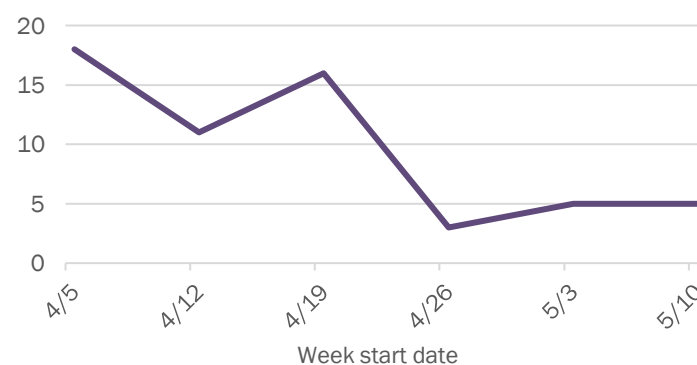
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



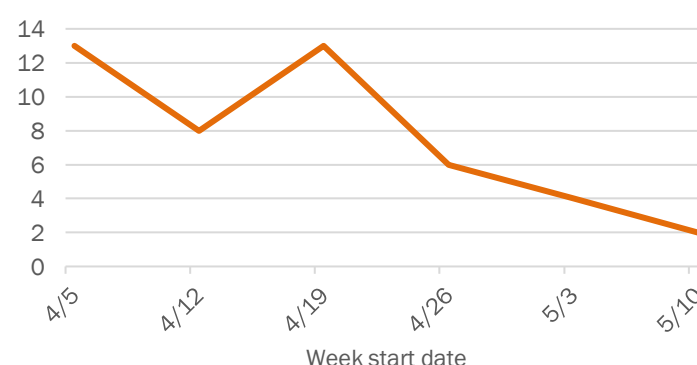
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

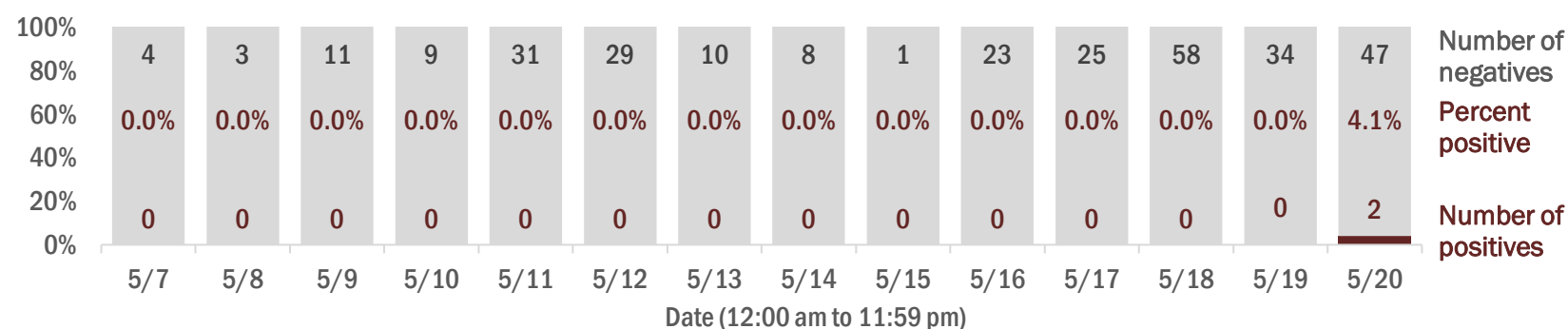

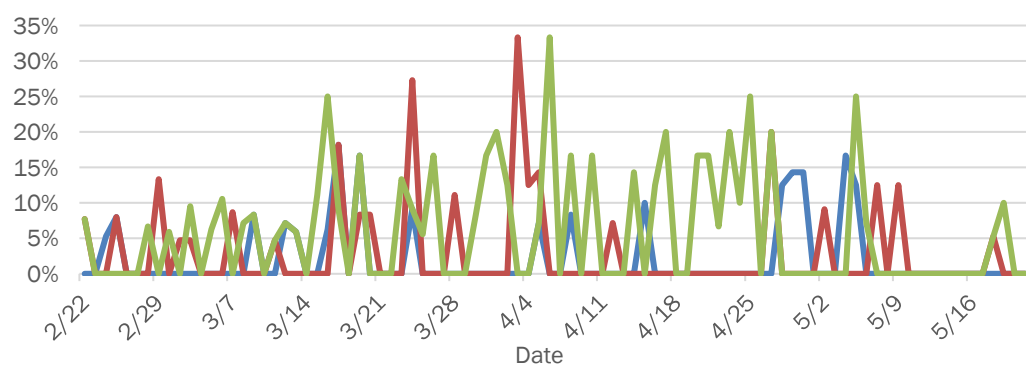

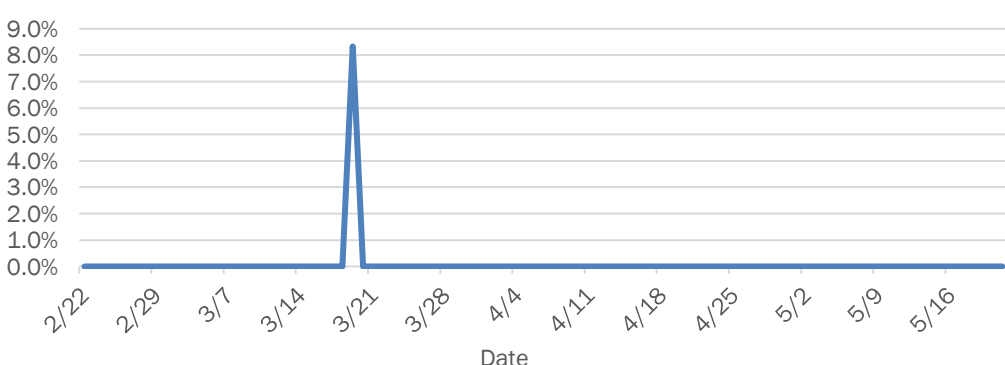


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Jefferson County

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



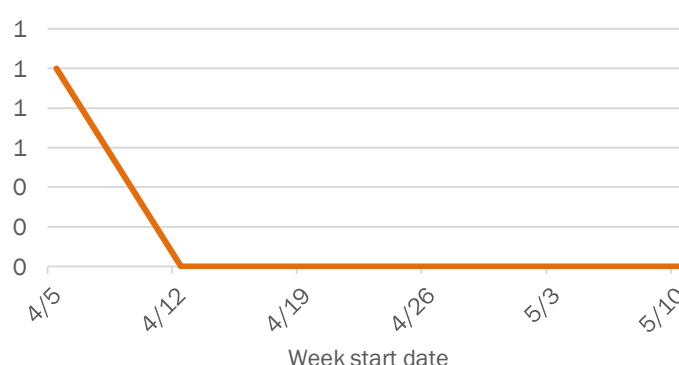
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

