


Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents




Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning













Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Gilchrist County







Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County





Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Okaloosa County








Daily percent of ED visits mentioning




Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County










Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for St. Johns County











Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County











Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents






Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County Daily percent of ED visits mentioning Weekly co








