SURVEILLANCE DATA: 2014

FLORIDA VIOLENCE AND INJURY PREVENTION

Injuries are the leading cause of death among Florida Residents ages 1-44 and the third leading cause of death overall, after cancer and heart disease.



In 2014, 13,269 residents were fatally injured. There were an additional 130,323 hospitalizations for non-fatal injuries.

Injuries and Hospitalizations by Intent

- 8%—Suicide/Self-inflicted
- 4%—Homicide/Assault
- 2%—Undetermined
- 1%—No-intent Code

Who is Injured?

Males accounted for **67%** of all injury deaths, and in all age groups, the fatality rate was higher than females.

Adults, 85+, had the highest rates of fatal injuries and non-fatal hospitalizations.

Adults under 65: Males had more non-fatal hospitalizations than females.