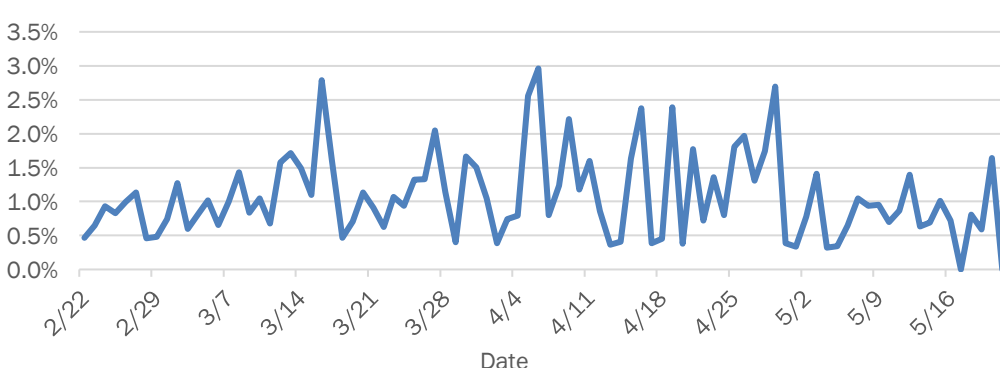


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Lake County

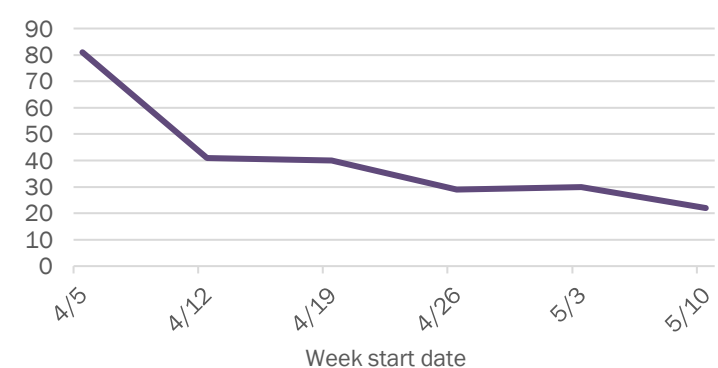
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



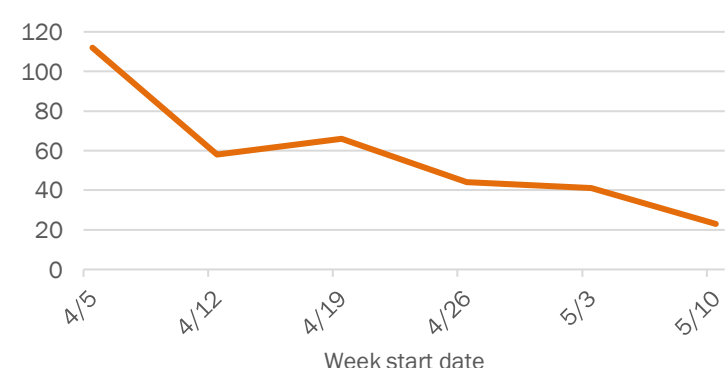
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

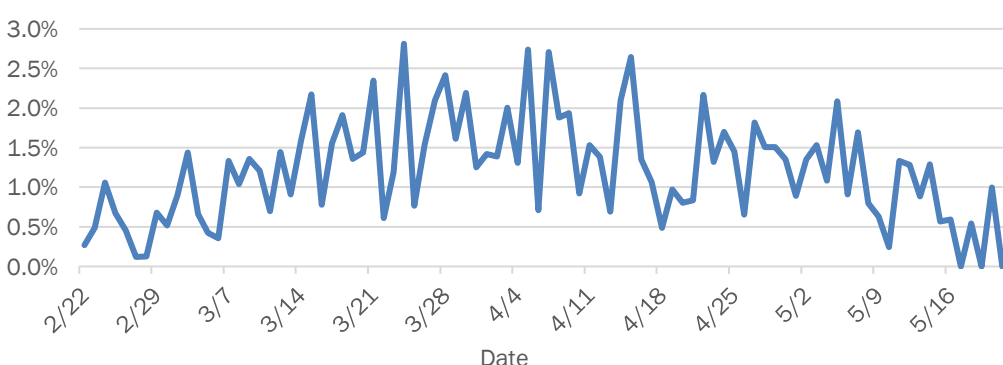

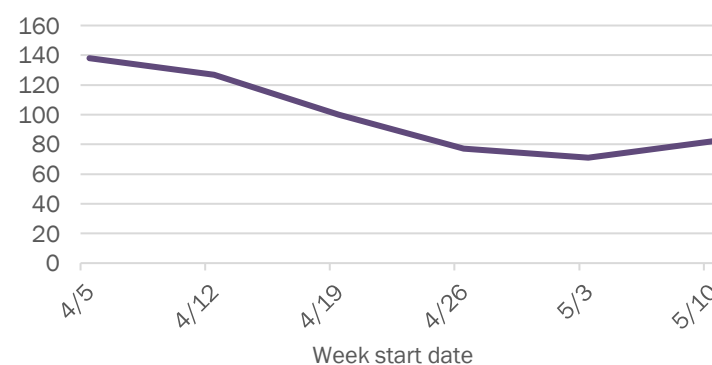
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



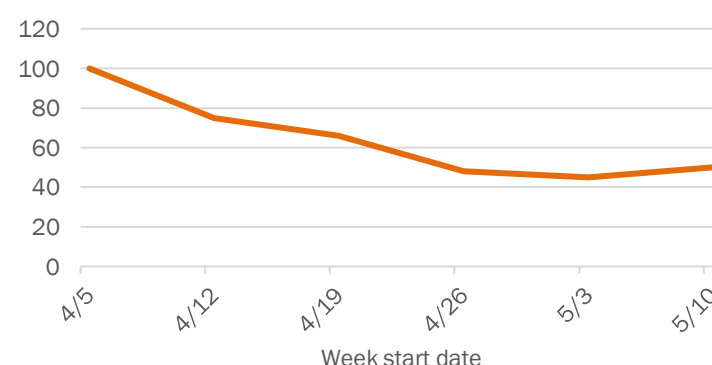
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

