

STDs are sexually transmitted diseases.

Could you have one?

24
years old or younger?

15-24 AGE GROUP:

27% of the sexually-active population.

50% of the **20,000,000** new STDs cases each year.

Many have multiple partners which increases risk.

Many don't like talking about their sexual behaviors with their doctors.

Condom use?

Consistent, correct use reduces risk.

MORE RELIABLE:

Long-term, mutually monogamous relationship with an uninfected partner.

Not having sex.

Gender?

STDs: more long-term health problems for women than men.

Undiagnosed STDs cause **24,000** women to become infertile each year.

Most women don't know they're infected because they have few or no symptoms.

YOUNGER WOMEN:

More likely to have serious health problems from STDs.

Many don't receive chlamydia screenings.
