


Daily percent of ED visits mentioning

Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning











## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Wakulla County




## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County