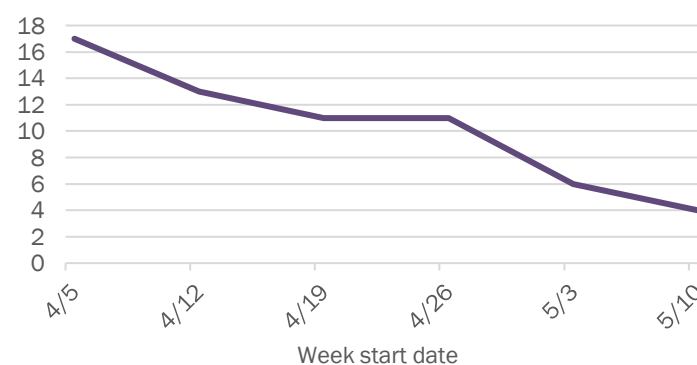


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Leon County

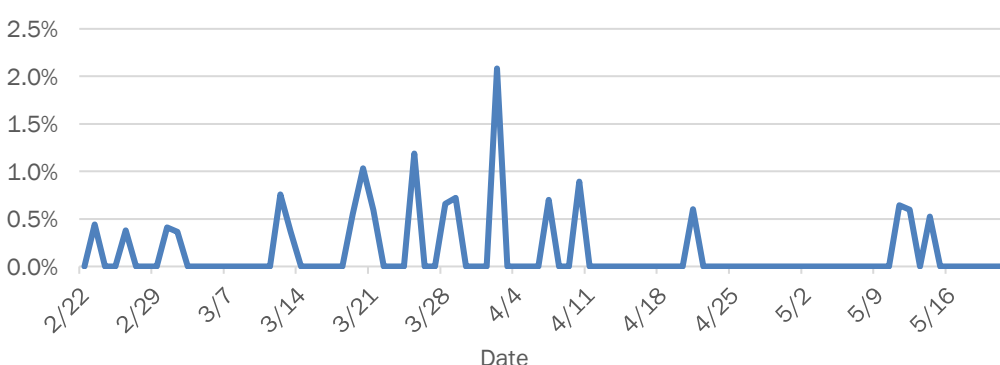
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath

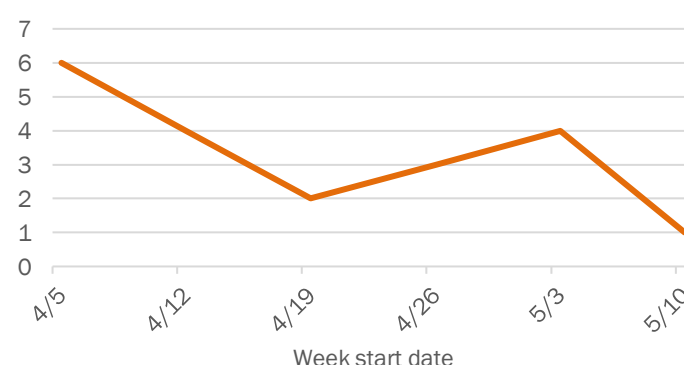

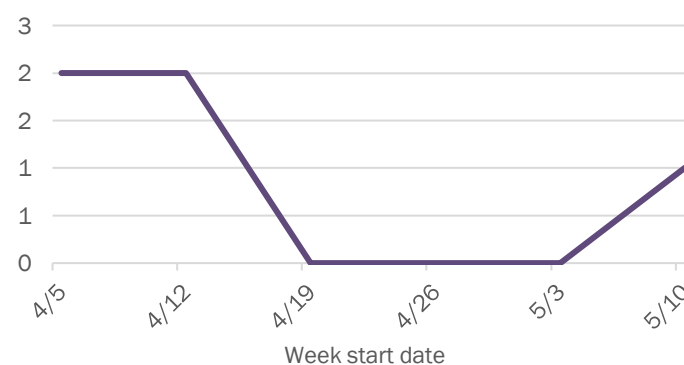
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



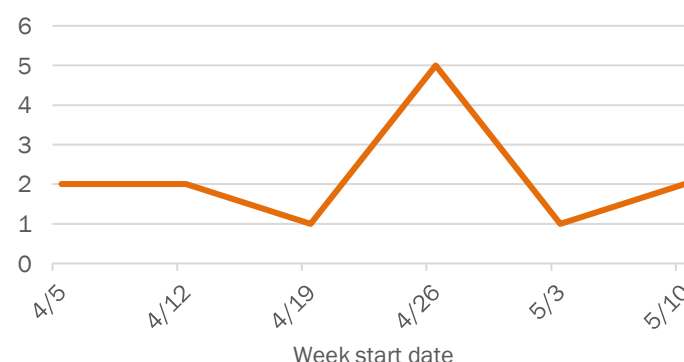
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

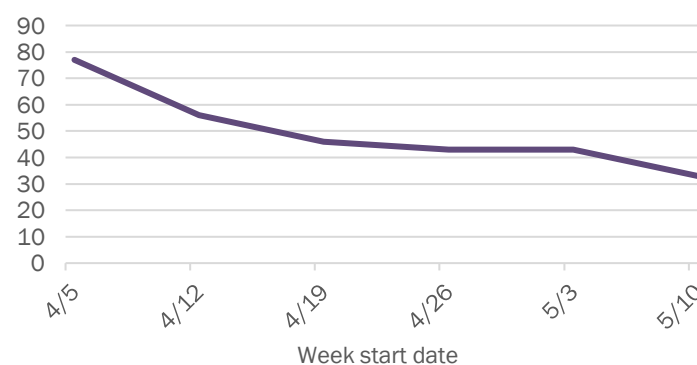

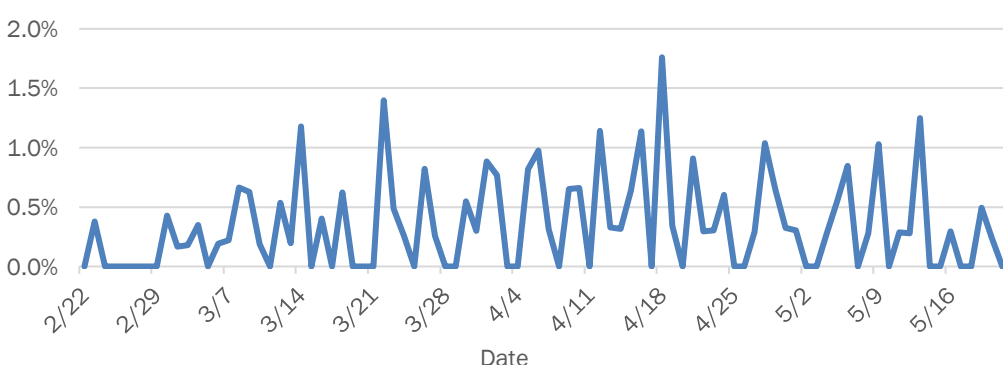
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



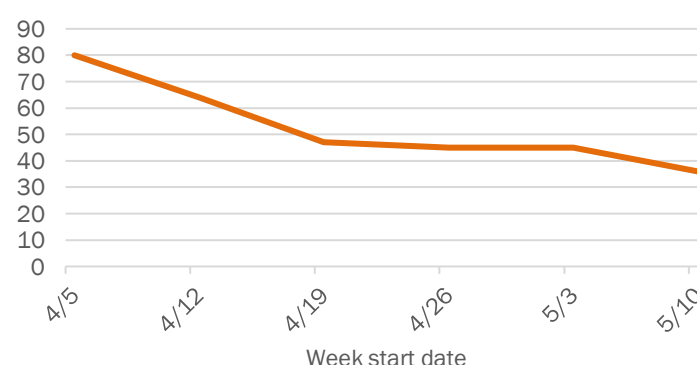
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

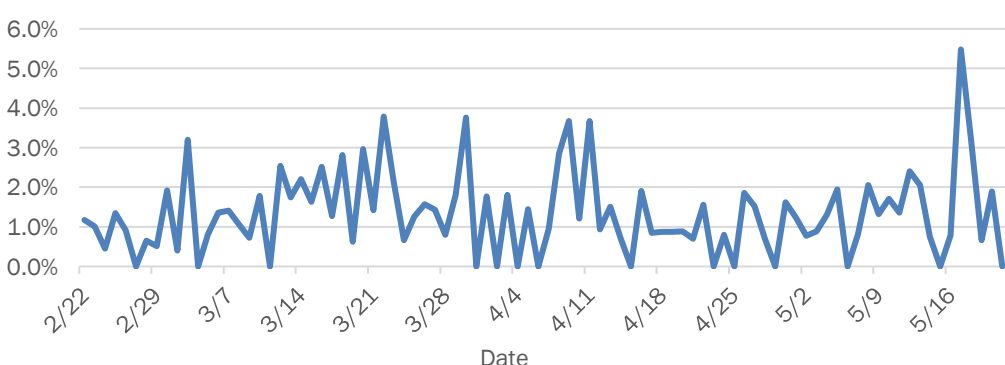

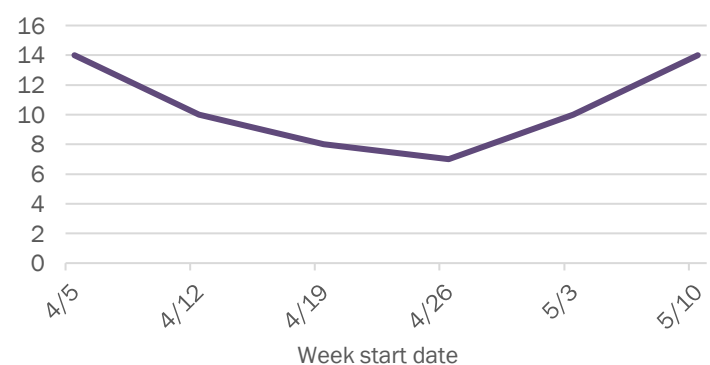
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



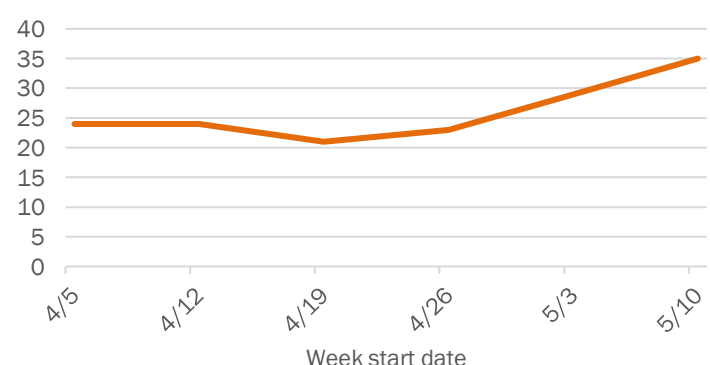
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

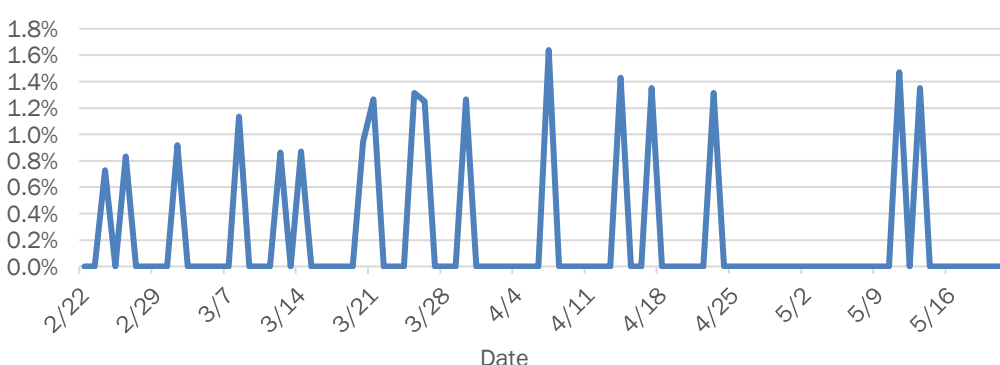
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



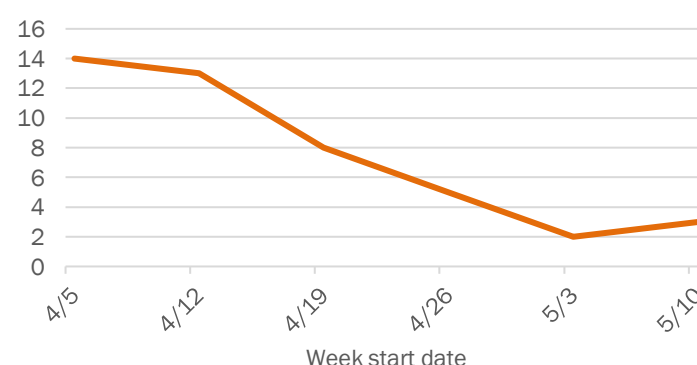
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

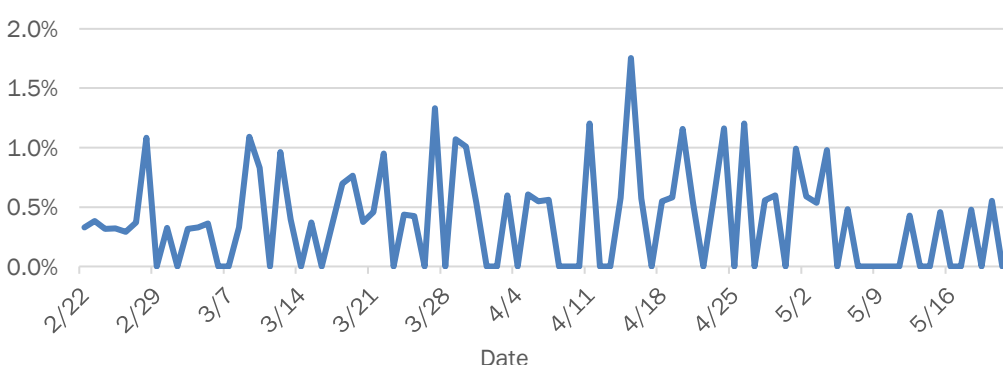

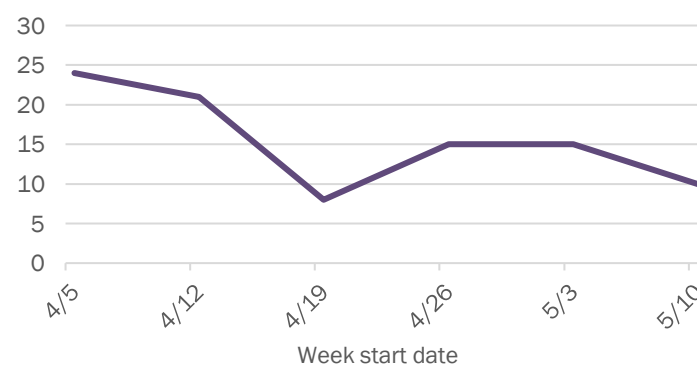
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



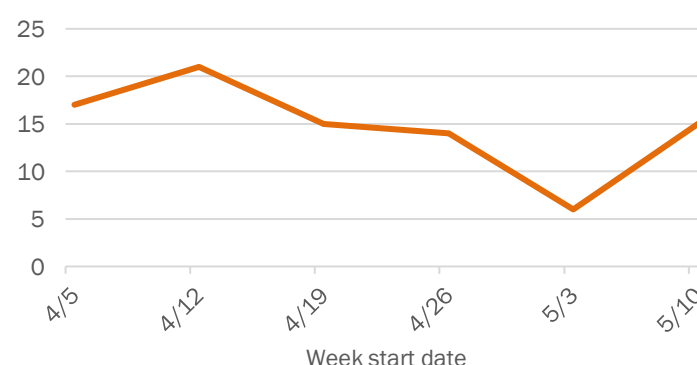
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

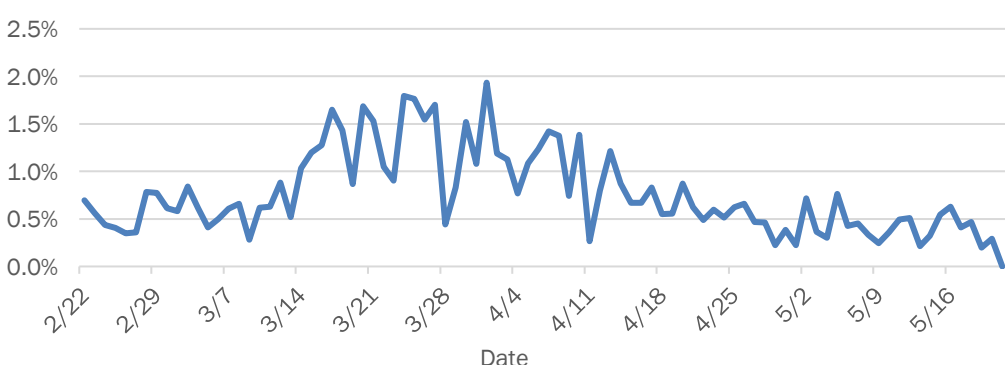


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Orange County

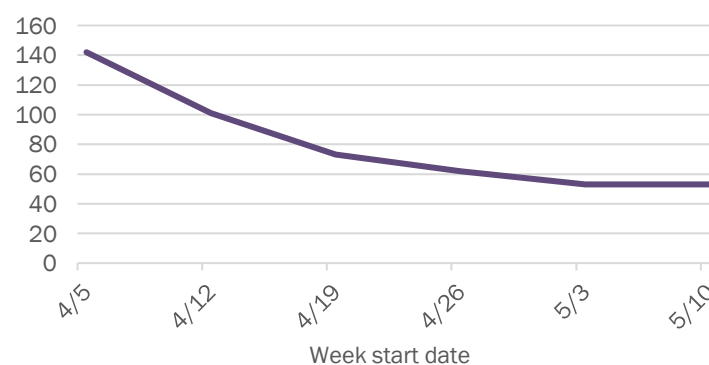
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



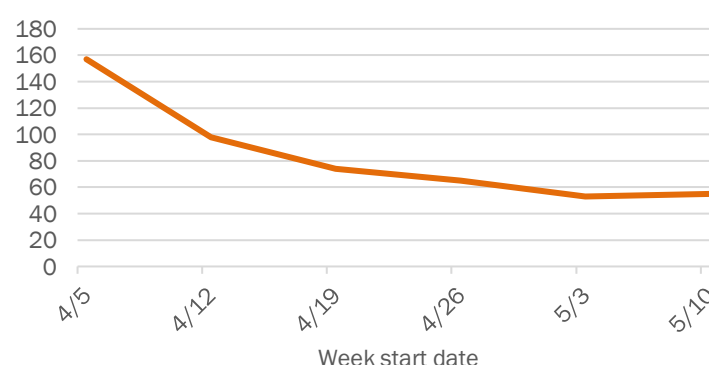
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in cough-associated admissions

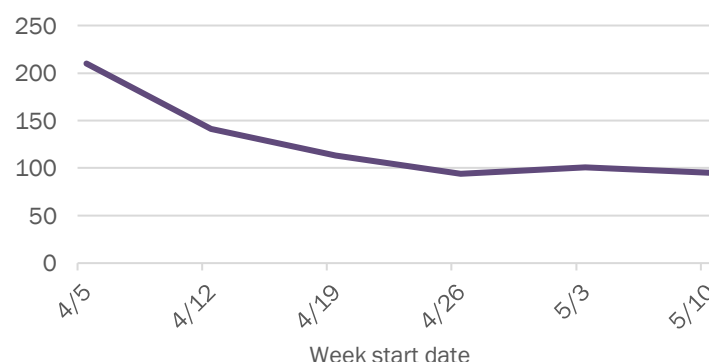
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



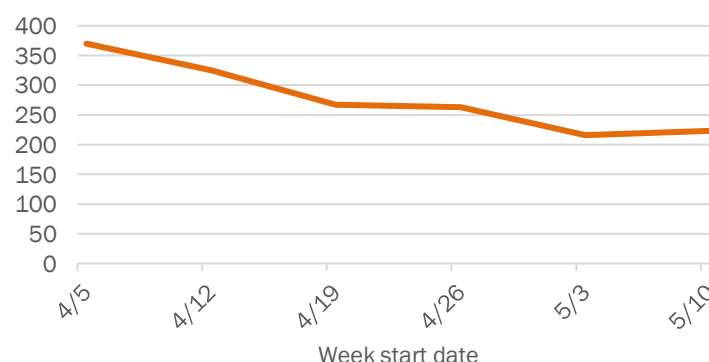

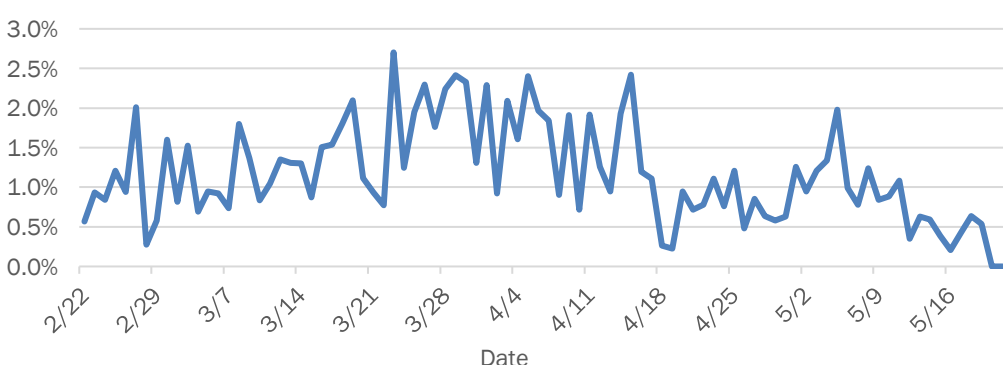
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



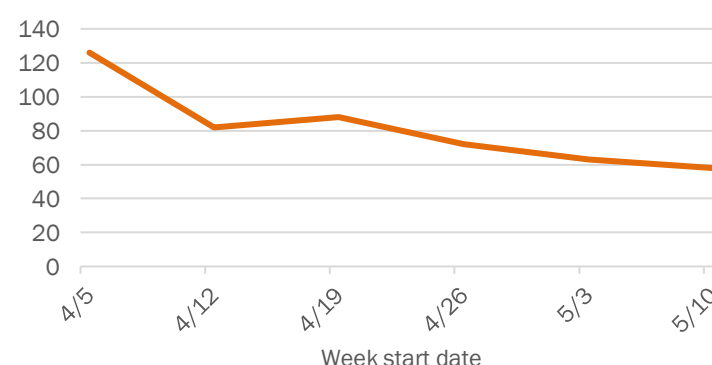
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

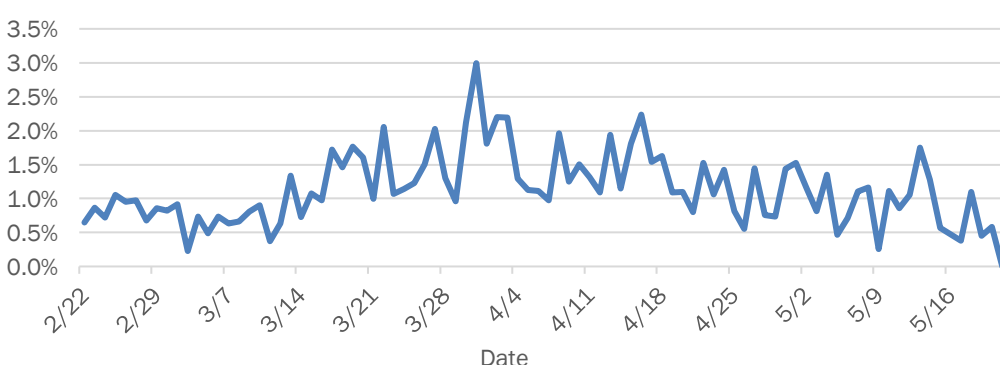
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



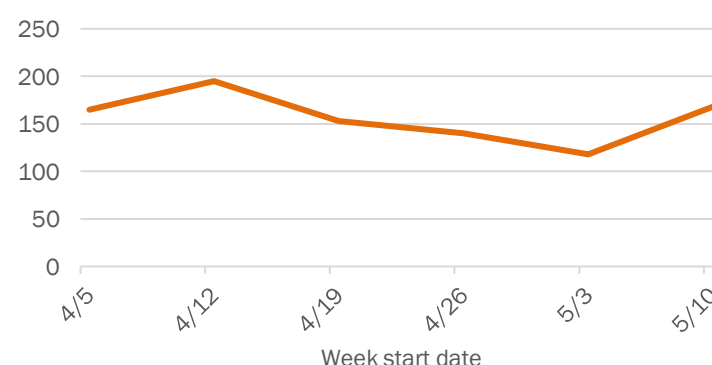
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

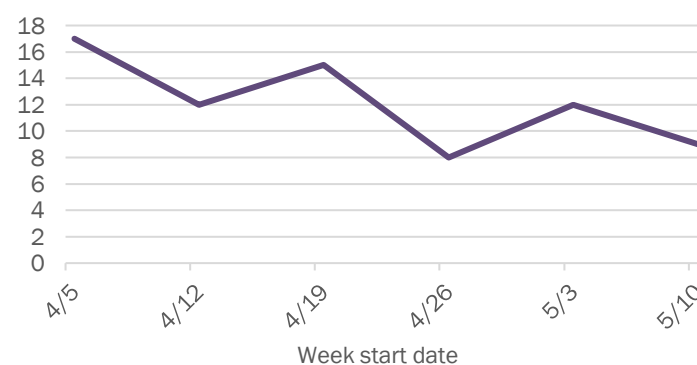

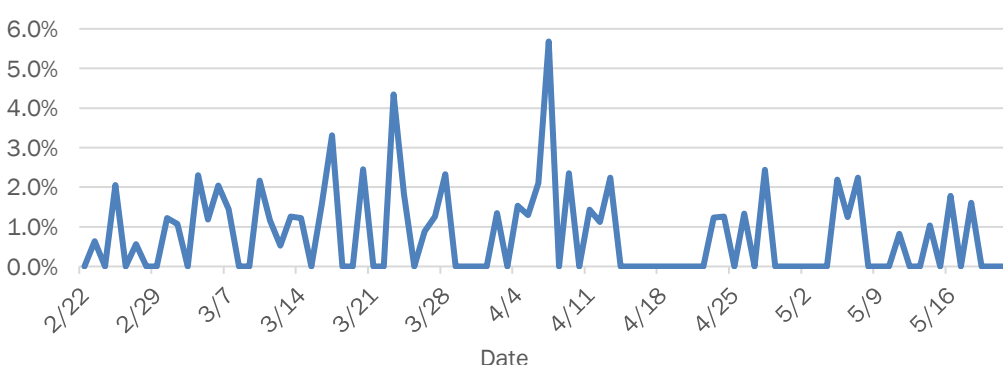
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



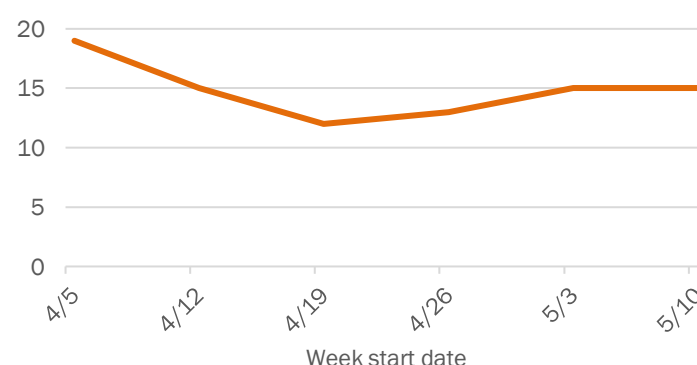
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

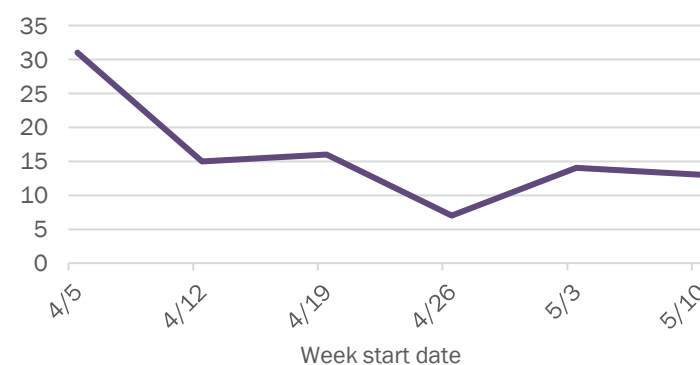

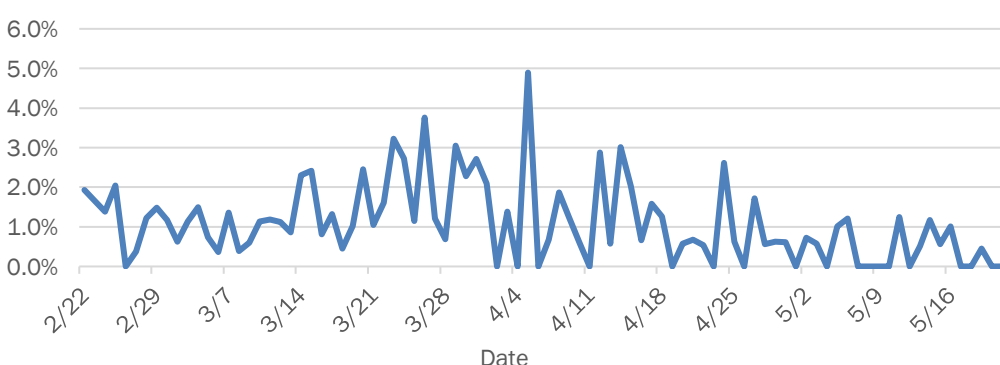
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath

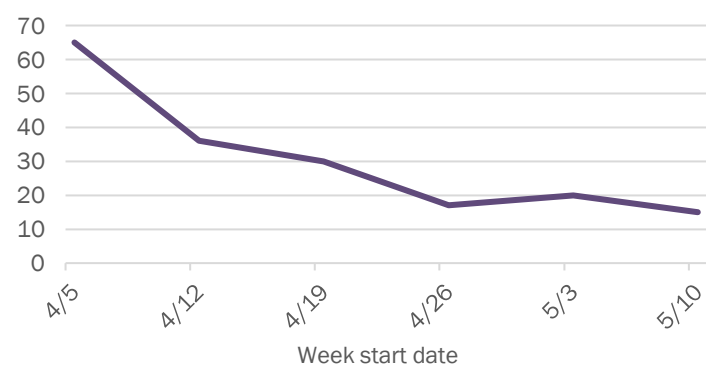


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County

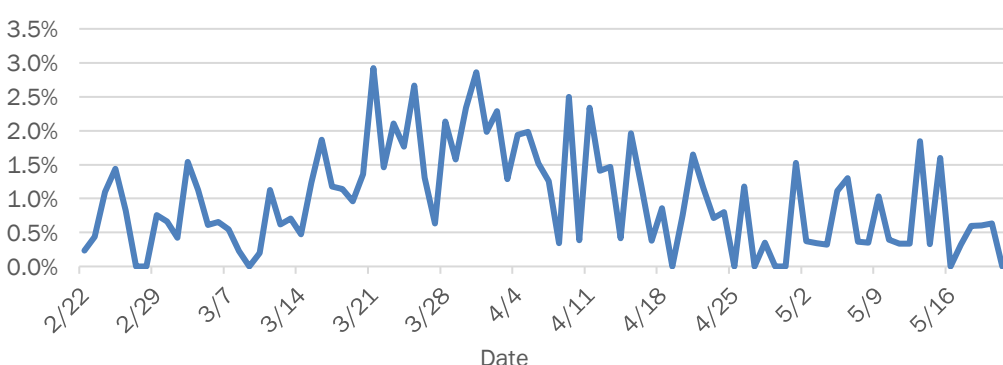
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



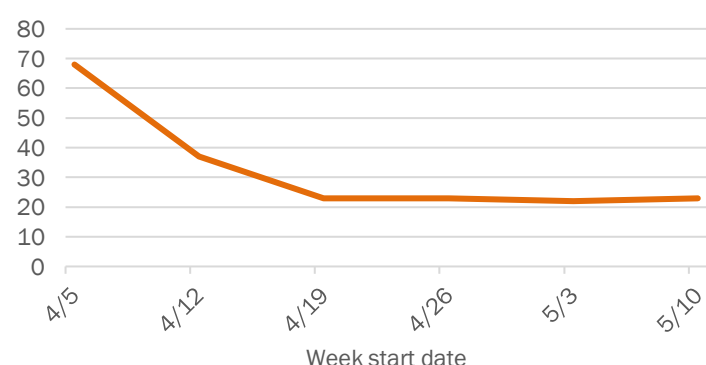
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness

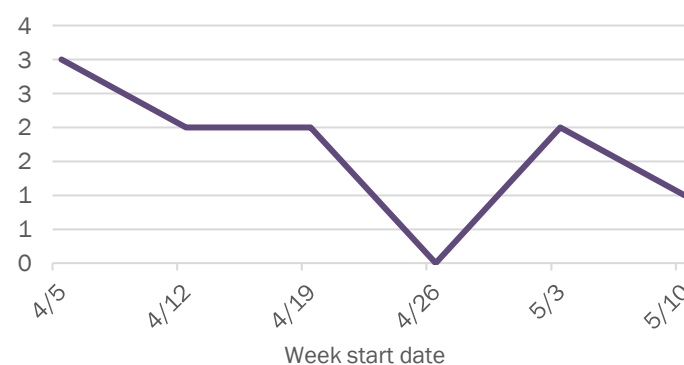
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



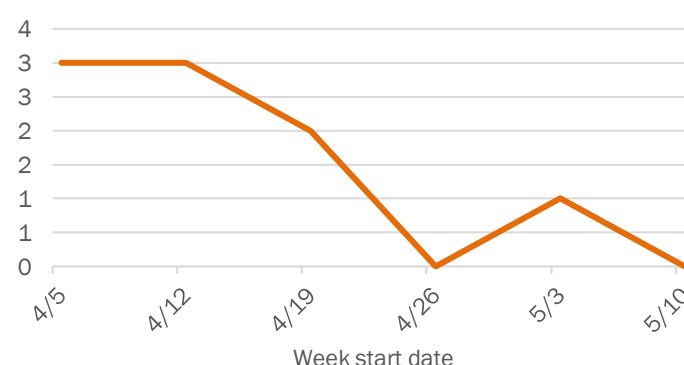

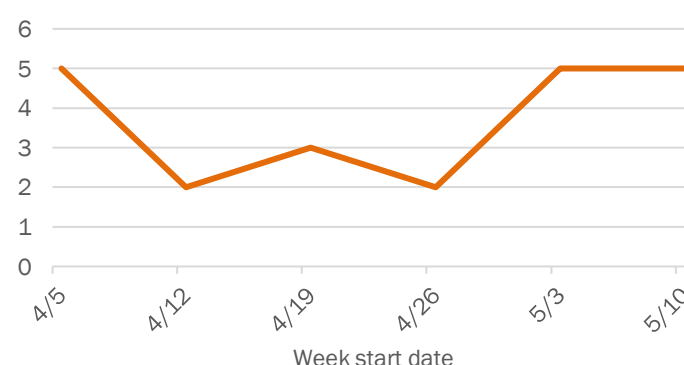

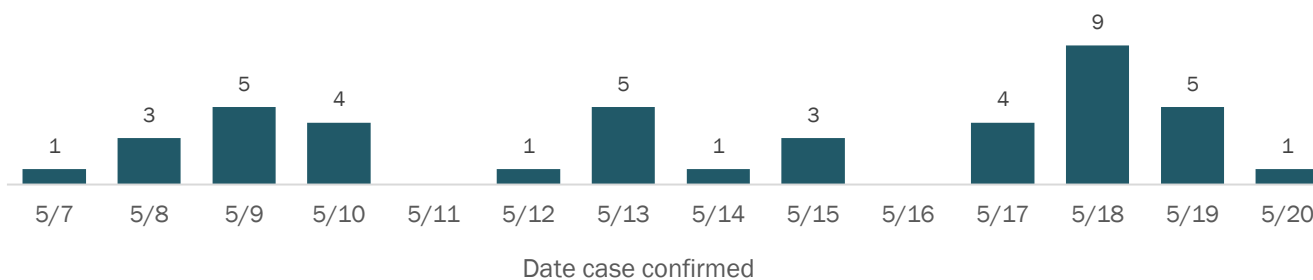

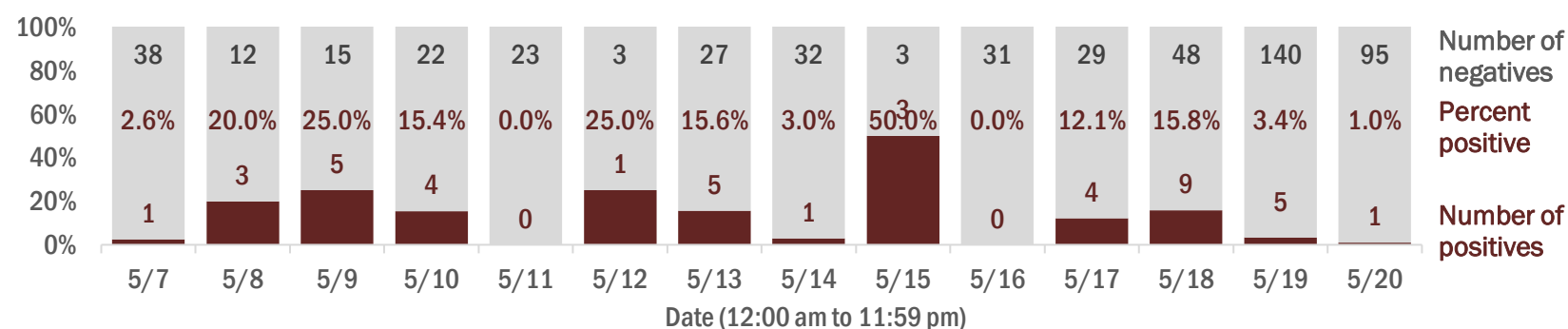

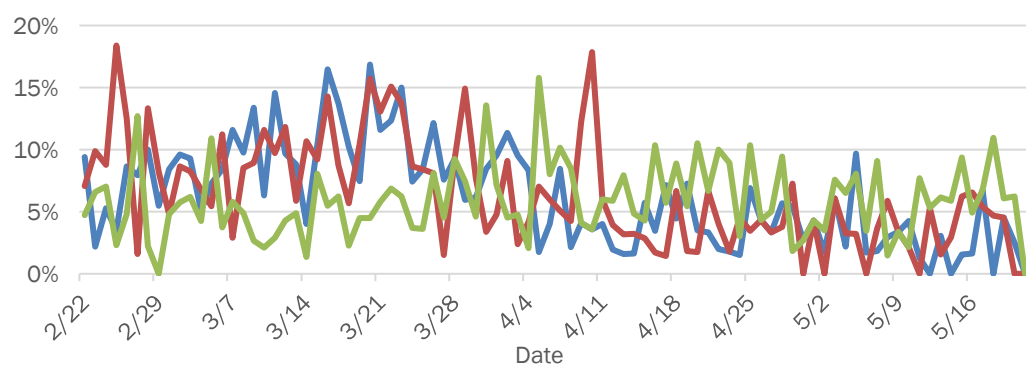

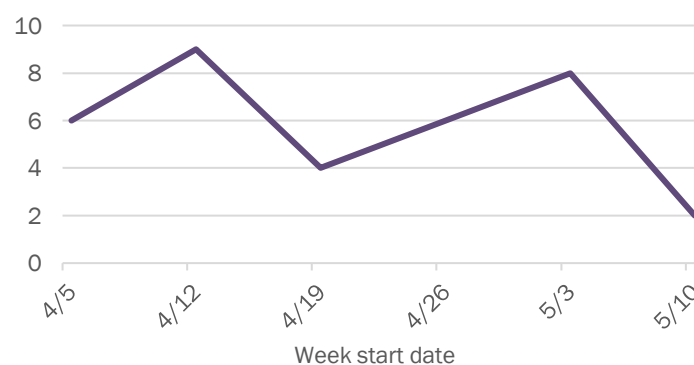


Emergency department (ED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County

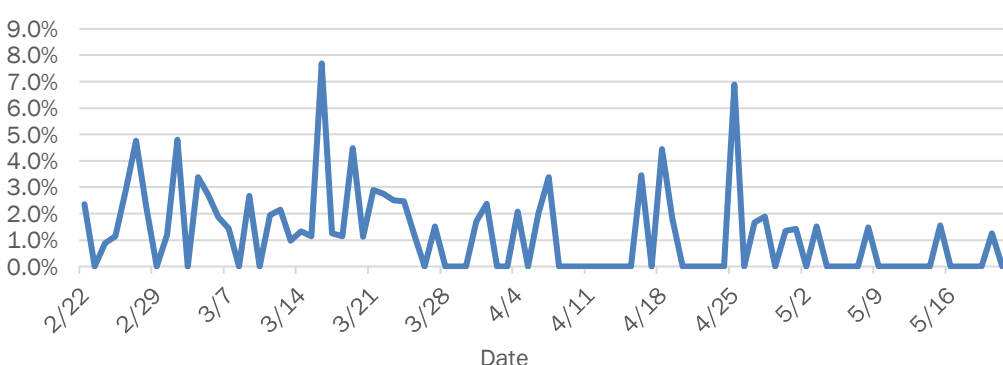
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning cough, fever, or shortness of breath



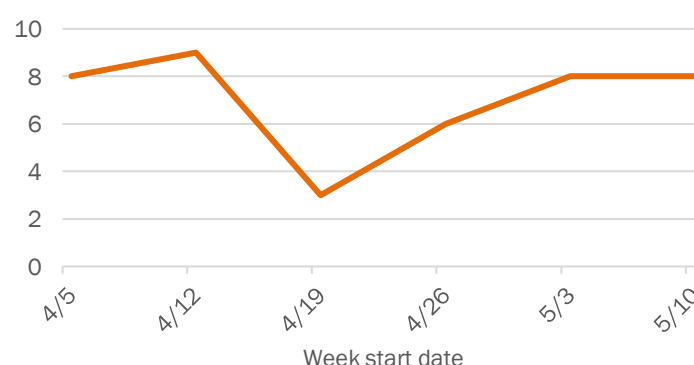
Weekly count of ED visits for influenza-like illness
